



MAKE AND MODEL

The Kia Seltos retains its #1 spot with low days to sell and reduced price pressure. In contrast, premium models like the Porsche Macan and Mercedes GLE are deeply discounted and slow to sell. New entries like the Nissan Vanette have disrupted the leaderboard, while some Japanese models enter the bottom for the first time.

- Top models across months consistently sell under 20 days.
- The premium segment continues to suffer from high supply and deep discounts.
- Repeat top performers like MG ZS EV and GWM Haval Jolion suggest brand momentum.

BODY TYPE

Utes and hatchbacks remain the fastest selling body types, averaging under 30 days. Coupes continue to be the slowest movers, with 74 day market supply and 43 days to sell.

- Minimal movement in top rankings month-to-month; Utility, Hatchback, and Van hold top spots.
- SUVs have slipped slightly, suggesting a cooling in demand for this dominant category.
- Sedans are recovering marginally, improving in rank from #6 to #5.

FUEL TYPE

Diesel and electric cars lead for speed to sale (27 days), while hybrid-diesels are the slowest and most discounted, taking 51 days to sell with 64 days of supply.

- Electric cars dropped from 2nd to 3rd place this month.
- Petrol vehicles improved slightly in sales velocity, moving from 3rd to 2nd.
- No major shifts in discounting behaviour across months; steady ~32%.

DOES AGE MATTER?

Insight: 2010–2015 models are selling fastest, followed closely by 2021–2023 vehicles, likely due to affordability. 2025 models remain stuck with 72 day sell times.

- Older vehicles (2010-2015) are consistently among the best performers.
- Newest stock (2025) is persistently slow-moving month over month.
- The number of vehicles dropping in price remains consistent (31–34%) regardless of age.

HOT PICKS

The Toyota RAV4 dominates, appearing 4 times in the top 10 across different years. The BYD Atto 3 makes a stunning entry with just 8 days to sell and minimal discounting indicating strong market buzz.

- Consistent performance from Toyota RAV4, regardless of age.
- Electric entrants like BYD Atto 3 hint at growing buyer confidence in EVs.
- Models like Mazda CX-9 and Subaru XV have improved dramatically in rank.

STANDARD ISSUE

The Toyota Aqua lineup continues to dominate listings, with steady sales and moderate discounts. The Ford Ranger (2019–2021) and Mazda Axela round out the top 10 but face longer days to sell and higher discount rates.

- Toyota Aqua (2012–2016) is a staple on the list across the last four months.
- Ford Rangers have slipped slightly in performance compared to May.
- Mazda Axela and Toyota CH-R remain consistent in ranking despite slow turnover.
