The 87th year of Southern Conference Football kicked off with a pair of Thursday night games: Western Carolina topped Shorter, 35-0 and Samford edged West Georgia, 21-19 ... Samford's game was the first hosted by a SoCon team in the state of Alabama since 1932 (Auburn) ... Dennis Wagner coached his first game for WCU ... Georgia Southern, Chattanooga and Appalachian State will face three of the top seven FBS teams Saturday in No. 1 Georgia, No. 4 Oklahoma and No. 7 LSU ... 15th-ranked Elon hosts 6th-ranked Richmond in the premier FCS game of the week - Richmond beat Wofford in the FCS quarterfinals in 2007 before falling to ASU in the semis ... The Citadel hosts Webber International after trouncing WIU 76-0 last season ... Furman entertains Mars Hill for the first time since 1985.

SoCon News and Notes



Experienced Coaches: Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 253 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 167 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (49 victories) needs 15 victories to enter the top 10.

SoCon Players Make NFL Impact: Prior to the final round of preseason cuts, 26 players with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Efram Hill and Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and four Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... Appalachian State leads the way with five players while Georgia Southern has four and Chattanooga three ... the Tennessee Titans, with three SoCon-affiliated players, have the most of any team.

Nationally-Ranked Teams: Five SoCon teams enter the 2008 season ranked in the FCS Coaches Poll and the Sports Network Poll ... Appalachian State is No. 1 in both polls while Wofford is 13th, Elon 15, Georgia Southern 17th and The Citadel 23rd ... the five SoCon teams ranks just behind the Missouri Valley Football Conference (6) and the Colonial Athletic Conference (6) ... in total, 17 of the top 25 teams come from just three conferences.

SoCon Well-Represented on Payton/Buchanan Watch Lists: Three Southern Conference players were named to the Payton Award watch list while SoCon preseason defensive player of the year Pierre Banks from Appalachian State was chosen for the Buck Buchanan Award watch list ... ASU QB Armanti Edwards is joined on the Payton Watch List by wide receivers Terrell Hudgins (Elon) and Andre Roberts (The Citadel) ... Georgia Southern's Jayson Foster was the 2007 Payton Award winner, marking the fourth SoCon winner of that award.

Non-Conference Schedule Notes: The nine SoCon schools have 32 non-conference games on the schedule this season ... 10 games are against FBS opponents, including five against the SEC and four versus the ACC ... Chattanooga ventures into Big 12 territory to face preseason No. 4 Oklahoma ... among the 17 FCS non-conference games, seven come against the Big South and four are against CAA opponents ... SoCon teams will face six non-Division I teams in 2008 ... the most common SoCon opponent is Presbyterian, which will battle four SoCon teams (Appalachian State, Elon, Western Carolina and Wofford) ... the last team to face at least four SoCon opponents in the same season was Coastal Carolina, which went

2-3 against league teams in 2006 ... two-time opponents include Florida State (Western Carolina, Chattanooga) and Liberty (Elon, Western Carolina).

Rebuilding and Reloading: SoCon teams return 57 percent of their starters from last season (133 of 233) ... the most experienced group are the specialists (63%) followed by defense (60%) and offense (53%) ... Elon has the most experienced group of returning starters as 21 of 25 (84 percent) return from a Phoenix team which finished 7-4 overall and 4-3 in the SoCon last season ... Elon boasts the most experience group in all three categories while Samford (seven offense, eight defense, four specialist) has the second-most experience group with 70.4 percent returning ... although Georgia Southern returns nine starters on defense, the Eagles bring back a SoCon-low three starters on "O".

The Running Backs (and QBs) Keep Marching: Georgia Southern led the nation in rushing last season for the seventh time in the past nine seasons ... the Eagles' 326.27 yards per contest edged out second place Wofford (309.69) and third place Appalachian State (287.40) giving the SoCon the top three rushing teams ... individually, GSU's Jayson Foster was second in the FCS in rushing yards per game with 167.64 (1,844 total yards), and ASU quarterback Armanti Edwards (144.4 ypg/1,558 yards) would have ranked sixth had he played in the NCAA-minimum 75 percent of his team's games ... Edwards missed the minimum by one game, seeing action in 11 of 15 contests (73.3 percent).

Samford Begins SoCon Play: Samford became the Southern Conference's 12th current member and 43rd all-time when it joined the league officially on July 1 ... the school based in Birmingham, Ala. has 4,500 students, and it most recently competed in the Ohio Valley Conference ... the Bulldogs will be under the guidance of 1971 Heisman Trophy winner Pat Sullivan for the second season in 2008, and they play their first SoCon contest at Elon on Sept. 27 ... when Samford hosts Appalachian State on Oct. 11, it will mark the first Southern Conference game played in the state of Alabama since Dec. 3, 1932 when Auburn played South Carolina to a 20-20 tie in Birmingham ... the last time a SoCon from Alabama won a league game was Nov. 24, 1932 when Alabama shut out Vanderbilt, 20-0, in Birmingham.

