

MAKE AND MODEL

The top-performing models this month include a mix of compact, fuel-efficient options (Holden Spark, Kia Stonic) and the BYD Atto 3 races to take top spot. Luxury models continue to dominate the bottom five—BMW, Mercedes, and Lexus models all suffer from long days to sell and deep discounting.

BODY TYPE

Utes remain the fastest-selling body type for the fourth consecutive month with consistent 24–25 day sales cycles. Hatchbacks and wagons continue to perform steadily, offering dependable sales and manageable supply. SUVs are still experiencing pressure with the highest days to sell (32) and high market day supply (41), which has been climbing since January.

FUEL TYPE

Diesel continues to be the most in-demand fuel type with the lowest average days to sell (26) and stable market supply. Electric vehicles saw reduced time to sell again (28 days), even as discounts softened—signaling rising buyer confidence. Hybrids, particularly hybrid-diesel, are the slowest segment this month with high days to sell and large discounts.

DOES AGE MATTER?

2021–2023 cars remain the clear winners with the lowest days to sell (25) and the most stable pricing (just 28% discounted). 2024 models are selling slightly faster than last month but still suffer from high market supply (47 days) and longer wait times. 2025 stock (though limited) is showing high days to sell (109) and very high market days supply (145).

HOT PICKS

Toyota has 6 of the top 10 best sellers this month, solidifying its dominant position in the used car market. The Toyota RAV4, Corolla, and Yaris (across multiple years) continue to deliver strong, fast sales. Diesel options like the Holden Colorado are showing up in the top 10, alongside value compact models like the Honda Fit.

STANDARD ISSUE

Ford Ranger (2021 and 2019) continues to be heavily listed and still performs well, with decent turnover and minimal discounts. Toyota Aqua models from 2012–2015 are still among the most listed, but all require significant discounting (up to 38%) to sell. The Toyota C-HR and Prius models are seeing slower sales and rising market supply—pricing and stocking strategies should be reviewed.








