QUICK HITS

The SoCon boasts three of the top four teams in the country this week in the Sports Network poll with Appalachian State ranked second, Elon third and Wofford fourth ... Six different SoCon teams are ranked in the top 25, although the fifth team differs in each poll - The Citadel (24) is ranked in the Sports Network poll while Georgia Southern (25) returns to the rankings in the Coaches Poll ... Furman is 19th in both polls ... SoCon teams averaged 10.9 points in the second half Saturday compared to 16.8 in the first half ... Wofford remains second nationally in both rushing offense and total offense while Appalachian State is fourth in both categories.

SOCON PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Offensive

Armanti Edwards, Appalachian State Jr., 6-0, 175, QB

Edwards accounted for 370 yards of offense and four touchdowns in Saturday's 35-24 SoCon win at Samford. In the win, he became only the seventh player in Division I history with 5,000 yards passing and 3,000 yards rushing in a career.

Defensive

D.J. Smith, Appalachian State So., 6-1, 215, LB

Smith matched a career high with 16 tackles, including 12 solo stops, in Saturday's win at Samford.

Freshman

Zack Jaynes, Western Carolina R-Fr., 6-0, 195, QB

Making his first career start Saturday at Furman, Jaynes passed for a career-high 302 yards and two touchdowns while leading a second half rally. Jaynes also rushed for 36 yards and a score.

Special Teams

Andrew Wilcox, Elon Sr., 6-2, 231, PK

Wilcox was perfect on Saturday, connecting on a pair of field goal attempts and making good on all three PAT tries in Elon's 27-23 win at The Citadel. In the process, he moved to sixth place all-time in SoCon history in career field goals made with 51.

Hudgins Rewriting Record Books: Elon junior wide receiver Terrell Hudgins continues to shatter records with his latest entry into the SoCon record book coming in the form of a career mark. With his 13-catch, 199-yard, 1-touchdown effort at Georgia Southern on Sept. 20, Hudgins became the league's all-time leader in receptions and receiving touchdowns. Just six games into his junior season, Hudgins also now sits in second place on the SoCon's career receiving yards list, 449 yards out of first place.

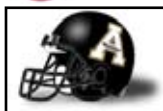

Game Times Decrease with New Rule Changes in 2008

When the revised rules regarding the play clock went into effect this year, many thought game times would decrease again, much like during the 2006 season. Rules changes for the 2008 season include the institution of a 40-second play clock that begins immediately following the completion of a play, except in dead ball situations. Also, when a ball carrier runs out of bounds, the clock is stopped, but it is started again when the ball is set for play (except for the final two minutes of each half.)