SoCon to Begin League Hall of Fame: The Southern Conference will induct its first-ever hall of fame class in the spring of 2009 with a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C. ... the 88-year old league is the fifth-oldest Division I conference in the country and has seen such stars as Arnold Palmer (Wake Forest), Jerry West (West Virginia), Terrell Owens (Chattanooga) and "Hot Rod" Hundley (West Virginia) play in the league in addition to legendary coaches such as Adolph Rupp (Kentucky), Everett Case (North Carolina State), Wallace Wade (Alabama, Duke), Bear Bryant (Kentucky), General Robert Neyland (Tennessee) and Lefty Dreisell (Davidson).

Strength in the Classroom Matches Strength on the Field: In addition to boasting eight national championships and semifinal appearances in 21 of the past 25 seasons, SoCon teams also excel in the classroom ... five SoCon players earned CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All District honors in 2007, trailing the SEC's seven and leading the ACC (4), Conference USA (3), Big South (2), Pioneer (2) and CAA (1) ... Furman's Jerome Felton and Scott Shuford were joined on the list by ASU's Pierre Banks and Wofford's Dan Tavani and Kevin Adleman.

Nov. 17, 2007 - Colorado State 42, No. 14 Georgia Southern 34
Down 25 points early in the fourth quarter, Georgia Southern scored 17 unanswered but the Eagles ran out of time losing 42-34 at Colorado State. Jayson Foster led the Eagles with 195 yards and three rushing touchdowns to go along with 107 yards through the air.

Jan. 1, 2008 - No. 5 Georgia 41, No. 10 Hawaii 10
Georgia forced six turnovers and built a 38-point advantage to top Hawaii in the Allstate Sugar Bowl. The Bulldogs limited Heisman Trophy finalist Colt Brennan to 169 yards and three INTs while UGA's Knowshon Moreno scored a pair of rushing touchdowns.

Georgia Southern Outlook

GSU is looking to replace Payton Award-winning QB Jayson Foster and each of its top three rushers from 2007, including Foster, Lamar Lewis and Mike Hamilton. The Eagles' strength in 2008 may be in its defense which returns nine of 11 starters from a year ago. In addition to defensive end Larry Beard, all-conference seniors Damon Suggs (DL) and Chris Covington (DB) will provide leadership for a unit that had the SoCon's highest turnover margin in 2007 (+12) and allowed the second-fewest number of first downs (229).

Dec. 14, 2007 - No. 5 Appalachian State 49, No. 13 Delaware 21
Armanti Edwards threw for three touchdowns while running back Kevin Richardson capped his ASU career with one score on the ground and another receiving as the Mountaineers became the first team in FCS history to win three straight national championships.

Jan. 7, 2008 - No. 2 LSU 38, No. 1 Ohio State 24
After falling behind 10-0 in the first quarter, LSU stormed back with 31 consecutive points to build an insurmountable lead and claim the program's second national title in the past five seasons. QB Matt Flynn tossed four touchdowns for the Tigers.

Appalachian State Outlook

The 2008 Mountaineers will once again be lead by junior Armanti Edwards, a dual-threat quarterback who amassed more than 3,500 yards of total offense last season. Running back Devon Moore will step into the spot vacated by ASU's all-time leading rusher Kevin Richardson while the Mountaineers' defense will be anchored by a strong linebacker core of D.J. Aug. 30, 2003: Furman quarterback Bo Moore passed for 221 yards and two touchdowns as Furman spoiled Elon's first-ever SoCon game with a 24-7 victory in Paladin Stadium. Future NFL linebacker Chad Nkang rushed five times for 57 yards and a TD to lead the Phoenix.

Aug. 30, 2001: Jason Bell rushed for a career-high 130 yards and a TD and Chattanooga scored 28 straight points en route to a 28-14 season-opening victory at Samford.

Aug. 30, 1997: Georgia Southern opened the Paul Johnson era with a 45-26 win over Division II power Valdosta State behind 280 yards passing from quarterbacks Kenny Robinson and Greg Hill.

Aug. 30, 1986: Appalachian State topped Western Carolina, 17-13, in the season-opener for both squads. ASU sealed the comeback win with a two-yard TD plunge by John Settle with 9:52 remaining in the earliest-ever Battle for the Old Mountain Jug.
