Quick Hits

- Thursday's game between Samford and Georgia Southern will be available on ESPN3 while Saturday's Wofford-College of Charleston matchup will be televised on the SoCon Sports Network.
- Georgia Southern won just won league game last season but already has six victories through nine conference games this year.
- After dropping 11 straight games, UNCG has now won four in a row and are a half-game out of first place in the North Division.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated U.S. Cellular Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

Player of the Week

Derrell Armstrong has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games played January 17-23. The junior averaged 28 points and five rebounds in two games last week as the Spartans ran their win streak to four with victories against Chattanooga (81-72) and Samford (61-60).

Armstrong led the Spartans again on Sunday afternoon with 27 points in a last-second, one-point victory against Samford. The Mechanicsville, Md., native connected on 10-of-22 field goal attempts, including three triples. He also added five rebounds, two steals and a pair of assists.

The junior guard poured in a season-high 29 points Thursday against Chattanooga, going 10-of-16 from the field, 5-of-8 from three-point range and 4-of-5 at the line. He set season highs in both field goals (10) and three-pointers (5) while adding five rebounds, four assists and two steals.

Other top performers in the SoCon included Appalachian State's Andre Williamson, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Davidson's Jake Cohen, Elon's Lucas Troutman, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, Chattanooga's Omar Wattad, Samford's Tyler Hood, Western Carolina's Trey Sumler, and Wofford's Kevin Giltner.



MOUNTAINEERS

NORTH DIVISION

Andre Williamson continued his solid senior campaign last week with 15.0 points and 10.0 rebounds in two games. He notched his third double-double of the season against WCU and improved his shooting accuracy to 60.7 percent for the year. His 1.6 blocks per game lead the Southern Conference. ASU is 3-0 this season when Williamson notches a double-double.

ASU went to the foul line in eight-straight possessions on Saturday and knocked down 16 free throws in a row to ice an 84-72 home win over Western Carolina and return to just one half game behind division leader Elon.



COUGARS

SOUTH DIVISION

Senior Antwaine Wiggins ranks second in the SoCon and leads the Cougars with 16.6 points per game. Wiggins has scored in double figures in 17 of CofC's 19 games this season, including a season-high of 24 against Tennessee.

The Cougars rank third in the league with 7.1 steals per game. Junior Andrew Lawrence leads the league with 2.0 steals per contest.

The Cougars host Furman Thursday night. CofC welcomes Wofford to TD Arena Saturday afternoon.



PHOENIX

NORTH DIVISION

Elon has displayed a balanced scoring attack this season. Lucas Troutman leads the team with 12.9 points per game. Austin Hamilton averages 10.7 points, while Jack Isenbarger has scored 10.0 points per contest.

The Phoenix rank third in the Southern Conference with 37.3 rebounds per contest, but are last in rebounding margin (-4.2).

Elon travels to Western Carolina Thursday night. The Phoenix visit Appalachian State Saturday.



BULLDOGS

SOUTH DIVISION

The Bulldogs lost in double overtime at Georgia Southern Monday night. It was The Citadel's first double overtime game since January 12, 2002 when the Bulldogs defeated Western Carolina 105-97.

Junior center Mike Groselle has posted 10 double-doubles this season, moving him within two of Patrick Elmore's single-season school record of 12 which was set during the 1989-90 season.

The Bulldogs have made 261 second half field goals this season as opposed to a first half in which they have 214. The Citadel is 261-of-562 (.465) in the second half on the season.



SPARTANS

NORTH DIVISION

David Williams' layup with 2.8 seconds left helped the Spartans knock off Samford, 61-60 Sunday afternoon.

Sunday's victory over the Bulldogs gave UNCG its first four-game winning streak in league play since the 2007-08 season. It is also the Spartans' longest overall winning streak since they strung together five straight victories during the 2007-08 season.

UNCG will host Appalachian State Thursday night and welcomes Western Carolina to the Greensboro Coliseum Saturday afternoon.



WILDCATS

SOUTH DIVISION

The Wildcats have won 16 of their last 17 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season. Davidson is the last unbeaten team in league play this season.

Davidson averaged 83.5 points per game last week and had a margin of victory of +23.5. The Wildcats are outscoring their opponents by 10.4 points per game on the season.

The Wildcats visit Chattanooga Thursday night and travel to Samford Saturday.



BULLDOGS

NORTH DIVISION

Samford senior Jeffrey Merritt tallied his team-high fourth double-double of the season Sunday with 15 points and 11 rebounds at UNCG. He will be making his 30th consecutive start Thursday against Georgia Southern in a streak that began Jan. 27, 2011, at Elon. Merritt has started in 78 of the team's last 80 games dating back to the beginning of his sophomore season in 2009-10.

