## NOTES

• ETSU and UNCG went 2-0 in the opening week of the 2022 SoCon men's soccer season, with the Bucs earning a pair of shutout victories over Longwood and Davidson and the Spartans clinching back-to-back wins over UNC Asheville and UNCW.

• In the 5-1 win over UNC Asheville on Thursday, UNCG saw four Spartans score, including Ismail el Harchi Khalfi, who scored two goals, and JC Ngando, Jack Birch and Colton Sessoms, who all scored one goal each.

• This was the most goals in a game for the Spartans since Oct. 19, 2021 when UNCG won 7-1 against USC Upstate.

• Against UNCW, junior goalkeeper Niclas Wild made one save and tallied his 14th career shutout.

• UNCG is currently ranked seventh in the first United Soccer Coaches South Regional poll and also received 23 votes in the United Soccer Coaches National Poll.

• ETSU senior forward Kieran Richards, who was named offensive player of the week, led the Bucs in their 4-0 shutout win over the Lancers, recording a brace in the win while Tarik Pannholzer and Gabriel Ramos added one goal each.

• In the 2-0 win over Davidson, junior forward Carlos Portas recorded a brace, while Richards added his third goal of the season.

• The Bucs' back-to-back shutout wins mark the first time they have accomplished the feat since Oct. 19-22, 2019, when ETSU blanked VMI 3-0 and then Mercer, 2-0.

• ETSU's seven total goals are the most scored by a Buccaneer team in the first two games to start a season.

• Furman and Mercer both went 1-0-1 to open the 2022 season.

• Junior midfielder Tommy Redhead converted from the penalty spot in the first half to lift Furman to a 1-0 victory over Incarnate Word. Furman forward Christian Kraus scored in the 88th minute to earn the Paladins a 1-1 draw versus Houston Baptist.

• Dylan Gaither led the Bears on offense in Mercer's 5-2 win over Winthrop, scoring on a penalty kick and dishing out assists on all four of the Bears' other goals. Fernando Arteaga also added two goals for Mercer, while Kadeem Agard and Ousman Jabang added one goal each.

• Sophomore defender Chad Eldridge had the team's only goal in the Bears' 1-1 tie against nationally ranked Georgia State (ranked 30th in CSN).

• VMI opened the 2022 season and kicked off Nick Regan's inaugural campaign as VMI's head coach with a 2-2 tie at St. Peter's.

• The Keydets saw goals from midfielders Nathan Lam and Jakub Mihulka before ultimately earning the 2-2 draw against St. Peter's.

• Wofford dropped a hard-fought 1-0 decision to Gardner-Webb on Thursday in the Terriers' 2022 season opener before falling 4-0 to NC State on Monday.

## PLAYER OF THE WEEK RELEASE

**SPARTANBURG, S.C.** – The Southern Conference has selected its first series of 2022 Men's Soccer Player of the Week honorees for contests played from Aug. 25-29. ETSU claims both the offensive and defensive player of the week awards, with senior forward Kieran Richards earning the Offensive Player of the Week honor and goalkeeper Cole Hunter collecting the Defensive Player of the Week award.

Richards netted three goals, recorded one assist and tallied seven points to lead the Bucs to a pair of season-opening shutout victories this past week, including a 4-0 win over Longwood on Thursday, Aug. 25, and a 3-0 victory over Davidson on Sunday, Aug. 28. In the Bucs' nonconference victory over the Lancers on Thursday, Richards opened the contest with an assist in the 24th minute on a goal by Tarik Pannholzer, which handed ETSU the early 1-0 advantage, before lashing a shot past Longwood's keeper in the 46th minute to extend ETSU's lead to 3-0. The senior forward sealed the game for the Bucs and increased the lead to 4-0 by completing a brace in the 78th minute, helping ETSU to its first win of the 2022 campaign. In the Bucs' victory over Davidson, Richards connected with the ball inside the 18-yard box in the 73rd minute and netted his third goal of the week, extending ETSU's lead to 3-0 and helping the Bucs improve to 2-0 on the young season. The Hamilton, New Zealand, native is the first player with three goals in the opening two matches for ETSU since 2014.

Hunter played a major role in ETSU's pair of shutouts against Longwood and Davidson last week, tallying eight saves and a perfect 1.000 save percentage in 180 minutes of action. In the Bucs' match against Longwood, Hunter recorded four saves to garner his first clean sheet of the season. Three days later, the redshirt senior goalkeeper helped ETSU's defense hold Davidson scoreless, grabbing another four saves in goal for the Bucs, including three impressive saves off seven second-half shots to preserve the 3-0 lead en route to the win. The Mount Juliet, Tennessee, native, who posted back-to-back shutouts for the first time in his career, starts the 2022 campaign as the SoCon leader in goals against average (0.00), save percentage (1.000) and saves per game (4.00).
