• Three teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll. Furman moved to No. 5, with Georgia Southern jumping five spots to No. 16. Appalachian State claims the No. 19 spot in this week's poll. Western Carolina, Wofford and Chattanooga also received votes.

• The ESPN/USA Today Poll has three SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman remains in the top 10 at No. 5 with Georgia Southern climbing five spots to No. 16. Appalachian State remains in the top 20 at the No. 19 spot. Western Carolina, Wofford and Chattanooga all received votes.

• Appalachian State's Richie Williams became the first Southern Conference player in league history to pass for over 6,000 yards and rush for over 1,000 yards in a career. His 7,137 total yards of offense is seventh in league annals.

• Wofford will step out of conference this weekend for a match-up with former SoCon member VMI at 1:30 in Spartanburg, SC. Western Carolina will take the week off.

Around the SoCon This Week

Appalachian State (3-2, 1-1 SoCon)

Appalachian State recorded 468 yards of offense in its 34-31 loss to Furman on Saturday...QB **Richie Williams** rushed for 124 yards for his fourth career 100-yard game and also passed for 272 yards and two touchdowns...Williams became the school's career leader in total offense with 7,137 career yards and just the seventh player in SoCon history to record at least 7,000 yards of total offense...He also became the first player in SoCon history to pass for at least 6,000 yards and rush for at least 1,000 yards in a career on Saturday at Furman...WR **Jermame Little** caught eight passes for 67 yards, one of seven different receivers to catch a pass...Two of DL **Marques Murrell's** eight tackles went for a loss, giving him a league-leading 11 on the season...The Mountaineers host Georgia Southern on Saturday in a game that will be televised on FSN South, marking the team's first home conference game of the season — and their first home contest since Sept. 17.

The Citadel (2-3, 1-1 SoCon)

The Bulldogs dropped a 27-7 decision at Mississippi on Saturday, the team's second loss to a I-A school this year...The Citadel managed only 81 yards of total offense...On defense, the Bulldogs forced three turnovers, including a 44-yard interception return for a touchdown by SS **Avery Dingle**...It was Dingle's second INT this season and the second longest by a SoCon player this season...The Citadel defense tallied 10 tackles behind the line of scrimmage...SS **Joshua Lawson** registered a team-best 11 tackles, including two for a loss of minus 12 yards...P **Mark Kaspar** punted nine times in the game, dropping two of them inside the 20...The Citadel hosts Furman on Saturday, the first of two home games in the next three weeks.

Chattanooga (4-2, 1-1 SoCon)

The Mocs moved to 4-2 on the season with a 24-21 win at Liberty last Saturday...The 3-1 mark in non-conference games is the team's best since going 3-0 back in 1997...UTC has won two in a row for the second time this year...The Mocs won the game on a 29-yard field goal by **Esteban Lopez** as time expired...UTC scored 10 points in the final 2:13 to pull off the road victory...RB **Eldra Buckley** rushed for 111 yards on 21 carries, while **Lironnie Davis** tallied 98 yards on only 15 carries...Davis also scored twice, once on the ground and the other on a catch...QB Antonio Miller was 21-for-35 for 179 yards and a TD...WR **Emanuel Hassell** had a game-high eight catches for 81 yards and has caught a league-best 36 balls this year...The Mocs travel to Elon in search of their first three-game win streak since 1997.

Elon (3-3, 0-2 SoCon)

The Phoenix lost a 14-9 decision at Wofford last week, its second straight conference defeat...LB **Chad Nkang** registered 15 tackles, including a season-high 10 solo stops...He also added a tackle for a loss, a forced fumble, a blocked kick and a safety...DL **Mark Jetton** recorded a career-high nine tackles, three of them coming behind the line of scrimmage, as well as a sack...RB **Joe Baptiste** rushed for a career-high 59 yards...Elon hosts Chattanooga on Saturday, its last home game until Nov. 19 against Appalachian State.

Furman (5-1, 1-1 SoCon)

Furman picked up its first league win of the season against Appalachian State, 34-31, snapping a three-game losing streak to the Mountaineers...QB **Ingle Martin** was 15-for-26 for 252 yards and two TDs...Martin also averaged 45.7 yards on three punts and is second in the SoCon in punting (42.4)...LB **William Freeman** blocked a potential game-tying 41-yard field goal as time expired to secure the Paladin victory...Freeman had a game-high 11 tackles, the sixth most in his career...RB **Jerome Felton** carried the ball 16 times for 72 yards...The Paladins converted five of six chances in the red zone...Furman didn't commit a turnover in the game with ASU, the team's first since the Chattanooga game in 1997 (30 games)...Furman heads to Charleston to play The Citadel on Saturday.

Georgia Southern (4-2, 3-1 SoCon)

Georgia Southern won for the third time in a row with a 45-7 win over Western Carolina...The Eagles recorded 374 yards on the ground, including 149 from **Jayson Foster** and 117 from **Jermame Austin**...Foster, who scored twice on rushes, also passed for a career-high two TDs...Foster's 149 yards was a career best and was also his sixth straight 100-yard game — tied for the ninth most in one season in conference history...GSU was a perfect 7-for-7 on fourth down conversions and are 14-for-17 on the season (league-high 82.4 percent)...LB **John Mohring** was credited with eight tackles, including one for a loss...No other GSU defender had more than four tackles...The Eagles face Appalachian State on the road Saturday in Boone, their final conference road game.