In their last three games, the Bulldogs' starting five consisting of Tyler Hood, Drew Windler, Jeffrey Merritt, Rajion Kelly and Will Cook has combined to score 70.3 of the team's 75.7 points per game.



PALADINS

SOUTH DIVISION

The Paladins are +3.3 in rebounding margin. Furman allows its opponents 30.9 rebounds per game, the lowest mark in the conference. The Paladins rebound 37.8 percent of the possible offensive rebounds, the highest mark in the league.

Richard Brown ranks third in the SoCon in assists-to-turnovers ratio (1.9) and fourth in the conference in free throw percentage (.848).

Furman visits College of Charleston Saturday night. The Paladins travel to The Citadel Saturday.



MOCS

NORTH DIVISION

The Mocs have given up just 66.5 points per game, the third best mark in the league. Chattanooga has limited its opponents to 39.4 percent shooting from the field, the best mark in the conference.

Keegan Bell leads the league with 6.9 assists per game and is tops in the SoCon with a 2.3 assists-to-turnover ratio. The senior guard is third in the conference with 35.7 minutes per game.

The Mocs host Davidson Thursday night at McKenzie Arena. Chattanooga will host Georgia Southern Saturday.



EAGLES

SOUTH DIVISION

Georgia Southern earned a 64-58 win over College of Charleston Saturday, snapping an eight-game losing skid to the Cougars.

The Eagles held off The Citadel 78-72 in double overtime Monday night. The two wins last week gave Georgia Southern its fifth and sixth league victories after recording just six overall wins a season ago.

Georgia Southern visits Samford Thursday night. The game can be seen on ESPN3.



CATAMOUNTS

NORTH DIVISION

Western Carolina went 1-1 last week with a road loss at SoCon North Division foe Appalachian State and a record-setting home win over nonconference opponent, Toccoa Falls. WCU set a school-record with the 102-point victory over the Eagles.

WCU opens a stretch of five games in 10 days on Thursday night as it hosts Elon in a North Division showdown in the Ramsey Center before the Catamounts travel to UNCG looking for a season sweep and ninth-straight win over the Spartans. The week concludes with WCU traveling to Wofford in the second meeting with the South Division's Terriers on Monday night in Spartanburg, S.C.



TERRIERS

SOUTH DIVISION

Wofford won on the road at Furman after trailing at the half for the first time this season. The Terriers came back from seven points down at the half for the win.

Wofford's team defense is first at 62.0 ppg, but the scoring offense is last in the SoCon at 64.0 ppg.

Wofford is averaging 72.2 points at home and only 57.3 points on the road. The Terriers are 8-1 at home and 3-6 on the road after Saturday's victory at Furman.

Conference News and Notes

Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 80.0 points per game.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

Cousy Nominees

Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, Davidson's JP Kuhlman and Western Carolina's Trey Sumler have been named to the Cousy Award Watch List. The Cousy Award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

Athletes of the Month

Antwane Wiggins was earned December Athlete of the Month honors in men's basketball. Wiggins led College of Charleston to a 5-2 record in the month. He averaged a team-and conference-leading 18.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Wiggins tied a career-high with 24 points against his home state Tennessee Vols, including 15 in the second half of play. Wiggins also reached a milestone of his own becoming the 29th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points with his jumper at the 8:32 minute mark of the first half at Louisville on Dec. 20.

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball in November. Groselle recorded five double-doubles during the month. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

Southern Conference News and Notes

Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

Freshman Honors

UNCG's Trevis Simpson was named to the league's all-freshman team in 2011. It was the third consecutive year that a Spartan was named to the league's all-freshman squad.

- Point guard Kyle Randall was named to the all-freshman team in 2010, while Damian Eargle was selected in 2009.

Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

Annual Leaders

Furman limited its opponents to just 64.4 points per game last season. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

Western Carolina's Mike Williams led the league in steals last year (2.0 spg) making it four consecutive seasons that a Catamount has led the Southern Conference in steals.

- Brigham Waginger, now an assistant coach at WCU, led the league in steals three consecutive seasons (2008-10).

College of Charleston led the league with 306 made three-pointers last year, the fifth highest single-season total in league history.

- Elon connected on 285 made triples last season, which tied for the ninth-best single season total.

SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.

SoCon Championship

The 2012 Southern Conference Men's Basketball Championship will be held March 2-5 in Asheville, N.C., at the newly renovated U.S. Cellular Arena. The 2012 tournament will mark a return to Asheville, site of the men's basketball tournament from 1984-95.
