PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Stephen Curry - Davidson

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - Davidson's Stephen Curry has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games December 2-8 the league office announced Tuesday (Dec. 9). Curry helped Davidson earn a 72-67 victory over NC State on Saturday (Dec. 6) in Charlotte. He tied his career high with 44 points, setting a new collegiate scoring record for most points at Time Warner Arena. Curry now owns facility scoring records at four different arenas including Holmes Center (Appalachian State), RBC Center, Time Warner Arena and Lloyd Noble Center (Oklahoma). The victory gave Davidson their first win over an ACC foe since defeating North Carolina 58-54 during the 2001-02 season.

Curry leads the nation in scoring with 31.3 points per game and ranks sixth nationally in three-point field goals per game (3.9). The Charlotte native averages 3.0 steals per game which ranks 12th nationally. Curry has scored at least 25 points in 10 of his last 11 games.

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Appalachian State has been the best rebounding team in the Southern Conference through six games. The Mountaineers lead the league with 43.0 rebounds per game, including 15.0 offensive rebounds per contest. ASU owns a +8.2 rebounding margin which ranks 25th in the nation.
- Appalachian State has started 2-0 in conference play for the second time in three years. The Mountaineers began the 2006-07 season 4-0 in league play, en route to a 15-3 mark. It is the third time they have started the league schedule 2-0 under Houston Fancher.
- The Mountaineers host former SoCon member East Tennessee State on December 13.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Senior Nicchaeus Doaks has recorded at least 10 rebounds in four of Chattanooga's six games this season. Doaks leads the league in rebounding (11.7 rpg) and is sixth in scoring (15.0 ppg). He has three double-doubles this season.
- Senior Stephen McDowell is third in the league in scoring (16.0 ppg) and ranks second in made three pointers per game (3.7 3fg).
- The Mocs were idle last week and return to the floor against Davidson on December 13.

ELON PHOENIX



- Sophomore Chris Long tied his career high with eight assists in games against The Citadel and College of Charleston last week. Long leads the conference with 6.8 helpers per game. The Phoenix lead the SoCon in assists (16.3) and rank third in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.1).
- Senior Brett James is just five points shy of the 1,000-point plateau. James is on pace to become just the 32nd player in school history to reach the career milestone. He is the league's active career leader in blocked shots with 71.
- The Phoenix host Lees-McRae College Friday night.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- UNC Greensboro is second in the league in blocked shots with 3.7 blocks per game. Damian Eargle is second in the conference with 1.6 blocked shots per contest.
- Mikko Koivisto became the eighth player in school history to record 150 career three-point field goals. He is only the second player to achieve the milestone, joining Scott Hartzell (UNCG's all-time leader with 309 treys).
- UNCG coach Mike Dement returns to his alma mater to face East Carolina on Saturday night. The Spartans won in his last return trip to Greenville on December 6, 2005, 78-70.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford has been one of the top defensive teams in the league this season. The Bulldogs lead the SoCon in both points allowed (59.8 ppg) and field goal percentage allowed (.394). The Bulldogs are also forcing the opposition into an average of 13.8 turnovers per game.
- Sophomore guard Josh Bedwell is second in the SoCon in free-throw percentage. The Hartselle, Ala., native owns a near-perfect 92.3 percentage from the charity stripe and has only missed one free throw this season (12-of-13). Despite Bedwell's shooting prowess, Samford is only shooting 58.5 percent from the charity stripe as a team.
- Samford will visit Saint Louis on Saturday (Dec. 13).

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina is second in the Southern Conference in rebounding with 40.2 rebounds per game. The Catamounts lead the league with 9.8 steals per game.
- Jake Robinson scored 18 points at Kent State. He has scored in double figures in each of the team's six games this season and 11 straight games dating back to last year.
- Western Carolina is off until December 15 when the Catamounts host Tennessee-Wesleyan at 7:00 p.m.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars (7-1) are off to their best start since opening the 2003-04 season with a 9-1 mark. CofC won its first two league openers for the first time since that same season.
- Head coach Bobby Cremins is just one win shy of 500 for his career. He currently ranks 69th on the NCAA's all-time victories list, while his 499 career wins ranks 17th on the active wins total list.
- The Cougars are off until December 17 when they host Coastal Carolina.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- After defeating West Virginia on Tuesday Davidson is 7-1, marking the best start since 1969-70 when the Wildcats opened the year 11-1 under Terry Holland.
- The Wildcats have been a force at both ends of the floor this season. Davidson leads the conference with 84.4 points per game. Defensively, the Wildcats lead the league by limiting their opponents to just 39 percent shooting from the field. Davidson is also tops in the conference with a +8.8 turnover margin.
- The Wildcats host Chattanooga December 13 in the league opener for both teams.

