Quick Hits

- League teams open conference play this week, beginning Wednesday when Furman visits Elon.
- Southern Conference teams are 19-6 at home in non-conference play this season.
- The Citadel's Mike Groselle leads the league in both scoring (18.2 ppg) and rebounding (11.2 rpg).
- College of Charleston's Antwaine Wiggins is just 83 points away from 1,000 for his career.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated Asheville Civic Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

Player of the Week

Davidson's JP Kuhlman has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games played November 22-28 the league office announced Tuesday (Nov. 29). The junior guard scored 21 points on the road as Davidson topped UNC Wilmington (70-67) last week.

With the Wildcats holding a one-point lead late in the game, Kuhlman grabbed a defensive rebound and was fouled before hitting two free throws with 1.2 seconds remaining to push Davidson ahead, 70-67. The Ponte Vedra, Fla., native connected on 6-of-11 shots from the floor, including 3-of-6 from three-point range. He made six of seven

free throw attempts, grabbed seven rebounds and dished out two assists in 33 minutes against the Seahawks.

Kuhlman is tied for seven in the Southern Conference in scoring with 14.2 points per game.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Isaac Butts, College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, Samford's Drew Windler, Western Carolina's Brandon Boggs and Wofford's Kevin Giltner.

MOUNTAINEERS

NORTH DIVISION

Jamaal Trice increased his scoring output through each of the season's first four games, culminating with a 27-point performance against East Carolina. The junior sank five three-pointers for a second-straight game and leads ASU with a 16.2 scoring average on the season. He is shooting 51.6 percent from beyond the arc.

The Mountaineers open SoCon play with a pair of games against UNCG and at Georgia Southern. ASU looks to avenge last season's home setback to the Spartans on Thursday as the Appys have won four of the last five meetings. Saturday's contest against the Eagles will be the only regular season meeting between the teams.



COUGARS

SOUTH DIVISION

College of Charleston leads the league in field goal percentage, as the Cougars have hit better than 47 percent of their field goal attempts. CoFC also leads the league in three-point percentage, connecting on 38 percent of its attempts from beyond the arc.

Junior point guard Andrew Lawrence leads the league in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.3).

The Cougars host The Citadel Thursday night. CoFC then plays host to Chattanooga Saturday afternoon.



PHOENIX

NORTH DIVISION

Drew Spradlin surpassed the 1,000 career point plateau with his first three-pointer against Rutgers-Camden last week. He currently has 1,033 career points. He is currently fourth among active players in career scoring.

Elon ranks second in the SoCon with 8.2 made triples per game. Sophomore Sebastian Koch ranks second in the league with 2.8 made three-pointers per game.

The Phoenix host Furman Wednesday night. Elon then hosts Navy in non-conference play Saturday.



BULLDOGS

SOUTH DIVISION

Junior center Mike Groselle moved his consecutive double-double streak to six games over the weekend, following a 15-point, 13-rebound outing against High Point. Groselle, who established the program record for most consecutive double-doubles (five) against Florida Christian on Nov. 26, placed himself in a tie with Kent Hill for sixth most double-doubles in Citadel basketball history.

The Citadel's next four games on the docket will pit the Bulldogs against teams from the state of South Carolina. The Bulldogs are 403-443 (.476 winning pct.) in program history against teams from the Palmetto State.



SPARTANS

NORTH DIVISION

Korey VanDussen and Derrell Armstrong are tied for third place in the league in steals. Both players have averaged 2.0 steals through UNCG's first six games this season.

After six games the Spartans are averaging 16.5 offensive rebounds per game, highest mark in the league. UNCG has grabbed over 40 percent of the available offensive rebounds which is also tops in the SoCon.

The Spartans travel to Appalachian State Saturday. UNCG will visit Western Carolina Saturday afternoon.



WILDCATS

SOUTH DIVISION

The Wildcats have won 29 of their last 31 non-conference games at Belk Arena.

Davidson made all 14 free-throw attempts at Duke. It was the first time the 'Cats shot 100 percent from the free-throw line since 2008.

Davidson has had the lead at halftime in all five games this season.

The Wildcats travel to face Wofford Thursday night. Davidson returns home to play host to Furman Saturday evening.



BULLDOGS

NORTH DIVISION

With Samford's road win at UT Arlington on Saturday, the Bulldogs extended their winning streak in the series to four-consecutive games. Samford also took a 5-4 all-time lead in the series between the teams.

The Bulldogs knocked down a season-high 15 3-point baskets in Saturday's 71-69 victory at UT Arlington. Samford's 15 3-point field goals was its highest total from beyond the arc since a similar total of 15 was achieved against Chattanooga in the final game of the 2010-11 regular season.

