Davidson's Stephen Curry Named SoCon Player of the Week

Davidson guard **Stephen Curry** was named the Southern Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for the week ending January 27.

The sophomore averaged 24.3 points in three games last week. Curry made 25-of-50 (50.0 percent) from the field and was 13-of-27 (48.2 percent) from three-point range while converting 10-of-12 (83.3 percent) from the free throw line. He dished out eight assists and had five steals.

The Charlotte, N.C. native ranks fifth nationally in scoring with a 23.9 average.

Davidson recorded an 82-67 win at Western Carolina coupled with an 87-70 victory at The Citadel and a 70-58 triumph at College of Charleston.

Other standout performances were turned in by Wofford's Junior Salters, UNC Greensboro's Ben Stywall, Elon's Ola Atoyebi, Western Carolina's Brandon Giles, Appalachian State's Donald Sims, Chattanooga's Kevin Bridgewater and The Citadel's Austin Dahn.

Tournament Seeding Procedures

The team with the best overall conference won-loss percentage in the North and South Divisions shall receive the top two seeds in the conference tournament. Other seeds for the tournament shall be determined based on each team's overall Conference won-loss percentage regardless of division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed, the seed shall be determined as follows:

- A. If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- B. If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie;
- C. If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- D. If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's Rating Percentage Index (RPI) as published by RPIratings.com after the completion of the last regular season game;
- E. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- F. If the teams are still tied, the team's records against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so forth until the tie is broken;
- G. If there is still a tie, the seeded position of the teams will be determined by comparing each team's RPI ratings as published by RPIratings.com,
- H. For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie; and
- I. For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian State



■ Appalachian State's 89-77 loss at Chattanooga on Jan. 26 snapped a seven-game winning streak for the Mountaineers, the 10th longest in the nation at the time.

■ Since scoring 52 points at Wofford on Jan. 10, the Mountaineers had averaged 86.4 points in the next five outings before slipping past Elon, 56-56, on Jan. 28.

■ Jeremy Clayton needs seven blocked shots to become Appalachian State's all-time leader.

Elon



■ Junior forward Ola Atoyebi scored 23 points and grabbed five rebounds as Elon fell to SoCon foe Western Carolina on Jan. 24. Atoyebi made 10-of-14 shots from the floor along with all three free throws in the contest.

■ Elon takes to the road this week with in-state games at Appalachian State (56-52 loss on Jan. 28) and at UNC Greensboro (Jan. 2). The five-game road swing continues next week with contests at Davidson (Feb. 6) and at Wofford (Feb. 9). The Phoenix are 2-8 on the road this season.

■ The Phoenix close out the regular season by playing five of their final six games at home.

UNC Greensboro



■ Defense has been a major reason the Spartans have won nine of their last 11 games. UNC Greensboro is yielding 62.0 points in the nine wins and 83.5 points in the two losses.

■ Kyle Hines became UNC Greensboro's all-time leading rebounder at The Citadel on Jan. 26. With 933 career boards, he passed Bruce Shaw (933).

■ UNC Greensboro's 88-71 triumph at College of Charleston on Jan. 24 was the first-ever win at Kresse Arena for the Spartans. Coach Mike Dement's Spartans handed the Cougars their worst home loss in 23 seasons.

■ For the second straight week, Ben Stywall's big second half propelled UNC Greensboro to victory. He scored 27 of his 36 points last week in the second half. His 21 points against The Citadel was a season-high for the sophomore.

Chattanooga



■ Senior guard Kevin Bridgewaters scored a season-high 20 points in an 89-77 win over Appalachian State on Jan. 26. He was a perfect 9-for-9 from the free throw line and grabbed seven rebounds and dished out four assists.

■ The Mocs had six players in double figures in the victory over Appalachian State, equaling the most players to score in double digits this season.

■ In his first start at Chattanooga, Qavotstaraj Waddell registered a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds in 26 minutes of action against the Mountaineers.