FURMAN PALADINS



- Sophomore Jordan Miller has dramatically increased his production from last year. Miller averaged 5.2 points and 2.1 rebounds per game as a freshman in 2007-08. He is eighth in the SoCon and leads the Paladins with 14.6 points per game this season. Miller is shooting 45 percent from the field.
- Bryson Barnes leads the SoCon with 2.0 blocked shots per game. Barnes has recorded at least one blocked shot in six of Furman's seven games this season.
- The Paladins have 12 days off before hosting North Florida on December 18.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Head coach Jeff Price ranks 13th all-time for most wins at a SoCon school with 160 victories at Georgia Southern. Price needs just nine more victories to pass Malcolm J. Pitt (Richmond) for 12th place.
- Senior Julian Allen has scored in double figures in each of his last five outings, the longest current streak on the team... He is averaging 12.2 ppg over that span.
- The Eagles travel to take part in the Drake Invitational December 12-13. GSU will face the host Drake Bulldogs on Saturday at 8:30 p.m.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Citadel's 57-50 win over UNC Greensboro marked the first time that the Bulldogs earned a victory in their conference opener since defeating Western Carolina to start the 2004-05 league slate. The win over the Spartans marked the first time The Citadel won their league opener on the road since defeating College of Charleston to start the 1988-89 conference season.
- Demetrius Nelson posted his first double-double of the season with 14 points and 12 rebounds against Elon. Nelson is 18th in the league in both scoring (12.7 ppg) and rebounding (5.6 rpg).
- The Bulldogs host UC Davis on December 15 before travelling to face Michigan State December 17.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- The Terriers have limited their opponents to just 30.3 rebounds per game, the best mark in the SoCon. Wofford ranks fourth in the conference with a +3.2 rebounding margin. Tim Johnson and Noah Dahlman both rank in the league's top 10 in rebounding.
- Junior Salters is now tenth all-time at Wofford with 141 career made three pointers.
- Wofford has 11 days off before the Terriers return to the hardwood when they host Union College on Wednesday, December 17.

CONFERENCE NOTES

RPI STRENGTH

The Southern Conference ranks sixth in the first Men's Basketball RPI Report, released December 8. The league has garnered the stop strength of schedule rating among 31 Division I conferences. Four of the league's teams (Western Carolina, 38; Davidson, 50; Wofford, 68, Georgia Southern, 92) all rank in the top 100.

STREAKING

Davidson will carry a 30-game conference winning streak into league play December 13 against Chattanooga. The Wildcats won their final 10 games during league play in 2006-07, before posting a 20-0 mark last year. Davidson's streak is the third-longest conference consecutive wins streak in league history.

- West Virginia won a league-best 44 straight conference games from 1956-1960. North Carolina won 34 straight league games from 1923-25.

TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Southern Conference teams are scheduled to take on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams will participate in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams are scheduled to participate in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

BRACKETBUSTERS 2009

Four Southern Conference teams will take part in the 2009 ESPNU BracketBusters event February 20-21. The event will feature 13 nationally televised games - on either ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU - selected from a pool of 102 teams.

- Davidson and Georgia Southern have been designated as home teams during the event, while Appalachian State and Elon will take to the road. The matchups for the 13 nationally televised games will be announced Feb. 2.

CONFERENCE NOTES

TOURNEY TIME

The 2009 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 6-9 at McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga. All 12 members of the Southern Conference will take part in the conference tournament. The championship game, scheduled for March 9, will be televised by ESPN2.

- The 2009 tournament will be the second time the league has held its conference championship in Chattanooga, after using the same site in 2005. The host Mocs downed UNC Greensboro, 65-62, in the final that year.

HALL OF FAME

Southern Conference Commissioner John Iamarino announced the formation of the SoCon Hall of Fame for 2009. The league will induct its inaugural class during a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C., on May 9. The Southern Conference is in its 88th season of intercollegiate competition and will begin recognizing many prominent student-athletes, coaches and administrators from the 43 current and former institutions that have been a part of the league's distinguished history.

- Among the nominees for consideration from Southern Conference men's basketball are Dick Groat (Duke), "Hot" Rod Hundley (West Virginia), Frank Selvy (Furman) and Jerry West (West Virginia).

EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches return to the bench for 2008-09. The current league head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

EXPERIENCE ON THE COURT

The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.

NEW MEMBERSHIP

Samford University, located in Birmingham, Ala., begins its first season as a member of the Southern Conference after officially joining the league on July 1, 2008. The Bulldogs, who play their home games in the 5,000-seat Pete Hanna Center, finished last season 14-16, including a 10-10 mark in Ohio Valley conference play.