PALADINS

SOUTH DIVISION

Furman limited its first five opponents to just 56.6 points per game, the lowest mark in the SoCon. The Paladins have also limited their opponents to just 39 percent shooting from the field.

Furman has also defended the paint well through the early portion of the season as the Paladins have averaged 3.8 blocked shots per game.

The Paladins open league play at Elon Wednesday night. Furman will then visit Davidson Saturday.



MOCS

NORTH DIVISION

Chattanooga won the championship of the Hoosier Classic Chattanooga Bracket. Senior Keegan Bell earned all-tourney honors for the Hoosier Classic.

Chattanooga leads the SoCon with 9.3 steals per game. Dontay Hampton has averaged 1.8 thefts per game for UTC.

The Mocs open their SoCon slate this week. UTC is 19-15 in league openers, 5-9 beginning on the road. The Mocs are 0-1 when opening against Georgia Southern, 0-1 in Statesboro.



EAGLES

SOUTH DIVISION

Georgia Southern is one of six SoCon teams with a positive rebounding margin. The Eagles ranks second in the conference in defensive rebounds with 32.2 per game.

The Eagles have made 46 percent of their field goal attempts this season, the second-best mark in the league. Willie Powers (.556) and Eric Ferguson (.516) are both shooting better than 50-percent from the field.

The Eagles host Chattanooga Thursday and welcome Appalachian State to Statesboro on Saturday.



CATAMOUNTS

NORTH DIVISION

Western Carolina snapped a three-game slide with a neutral court victory over Florida A&M to close play in the South Padre Island Invitational in South Padre Island, Texas. The Catamounts fell on the road at both Iowa State and Northern Iowa before making the trip to the southern tip of the Gulf Coast of Texas for two neutral floor games against Northern Colorado and FAMU.

WCU concludes its six-game road swing when it opens Southern Conference play Thursday at Samford. The Catamounts return home for their first game in the Ramsey Center since Nov. 15 (18 total days) as they welcome UNCG to Cullowhee in league play.



TERRIERS

SOUTH DIVISION

Senior guard Brad Loesing was named to the Chicago Invitational Challenge All-Tournament team.

The Terriers will open SoCon play on Thursday night against Davidson. The road team won both contests last season.

Wofford is opening a five-game homestand against Davidson. The Terrier will not be back on the road until December 21 at High Point.

Conference News and Notes

Familiar Faces

A total of 104 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2011-12. Three of the 12 schools boast at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams average 8.7 returners from 2010-11.

- Conference teams return 33 starters from last year, an average of 2.8 per team. Appalachian State, Davidson, Georgia Southern, UNCG and Chattanooga each return four starters. The Citadel, Furman and Wofford each return just one starter from last year.
- Just two players (Omar Cater - ASU and Omar Wattad - UTC) from the 2011 Coaches All-Conference team return for 2011-12.

Head Coaches

All 12 Southern Conference head coaches return to the bench in 2011-12. The current head coaches have a combined 71 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop eclipsed the 400-win plateau at Davidson last season while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. College of Charleston's Bobby Cremins, UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

Non-Conference Scheduling

Six of the 12 SoCon teams are scheduled to participate in an exempt tournament this year. SoCon teams will take part in the All-Military Classic (The Citadel), Battle for Atlantis (College of Charleston), Chicago Invitational (Wofford), Hoosier Classic (Chattanooga), Maui Invitational (UNCG) and South Padre Island Invitational (Western Carolina).

Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

Southern Conference News and Notes

Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

Freshman Honors

UNCG's Trevis Simpson was named to the league's all-freshman team in 2011. It was the third consecutive year that a Spartan was named to the league's all-freshman squad.

- Point guard Kyle Randall was named to the all-freshman team in 2010, while Damian Eargle was selected in 2009.

Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

Annual Leaders

Furman limited its opponents to just 64.4 points per game last season. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

Western Carolina's Mike Williams led the league in steals last year (2.0 spg) making it four consecutive seasons that a Catamount has led the Southern Conference in steals.

- Brigham Waginger, now an assistant coach at WCU, led the league in steals three consecutive seasons (2008-10).

College of Charleston led the league in scoring with 76.2 points per game. It was the second straight year the Cougars led the conference in offense after posting 75.0 points per game in 2010. The Cougars' 2,173 points last year was the seventh highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson led the Southern Conference in scoring four straight seasons from 2006-09.

College of Charleston also led the league with 306 made three-pointers last year, the fifth highest single-season total in league history.

- Elon connected on 285 made triples last season, which tied for the ninth-best single season total.