Western Carolina



■ After falling at Wofford, 83-73 on Jan. 26, the Catamounts fell to 0-9 on the road this season. The Catamounts begin a three-game homestand with games against Georgia Southern (Jan. 28), Appalachian State (Feb. 2) and Chattanooga (Feb. 4).

■ Sophomore guard Brandon Giles averaged 22.3 points in three contests last week and stretched his consecutive double-digit scoring streak to 10 games.

■ Senior Negus McKenna has connected on 13 of his last 15 three-point goal attempts. He was 8-of-10 from three-point range against Elon and a perfect 5-for-5 at Wofford.



SOUTH DIVISION

College of Charleston



■ Jermaine Johnson registered his 10th double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds against Davidson on Jan. 26.

■ Freshman Andrew Goudelock is second on the team in scoring with a 12.9 average. His 258 points is the fifth highest total since College of Charleston moved to Division I in 1991-92.

■ The Cougars lost, 67-66, on a last-second shot at Wofford on Jan. 28. College of Charleston won the first meeting, a 70-60 decision on Jan. 17. The Cougars had beaten the Terriers five consecutive times and 17 of 20 times since becoming a member of the Southern Conference in 1998-99.



The Citadel

■ The Citadel lost the first game of a four-game road trip to Furman (53-51 on Jan. 31). The road trip continues with SoCon contests at College of Charleston (Feb. 4), Appalachian State (Feb. 9) and Elon (Feb. 11).

■ The Bulldogs have lost nine straight games since a 71-63 win over Cornell (Iowa) on Dec. 31 but three of the losses were by margins of two, three and four points.



Davidson

■ Davidson has won 10 consecutive games and 22 straight SoCon regular-season contests and 35 of its last 36 against SoCon competition. The Wildcats are 12-0 in league play for the third time in coach Bob McKillops' tenure.

■ Stephen Curry averaged 24.3 points as the Wildcats downed Western Carolina (82-67), The Citadel (87-70) and College of Charleston (70-58) last week. He shot 50.0 percent (25-of-50) from the field with 13 three-pointers and converted 10-of-12 free throws.

■ As conference play reaches the midway point, it is worth noting that the last SoCon team to go undefeated in league play was Davidson (16-0) in 2004-05.



Furman

■ Furman beat The Citadel, 53-51 on Jan. 30, in the 187th meeting between the two schools, the longest running active SoCon series. Furman leads the series 108-78 and has won 10 of the last 11.

■ Freshman Daryl Evans scored a career-high 10 points, making 3-of-5 from three-point range in a 62-53 loss at Georgia Southern on Jan. 26.

■ Furman has scored 70 or more points just once in its last 10 outings.



Georgia Southern

■ Georgia Southern is 8-6 away from Statesboro, Ga. this season following a 69-58 win at Western Carolina on Jan 28. The Eagles play at Chattanooga on Jan. 31 to close out the month.

■ Coach Jeff Price's team is one victory short matching last year's victory total (15-16 overall and 7-11 in conference play in 2006-07).

■ A crowd of 4,082 was on hand to witness Georgia Southern's 62-53 victory over Furman on Jan. 26, the sixth largest crowd in Hanner Fieldhouse history and the largest since March 11, 1992.



Wofford

■ The Terriers had their four-game winning streak snapped, 78-65, at Davidson on Jan. 30. Wofford averaged 79.0 points per game during the winning streak.

■ Wofford trailed both Georgia Southern (9) and Western Carolina (7) at halftime before pulling out come-from-behind victories.

■ Guard Junior Salters, a sophomore, scored a career-high 26 points in an 83-73 win over Western Carolina, the most points scored by a Terrier player this season.

Coach Jimmy Tillette's team was 15-16 in 2006-07 with an RPI of 76. Samford currently competes in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Bulldogs are 9-12 (6-7 in the OVC) as of Jan. 30, 2008. The Bulldogs lost to Murray State, 62-34, on Jan. 29. They face Tennessee State on Jan. 31 in Nashville, Tenn.
