Wells scored a game-high 25 points as The
Citadel downed High Point, 71-63, last
Tuesday. He added seven rebounds, three
assists and a steal in 34 minutes of action.
Wells reached the 20-point plateau for the
30th time in his career with 22 points against
Coastal Carolina as the Bulldogs fell 72-64

gainst 72-64 to the Chanticleers. He scored 15 of The Citadel's 31 points in the second half and dished out five assists.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK** 

The senior guard is third in the Southern Conference in scoring (20.0 ppg) and is tied for seventh in assists (3.8 apg). Wells leads the SoCon in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.7) and has connected on 87.5 percent of his free throw attempts, which is tied for the thirdbest mark in the league.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Donald Sims, Davidson's JP Kuhlman, Georgia Southern's Ben Drayton III, Samford's Kaylin Johnson, Western Carolina's Mike Williams and Wofford's Noah Dahlman.

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



· Donald Sims scored a game-high 28 points in Appalachian State's loss at Chattanooga Thursday night. Sims leads the Southern Conference in scoring with 26.8 points per game. He ranks fourth in the SoCon with 4.2 assists per game.

• ASU struggled from beyond the arc against the Mocs as Appalachian State shot 7-of-31 (.226) from three-point range. The Mountaineers have shot 33 percent from three-point range this season

Appalachian State visits Samford Saturday afternoon. Following a week off, the Mountaineers will visit Georgetown December 12.

#### **ELON PHOENIX**



 Freshman Jack Isenbarger has made an immediate impact for the Phoenix. Isenbarger leads the team and is tenth in the conference with 15.2 points per game. His 3.8 assists per game are tied for the sixth best mark in the league. Isenbarger has made 88 percent of his free throws.

Elon has seen a dramatic increase in its scoring through the first five games this season. The Phoenix average 74.3 points per contest, eight points better than 2009-10 when Elon averaged 66.9 points per game. The Phoenix host Wofford Saturday night.

#### **UNCG SPARTANS**



• Kyle Randall has continued his strong play through the start of the season. The sophomore point guard ranks among the league leaders in scoring (11.4 ppg), assist to turnover ratio (1.4) and free throw percentage (.857). • UNCG has been one of the best teams on the offensive glass in the conference through the first three weeks of the

season. The Spartans rank second in the SoCon with 13.3 offensive rebounds per game. UNCG is second in offensive rebound percent (.359)

UNCG hosts Furman Monday night.

#### SAMFORD BULLDOGS



 The Bulldogs have made at least one three-point field goal in 572-consecutive games. The last time that Samford did not make a three-point basket was on Jan. 19, 1991, against Texas-San Antonio.

• Samford ranks among the top defensive teams in the league. The Bulldogs have limited their opponents to a league-low 61.1 points per game this season. The Bulldogs also lead the conference in field goal percentage defense (.376). Samford is averaging 5.5 steals per game.

The Bulldogs host Appalachian State Saturday afternoon. Samford will then host UT-Arlington on December 11.

### CHATTANOOGA MOCS



The Mocs opened the season playing seven times in 16 days. That equates to one game every 55 hours. Five of the seven were on the road with Chattanooga traversing approximately 2,900 miles.

Chattanooga has the third longest active streak of making 5+ three-pointers in a game with 33. VMI leads the nation with 77 consecutive games followed by Northern Colo-

rado (36). The Mocs play host to Western Carolina on Saturday. Chattanooga entertains Murray State at McKenzie Arena on December 11.

### WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



 Mike Williams recorded his first double-double of the season with 20 points and 10 rebounds in Thursday's loss at Samford. Williams leads WCU and ranks eighth in the conference with 15.8 points per game. The senior ranks third in the SoCon with 2.2 steals per game.

Western Carolina ranks second in the league in scoring margin through its first eight games. The Catamounts are +3.3 in scoring this season.

The Catamounts visit Chattanooga Saturday afternoon. The game will be televised by SportSouth.

#### **COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS**



· CofC is in the midst of a five-game homestand after playing six of its first seven games on the road. The Cougars boast an all-time home record of 26-5 at the two-year-old Carolina First Arena after earning an 82-73 victory over Davidson Thursday night.

Andrew Goudelock scored 33 points in the win over the Wildcats Thursday. Goudelock is the league's active scoring leader with 1,893 career points. He is averaging 24.9 points per game this season, the second best mark in the league.

