Quick Hits

- Davidson has clinched a first-round bye in the SoCon Tournament.
- Georgia Southern's 10-game improvement in league play is tied for the third best turnaround in league history.
- Four league teams will participate in BracketBusters on Saturday, February 18. Davidson and Appalachian State will be at home, while College of Charleston and Wofford are on the road. The SoCon is 17-12 all-time in BracketBusters.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated U.S. Cellular Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

Player of the Week

UNCG's Trevis Simpson has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week. Simpson averaged 26.5 points per game last week as UNCG picked up road wins at Samford and Chattanooga.

The sophomore has scored at least 23 points in each of his last six games and is averaging 25.7 points per contest over that stretch, while UNCG is 5-1 in those games.

Simpson poured in a game-high 25 points and seven rebounds at Samford as the Spartans came away with a two-point victory. On the road at Chattanooga, Simpson tallied 24 points on 11-of-18 shooting, including 18 points in the second half. Trailing by four with 1:29 to play, Simpson hit a three-pointer to pull the Spartans to within one before teammate Derrell Armstrong scored with 16 seconds left to lift UNCG to the win.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Mike Neal, College of Charleston's Antwaine Wiggins, The Citadel's Ashton Moore, Davidson's De'Mon Brooks, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, Chattanooga's Omar Wattad, Samford's Tyler Hood, Western Carolina's Brandon Boggs and Wofford's Brad Loesing.





MOUNTAINEERS **NORTH DIVISION**

Mike Neal scored a game-high 23 points and senior Isaac Butts added a season-high 16 rebounds as Appalachian State downed Chattanooga (79-70) Wednesday night. Nathan Healy added 11 points for ASU.

The Mountaineers recorded seven blocked shots in the win. ASU leads the Southern Conference with 4.1 blocks per game.

The Mountaineers host Winthrop Saturday afternoon in a BracketBuster matchup. ASU travels to The Citadel February 22.



COUGARS **SOUTH DIVISION**

Trent Wiedeman posted a double-double with 21 points and 18 rebounds but College of Charleston fell to UNCG 78-63 Wednesday. Antwaine Wiggins and Andrew Lawrence each added 11 for the Cougars, who shot just 36 percent from the field in the loss.

The Cougars will participate in their third consecutive ESPN Sears BracketBusters game traveling to Kent State on Feb. 18 in a rematch of the only meeting between the two in the 2003 NIT First Round.

Following Saturday's BracketBuster matchup, the Cougars will host Georgia Southern February 23.



PHOENIX **NORTH DIVISION**

Sophomore Jack Isenbarger scored a team-high 17 points while Ryley Beaumont and Lucas Troutman scored 10 points apiece, but Elon lost at Wofford 72-59 Wednesday. The Phoenix were held to just 4-of-15 shooting from beyond the arc.

The Phoenix has eight league wins, the most under head coach Matt Matheny. Elon is one win shy of tying the most overall victories under Matheny (14).

The Phoenix host Western Carolina Saturday afternoon. Elon will travel to Davidson next Thursday.



BULLDOGS **SOUTH DIVISION**

Freshman guard Ashton Moore, who hit a perfect 10-of-10 from the free throw line against Georgia Southern (Feb. 11) became the first Citadel player to hit 10 free throws in a game, since Cameron Wells converted 11 free throws against Wofford (Feb. 5, 2011).

Mike Groselle enters the week tied with Patrick Elmore for most single season double-doubles in program history. Groselle, who has 12 this season, has tied a mark set by Patrick Elmore in 1989-90.

The Bulldogs visit Western Carolina Thursday.



SPARTANS **NORTH DIVISION**

Darrell Armstrong scored 30 points and Aloysius Henry added a season-high 22 as the Spartans topped College of Charleston Wednesday night (78-63).

UNCG's ten SoCon victories are the most since the 2007-08 squad won 12 league games.

Sophomore Trevis Simpson needs just 29 points to become the ninth player in school history to score 500 points in a season.

The Spartans travel to Georgia Southern Saturday night.



WILDCATS **SOUTH DIVISION**

Davidson needs one more win to claim the South Division crown.

The Wildcats have won 22 of their last 25 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season.

Davidson has won 18 of its last 19 in Belk Arena with the lone loss coming to Vanderbilt on December 7. The Wildcats will host Samford Wednesday evening.

The Wildcats will host Wichita State in a BracketBusters game Feb. 18, at noon in Belk Arena. The game will be televised on ESPN2.