Western Carolina (2-3, 1-2 SoCon)

The Catamounts lost their third straight game at Georgia Southern, 45-7...It was also their 11th consecutive defeat to the Eagles...QB **Justin Clark** was 13-for-22 for 149 yards and a TD...RB **Darius Fudge** rushed for 68 yards and added 28 more on three receptions...Four different receivers caught at least three balls...WCU had the ball for only 10:29 in the second half...The Catamounts are idle this week and return to action on Oct. 22 at Chattanooga.

Wofford (3-2, 2-1 SoCon)

Wofford won its Homecoming game against Elon last Saturday, 14-9...The win for the Terriers was their 16th in their last 17 games at home...Wofford followed up a loss (25-13 vs. UTC on Oct. 1) with a win for the 12th consecutive time...The Terriers registered 307 yards on the ground and were led by 111 yards from **Corey Dunn**...**Gabriel Jackson** added 97 yards, that included an 80-yard run for a touchdown...RB **Michael Hobbs** also added 66 yards on 16 carries...The team had only two catches on the day, both going to **Colby Harris**...Five different defenders led the team with six tackles apiece...**Brian Kemp** intercepted his second pass of the season, while **Dan Tavani** recorded his first...The Terriers host VMI in non-conference action on Saturday.

Players of the Week

Richie Williams, Appalachian State Sr., QB, 6-3, 190-lb., Camden, SC

The 6-3, 190-lb. quarterback from Camden, SC, led the Mountaineers in ASU's 34-31 loss to No. 6-ranked Furman on Saturday. Williams was 23-of-31 for 272 yards passing and picked up 124 passing yards with two touchdowns, giving him 6,059 career yards of passing and 1,078 career rushing yards. His 7,137 career yards of total offense broke the ASU record of 7,129 yards, set by Steve Brown from 1977-80. Williams became the first player in Southern Conference history to accumulate at least 6,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards in a career. He also became just the seventh player in league annals to top the 7,000-yard career mark.

William Freeman, Furman

Sr., LB, 6-3, 240-lb., Swansea, SC

Freeman, a 6-3, 240-lb. senior from Swansea, SC, led the Paladins to a 34-31 win over Appalachian State. The linebacker blocked a potential game-tying 41-yard field goal attempt as time expired to preserve the win for Furman. Freeman notched a game-high 11 tackles, including two tackles-for-loss for 15 yards. He anchored the defense that limited Appalachian State to only three third-down conversions in 11 attempts.

VMI (3-3, 2-0 Big South) at Wofford (3-2, 2-1 SoCon), 1:30
Gibbs Stadium (13,000) • Spartanburg, SC



THE GAME: This will be the 17th meeting between these two teams with the Keydets holding a 10-6 advantage...However, the Terriers are 6-1 against VMI since joining Division I-AA in 1995...VMI's last win against Wofford came in a 27-16 decision in 2002...The series between these two teams dates back to 1924, VMI's first year in the Southern Conference...The Keydets left the SoCon in 2003...Wofford is coming off a 14-9 win over Elon at home, while VMI is coming off a 34-12 win over Charleston Southern.

THE COACHES: VMI head coach Cal McCombs (The Citadel '67) is in his seventh year as the head coach of the Keydets and has a record of 19-55 including a 3-3 mark this year, 2-0 in the Big South...McCombs was the 2002 Southern Conference Coach of the Year and spent most of his career in the SoCon . . . He was an assistant coach for 13 seasons from 1971-83 before moving to Air Force for 15 seasons from 1984-98...Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 113-82-1 in his 17 years at the helm...Ayers is 6-1 lifetime against VMI.

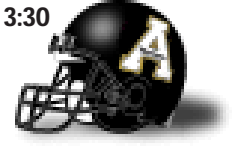


THE GAME: In a series that began in 1913 and ranks as the Southern Conference's oldest active rivalry Furman holds a 52-29-3 lead over The Citadel...Furman has claimed five wins in the last six meetings, including a 33-14 win last year in Greenville...The Paladins are coming off a 34-31 thrilling win over Appalachian State from Saturday where William Freeman tipped a field-goal attempt in the final seconds to clinch the win for Furman...Furman's 5-1 record is its best six-game start under Bobby Lamb...QB Ingle Martin needs 136 yards to pass Lamb for fourth place on the school's career passing list...The Citadel returns to league action after falling 27-7 to Mississippi on Saturday...It was the second Division I-A opponent for The Citadel, which faced Florida State earlier in the season.

THE COACHES: Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is in his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 2-3... Higgins was 56-26-1 at Lehigh from 1994-2000, his first collegiate head coaching position...This will be Higgins' first time facing the Paladins...Bobby Lamb (Furman '86) is in his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater in 2005...Lamb has compiled a 29-13 record while at the head of the Paladins program and is 2-1 against The Citadel.

