Preseason Men's Soccer Release

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – For the second consecutive year, the 2021 regular-season Southern Conference champion, UNC Greensboro, has been selected as the preseason frontrunner to claim the 2022 SoCon men's soccer title in voting completed by the league's six head coaches. The Spartans, led by head coach Chris Rich, will be looking to capture their seventh championship title in program history and their first since 2020-21.

The Southern Conference men's soccer head coaches also selected an 11-member preseason all-conference team, with UNCG garnering four selections total, Furman, Mercer and Wofford collecting two each, and ETSU securing one. The coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team or players in the balloting process.

UNCG amassed five first-place votes and finished with a total of 25 points, while Mercer accumulated one first place vote and finished tied for second with Furman, with both teams earning 19 points. ETSU clinched the fourth-place position and was separated from Mercer and Furman by seven points, finishing with a total of 12 points. Wofford (10) and VMI (5) were separated by five points and concluded the poll with a fifth-place and sixth-place finish, respectively.



Notes

- The 2022 Southern Conference men's soccer season will commence this week with all six SoCon teams competing on Thursday, Aug. 25, including preseason favorite UNCG, who hosts UNC Asheville for a non-conference match at UNCG Soccer Stadium in Greensboro, North Carolina.
- The Spartans have won the regular season or tournament title three times in the last three years and will be looking to capture their seventh championship title in program history.
- Mercer won the 2021 Southern Conference Men's Soccer Championship with a 4-3 win over No. 4 seed Belmont in the title game after defeating No. 3 seed Furman in the semifinal round, 4-0. It was the Bears' fourth title since joining the league in
- Mercer and Furman garnered 19 points each in the preseason poll and have both been predicted to finish second by the conference's coaches, with the Bears earning one first-place following their victory in the championship last season.
- The Spartans received votes in College Soccer News' 2022 preseason poll and are ranked No. 29 following a successful 2021 season as the SoCon regular-season champions.
- The Bears put senior midfielders Ousman Jabang and Dylan Gaither, who earned first-team and second-team all-conference honors, respectively, last season, on this year's preseason squad. Gaither was also named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player, and joined Ousman on the 2021 All-Tournament team.
- UNCG's JC Ngando, who collected Freshman of the Year, All-SoCon first-team and All-Freshman awards and was named to the United Soccer Coaches' All-South Region Third Team and College Soccer News All-Freshman Team a season ago, will return to the midfield for his sophomore season.
- Mercer graduate forward Trevor Martineau opens the 2022 season as the active career leader in points (75), goals (28), assists (19) and game-winning goals (12).
- UNCG junior goalkeeper Niclas Wild, who was the 2021 Goalkeeper of the Year and an All-SoCon firstteam selection a season ago, returns for the 2022 season as the active career leader in wins (19) and shutouts (13), while sitting in second for saves (65).
- The Spartans ended the 2021 season as the national leader in corner kicks per game (8.00), goal differential (38), points per game (8.39), and scoring offense (2.89).
- Two teams will be under new direction this year. David Lilly (ETSU) and Nick Regan (VMI) will lead their respective teams this year for the first time, marking Lilly's and Regan's inaugural campaign as head coaches for the Bucs and Keydets.