College of Charleston hosts Georgia Southern Saturday evening.

#### THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



• Senior guard Cameron Wells has moved within 55 points of becoming The Citadel's all-time leading scorer. After scoring at least 20 points last week in games against High Point and Coastal Carolina, Wells chipped in 10 points Thursday night as the Bulldogs topped Georgia Southern.

• Austin Dahn, who recently moved into fourth place among the school's premiere three-point shooters, has hit 13 triples this season. The team leader in that category, Dahn now has 194 for his career, passing Alan Puckett (192) on the all-time list.

The Citadel hosts Davidson Saturday afternoon. The Bulldogs then welcome St. Mary's (Md.) to McAlister Field House on Monday.

#### DAVIDSON WILDCATS



• Sophomore forward Jake Cohen had a strong outing for Davidson Thursday at College of Charleston. Cohen scored a team-high 23 points and pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the season. · Davidson has 10 underclassmen (four sophomores, six freshman) on its roster. The Wildcats have 11 total years of Division I experience in the rotation; only 25 teams in the country have less experience than Davidson.

The Wildcats visit The Citadel Saturday afternoon. After a week off, Davidson will play host to Charlotte at Belk Arena on December 11.

#### **FURMAN PALADINS**



Furman has used the three-point shot to its advantage this season. The Paladins averaged 7.5 made threepointers per game and have shot 34 percent from beyond the arc.

The Paladins have carried over their strong defensive play from a season ago. Last year Furman held its

opponents to just 68.6 points per contest, the fourth-best mark in the league. This year Furman is limiting its opponents to just 64.8 points, the second-lowest mark in the conference.

Furman travels to face UNCG Monday night. The Paladins visit Middle Tennessee State December 12.

### **GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES**



 Despite recording just six steals at The Citadel Thursday, the Eagles lead the league with 9.5 thefts per game. Georgia Southern ranks fourth in the conference in blocked shots with 3.3 blocks per game.

• Five different Eagles scored in double figures for the second time this season during last week's game at Texas Tech. Earlier this year Georgia Southern had seven players scored in double figures against Reinhardt.

Georgia Southern visits College of Charleston Saturday. The Eagles welcome Brewton Parker to Statesboro December 11.

#### WOFFORD TERRIERS



• Wofford played three straight overtime games, one shy of the NCAA record of four straight, before downing UNCG Thursday night in regulation. Wofford's three overtime game against Xavier last week was just the second three overtime game in school history, matching a 108-104 win over Presbyterian College in 1952

Noah Dahlman scored 16 points against the Spartans and has now

scored in double-figures in 56 consecutive games for the Terriers. Wofford visits Elon Saturday. The Terriers travel to South Carolina December 11.

## **CONFERENCE** NOTES

### Familiar Faces

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2010-11. Seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 35 starters from last year, an average of 2.9 per team. Furman is the only team in the league to return all five starters from last season. Wofford and The Citadel each return four starters.
- Eight of the ten members from the 2010 Coaches All-Conference team return for 2010-11.

## Head Coaches

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

• Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.

• Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

## Four for 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

• League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

### Non-Conference Scheduling

Ten of the 12 SoCon teams are scheduled to participate in an exempt tournament this winter, from Puerto Rico (Davidson) to Cancun, Mexico (Appalachian State).

• SoCon teams will take part in the 2K Sports Classic, Charleston Classic, Puerto Rico Tip-Off, Global Sports Showcase, Legends Classic, South Padre Island Invitational, Cancun Govern's Cup, MSG Holiday Festival and Las Vegas Classic.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### Annual Leaders

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in Southern Conference history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the league in scoring defense.

• Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighthbest mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.

• College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

• Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

## MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

• The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

## SoCon Tournament

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2011 marks the 90th year of the post-season classic.

### Postseason Play

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the postseason for 2010. The league also placed four teams in postseason tournaments in 2009.

- The Wofford Terriers made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2010. Wofford fell to Wisconsin 53-49 in the first round in Jackson-ville, Fla.
- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
- Appalachian State defeated Harvard (93-71) and Marshall (80-72) in the CIT but dropped a 64-56 decision to Pacific in the semifinal.
- After defeating Eastern Kentucky (82-79) in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, College of Charleston fell at VCU (93-86) in the second round.
