Quick Hits

• All nine SoCon teams are in action on November 19.

• Georgia Southern has won the 2011 Southern Conference championship and earned the league's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs.

• ASU's Drew Stewart tied the SoCon single-game record with six made field goals against Western Carolina Saturday.

• Home teams have won 17 of 32 league games in 2011.

• Southern Conference teams are 11-1 against FCS non-conference opponents.

AWARD CANDIDATES: The Southern Conference boasts three candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List and three on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player in FCS.

• Payton Award Candidates - Eric Breitenstein (Wofford), Aaron Mellette (Elon) and Brian Quick (Appalachian State).

• Buchanan Award Candidates - Kadarron Anderson (Furman), Brent Russell (Georgia Southern) and Ryan Steed (Furman).

RANKINGS: Three Southern Conference teams are ranked this week in both major FCS Polls. Georgia Southern is ranked No. 2 by the FCS coaches and third by the Sports Network. Appalachian State is eighth according to the coaches and ninth in the Sports Network poll, while Wofford ranks 12th and 13th, respectively. Furman is ranked 24th in the Sports Network Poll.

• Chattanooga and Elon are among the teams receiving votes in the Sports Network Poll.

THROUGH THE AIR: Elon's Aaron Mellette leads the FCS with 140.3 receiving yards per game.

- The Southern Conference has had at least one wide receiver rank in the top five nationally for receiving yards per game in each of the last five seasons.

ON THE GROUND: Wofford owns the nation's best rushing attack with 356 yards per game.

- A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in seven of the last ten years.

DEFENSIVE ROTATION: Chattanooga owns the top defensive unit in the conference as the Mocs rank tenth in the nation for total defense. Chattanooga has given up just 297 yards per game this season.

- Wofford led the league in total defense last season, marking the eighth straight season a different school led the SoCon in total defense. Chattanooga is the only team that has not led the league in total defense, dating back to 2003.

PLAYOFF POWER: Georgia Southern reached the semifinals of the FCS Playoffs in 2010 for the first time since 2002 when the Eagles fell to Western Kentucky 31-28, in Statesboro, Ga. The Southern Conference has had at least one team reach the semifinals 11 times in the last 13 years.

- The SoCon placed three teams in the quarterfinals last year. The league also had three teams in the quarterfinals in 2001, 1995 and 1996.

CHAMPIONSHIP STREAK: Georgia Southern won the 2011 SoCon Championship, snapping Appalachian State's six-year run where the Mountaineers won at least a share of the conference championship. Appalachian State was just the second SoCon team to win six league titles in a row.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 954, ten points higher than the national average of 944 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Seven of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (66 percent) for FCS programs.

CAUGHT IN THE DRAFT: The Southern Conference had five players taken in the 2011 NFL Draft in April. The five draftees were the most taken in the draft since 1992 when five SoCon student-athletes were also selected.

- Defensive Back Cortez Allen of The Citadel was the first SoCon player taken off the board when he was chosen 128th overall (4th round) by the Pittsburgh Steelers.
- Chattanooga's Buster Skrine (DB) was selected in the fifth round (#137 overall) by the Cleveland Browns.
- Appalachian State had a trio of players taken. Defensive Back Mark LeGree was selected in the fifth round by Seattle (#156) while offensive lineman Daniel Kilgore was taken with pick #163 by San Francisco. Linebacker D.J. Smith was chosen by the Green Bay Packers in the sixth round (#186).

SoCon Sports Network: This summer the conference office announced a three-year partnership with Public Television to carry Southern Conference football games. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon football games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry Southern Conference football games. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced this fall for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
