SPARTANBURG, S.C. – Defending Southern Conference men's soccer tournament champion Furman was picked to win the league in 2015 in voting among the six league head coaches, who also selected an 11-member preseason all-conference team. Mercer, the defending regular-season champion, and Wofford had

three selections each.

Furman, which received votes in the preseason NSCAA top 25, collected four first-place votes and 24 total points in the preseason SoCon poll, while Mercer was close behind with 20 points and one first-place vote. UNCG finished third in the poll with 16 points, followed by ETSU with 13 points and the remaining first-place vote. Wofford was fifth with 12 points, with VMI (five points) rounding out the poll.

News & Notes

- The 2015 regular season opens on Friday, Aug. 28, with all six league schools in action. Wofford hosts Gardner-Webb in the lone home contest, while four squads will face Power 5 opponents. In true road contests, ETSU will take on No. 11 Clemson, Mercer will face South Carolina, UNCG will play at Virginia Tech and VMI will face former Big South foe Longwood. Furman will take on NC State in Mt. Pleasant, S.C.
- 2014 SoCon Men's Soccer Championship winner Furman is the preseason favorite to win the 2015 league title (see below). The Paladins edged last year's regular-season winner, Mercer, for the top spot in the poll. Furman also recevied votes in the NSCAA preseason top 25 poll. The Paladins were ranked as high as No. 19 nationally last season.
- The SoCon produced eight NSCAA/Continental Tire All-South Region selections last season, with six of them returning this season. Wofford's Matthew Aurednik was a first-team selection, while Furman's Sven Lissek and Mercer's Will Bagrou were second-team picks. ETSU forward Joao Ramalho, Furman defender Kevin Edelmann and Wofford forward Nestor Jaramillo were all third-team selections.
- Wofford's Aurednik was named to the MAC Hermann Trophy watch list heading into this season. The junior scored 10 goals for 20 points last season.