BULLDOGS **NORTH DIVISION**

Guard Rajion Kelly scored 14 points for Samford but the Bulldogs fell at Davidson Wednesday night. Despite the loss the Bulldogs hold a half-game lead over Appalachian State for third place in the North Division.

Samford's Jeffrey Merritt made 38th consecutive start Wednesday in a streak that began Jan. 27, 2011, at Elon. The Bulldogs' senior guard has started in 86 of the team's last 88 games dating back to the beginning of his sophomore season in 2009-10.

Samford hosts Furman Saturday afternoon.



PALADINS **SOUTH DIVISION**

Charlie Reddick scored a game-high 16 points and Bryant Irwin added 14 off the bench as Furman held off Western Carolina 80-66, Saturday. The Paladins shot 54 percent from the field in the win.

The Paladins rank second in the conference in scoring defense, as they have yielded just 65.6 points per game. Furman leads the conference in defending the three-point arc. The Paladins' opponents are shooting just 30 percent from three-point range.

Furman travels to Samford Saturday afternoon.



MOCS **NORTH DIVISION**

Dontay Hampton and Ronrico White came off the bench to score 17 and 16 points, respectively, in Chattanooga's 79-70 loss at Appalachian State Thursday night.

Senior guard Keegan Bell has 514 assists at Chattanooga. He is 16 assists from the 10th-most in SoCon history (530, Kevin Young, Western Carolina, 1979-82).

Senior guard Ricky Taylor is eight points shy of 1200 for his career.

The Mocs host The Citadel Saturday night at McKenzie Arena.



EAGLES **SOUTH DIVISION**

Sophomore Eric Ferguson ranks fifth in the league in scoring (15.4 ppg) and is third in rebounding (7.2 rpg). He is one of just two players to rank in the top five in both categories. Ferguson is shooting 57 percent from the field which is the fourth best mark in the conference.

After winning just one league game last season, Georgia Southern has 11 conference wins through 15 games. The Eagles are currently in second place in the South Division.

Georgia Southern will host UNCG Saturday night.



CATAMOUNTS **NORTH DIVISION**

Senior Harouna Mutombo has moved into 15th-place in WCU history with 1,434 career points, passing former standouts Brandon Giles (1,424, 2006-10) and Harris Pryor (1,429, 1956-59). Mutombo is fourth in school history with 175 career steals, while senior Keaton Cole has moved into sixth in school history with 169 career 3-pointers.

Three of WCU's final four games will be played at home beginning with Thursday night's meeting with The Citadel Bulldogs.



TERRIERS **SOUTH DIVISION**

Wofford is 17-11 following Wednesday's win over Elon. With just three games left in the regular season, the Terriers are assured a .500 season or better for the fifth straight season.

Kevin Giltner poured in a game-high 26 points in Wednesday's win over the Phoenix.

Wofford is 15-1 when leading at the half this season.

The Terriers travel to Charleston Southern Saturday night for a BracketBusters matchup against the Buccaneers.

Conference News and Notes

One Possession Games

The Southern Conference has played 91 league games as of February 15. A total of 29 games (32 percent) have either been decided by one possession or gone into overtime.

- There have been eight games that have gone to overtime, while 21 contests have been decided by one possession at the end of regulation.

Moving Forward

Georgia Southern has won 11 conference games this season after going 1-15 in league play last year. The Eagles' nine-game improvement is among the best mark in league history.

Athletes of the Month

Jake Cohen earned Player of the Month honors in January as he averaged 18.5 points, 6.4 rebounds and 1.7 blocked shots per game in a 7-1 month for the Wildcats. The junior forward had five consecutive games with 20-plus points and two double-doubles during the month. Cohen shot 59 percent from the floor, 50 percent from 3-point range and 88 percent from the free-throw line for the month.

Antwaine Wiggins was earned December Athlete of the Month honors in men's basketball. Wiggins led College of Charleston to a 5-2 record in the month. He averaged a team-and conference-leading 18.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Wiggins tied a career-high with 24 points against his home state Tennessee Vols, including 15 in the second half of play. Wiggins also reached a milestone of his own becoming the 29th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points with his jumper at the 8:32 minute mark of the first half at Louisville on Dec. 20.

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball in November. Groselle recorded five double-doubles during the month. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 78.8 points per game.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

Southern Conference News and Notes

Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the L.A. Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.

SoCon Championship

The 2012 Southern Conference Men's Basketball Championship will be held March 2-5 in Asheville, N.C., at the newly renovated U.S. Cellular Center. The 2012 tournament will mark a return to Asheville, site of the men's basketball tournament from 1984-95.