THE GAME: The two teams meet for the 21st time, with the Eagles holding a 10-9-1 lead...GSU has won five of the last six meetings, including a 54-7 win in Statesboro a year ago...The last three meetings in Boone have been decided by a total of 17 points...RB Jermaine Austin's next 100-yard game will be his 29th and will move him into second place all-time in league annals...QB Jayson Foster has six consecutive 100-yard rushing games, tied for ninth in SoCon history...ASU QB Richie Williams, who has 7,137 yards of total offense in his career, needs 111 yards to move into fourth on the conference's career total yards list...Williams' next TD pass will be his 47th and will move him into second place in ASU history and tie him for fifth all-time in league history...GSU is coming off a 45-7 win over Elon, while ASU lost 34-31 at Furman.

THE COACHES: Mike Sewak (Virginia '81) is 31-12 in three-plus years as head coach of Georgia Southern and is 2-1 against Appalachian State...Since he joined GSU in 1997, the Eagles have compiled a 93-21 record and won national championships in 1999 and 2000...The winningest coach in Southern Conference football history, Jerry Moore (Baylor '61) is in his 17th season at the helm of the Mountaineer program in 2005...Moore has a 132-65 mark at Appalachian over the course of his 16-plus seasons with the school...Moore is 5-8 vs. GSU.



Chattanooga (4-2, 1-1 SoCon) at Elon (3-3, 0-2 SoCon), 6:00
Rhodes Stadium (11,250) • Elon, NC



THE GAME: This is only the third meeting between the two teams, with each team winning a game in the series...Elon won last year's meeting in Chattanooga 35-26...The Mocs, who won 24-21 last week at Liberty, are one win away from their first five-win season since 2000...UTC had 245 yards on the ground, marking the team's fourth straight game of 200 or more yards of rushing...RB Eldra Buckley had his second career 100-yard game of the season with 111 yards and ranks fifth in the league in rushing at 80.8 ypg...Elon LB Chad Nkang is averaging a league-high 12.8 tackles per game...QB Kye Hamilton needs four yards to become only the 13th player in school history to pass for 2,000 yards in a career.

THE COACHES: Rodney Allison (Texas Tech '80) is 9-20 in his third season as Mocs head coach and is 1-1 against the Phoenix...Allison came to Chattanooga from Clemson where he was the defensive ends coach from 1999-2002...Paul Hamilton (Appalachian State '81) is 6-11 in his second year as head coach of the Phoenix...Hamilton is 44-52 in nine years as a collegiate head coach and 5-3 all-time vs. Chattanooga, 1-0 at Elon.

This Date in Southern Conference History

Oct. 15, 1977: Furman used 589 yards of total offense to defeat Marshall, 42-24. The Paladins picked up 393 of the 589 yards of offense on the ground.

Oct. 15, 1977: Chattanooga used its fourth game of 1977 of 300 yards or more rushing as a team to take down Illinois State, 31-28. Illinois State scored eight points in the final stanza to put themselves within three, but the Mocs held on to start the season 5-1.

Oct. 15, 1983: Down 17-7 with a little under 10 minutes left against Gardner-Webb, Appalachian State scored 14 points in just under nine minutes, capped by an Alvin Parker touchdown run with 1:49 left in the fourth quarter, to defeat the Bulldogs 21-17 in Boone, N.C.

Oct. 15, 1994: NCAA Division I-AA's No. 1 ranked team, the Marshall Thundering Herd, handed Western Carolina its worst loss in SoCon play since 1991, downing the Catamounts 38-14 to take sole possession of first place in the conference standings with a 4-0 record, one game ahead of second-place WCU and Appalachian State.

Oct. 15, 1994: Reed Haley booted the Eagles of Georgia Southern to .500 overall after six games in 1994, when he hit a 27-yard field goal with 1:41 remaining to lift the Eagles past Appalachian State, 34-31.

Oct. 15, 1994: With a 52-44 loss to The Citadel at Paladin Stadium, Furman dropped its fourth straight overall to extend the Paladins' longest losing streak since 1979.

Oct. 15, 1994: Chris Parker ran for three touchdowns to give him 40 for his career in Marshall's 38-14 win over Western Carolina.

Oct. 15, 1983: Western Carolina tailback Melvin Dorsey racked up 117 yards to lead the Cats to their fifth straight win in a 37-20 victory over Wofford.

Oct. 15, 1994: Chattanooga picked up its first win in six weeks with a 49-14 decision over VMI at Chamberlain Field. The Mocs' rushing tandem of Terry Willburn and Stan Sullivan racked up 216 yards rushing, scoring three touchdowns to net a season-high 404 yards on the ground in Buddy Green's first SoCon win as coach of Chattanooga.

Oct. 15, 1994: Terrence Rivers ran for a career-high 217 yards in The Citadel's 52-44 win over Furman at Paladin Stadium, netting the Bulldogs their first SoCon win of 1994. Rivers total was the fourth-highest in Bulldogs history.

Oct. 15, 1994: After roaring back with 21 points in the fourth quarter to knot the game at 31-31, Appalachian State's rally fell short, as Reed Haley booted a 27-yard field goal with 1:41 left in the contest to give Georgia Southern a 34-31 win.
