QUICK HITS

- The Southern Conference Championship begins Thursday with the quarterfinal round. The semi-finals are slated for Friday and the championship final is Sunday at noon. Two of the match-ups are rematches of Saturday's regular-season finales as No. 1 Samford and No. 8 Western Carolina kick things off in the first game and No. 4 Furman and No. 5 Wofford follow in game two.
- The back-to-back champion Mercer Bears enter as the No. 7 seed.
- Samford, the No. 1 seed, was picked to finish 7th in the coaches preseason poll, while No. 2 Chattanooga was tabbed sixth and No. 3 UNCG was at fifth. All three teams finished 10-4.

POSTSEASON AWARDS

All-SoCon women's basketball teams announced

UNC Greensboro's Soliman tabbed player of the year, Spartans' Patterson named coach of the year

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – The Southern Conference announced the 2019-20 women's basketball postseason awards Tuesday. Selections include the coaches' all-conference teams and specialty awards in addition to the Southern Conference Sports Media Association all-conference teams and awards.

UNC Greensboro's Nadine Soliman was tabbed the player of the year by both the coaches and the media, while Wofford forward Lilly Hatton was named the freshman of the year by both groups. UNCG's Trina Patterson was voted as the coach of the year by the coaches, while the media honored Patterson and Samford head coach Carley Kuhns, in her first season as the leader of the Bulldogs.

Mercer forward Shannon Titus was named the defensive player of the year by the coaches and Chattanooga's Lakelyn Bouldin was the winner of the Ann Lashley Inspiration Award.

The 2020 Ingles Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship presented by General Shale begins Thursday at 11 a.m. at the Harrah's Cherokee Center Asheville in Asheville, North Carolina. The championship game is scheduled for Sunday at 12 p.m. and will be televised on ESPN+ and select Nexstar affiliates.

Notes

- Nadine Soliman is UNC Greensboro's first player of the year in program history.
- Soliman's honor marks the first time since 2013-14 that a Mercer player is not the player of the year.
- Lilly Hatton is just Wofford's second freshman of the year and the first since Mahogany Williams was the pick by both the coaches and the media in 2007-08.
- Shannon Titus is the first Mercer player to be named defensive player of the year.
- Trina Patterson collects her second coach of the year honor. She was last honored by both the coaches and the media in 2016-17. It is the fourth time a UNCG coach has been honored as Lynne Agee was recognized in 1998-99 and 2001-02.
- This year marks the first time there have been co-coaches of the year on either squad.
- Samford head coach Carley Kuhns, the co-coach of the year by the media, is just the second head coach in program history to earn the honor and the first since Mike Morris in 2008-09.
- Soliman and Wofford's Chloe Wanink are first-team selections for the second straight season. Soliman's recognition is the fourth of her career, as she was also a second-team selection in 2016-17 and 2017-18, while Wanink, a second-team selection in 2016-17, collects her third all-conference honor.
- Natalie Armstrong and Sarah Myers are the first Samford players to be honored on the first team since the league went to a first team and second team in 2014-15.
- Since joining the league in 2014, Mercer has had at least one member on the all-conference first-team each year.
- The coaches and media had four common players on the first team, with the coaches placing Mercer's Jaron Dougherty on the squad and the media recognizing Furman's Tierra Hodges.
- Seven of the eight league teams were represented on either the coaches' all-conference or all-freshman teams, while all eight were represented by the media.
- Due to a tie in the voting, there are six members on the coaches' all-freshman team.

TEAM NOTES AND PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ETSU

- The Bucs got their first win since Feb. 6 on Feb. 22, downing Mercer 56-54.
- ETSU's 67-60 win over ACC opponent Wake Forest was ETSU's first win over a Power 5 opponent since 2008-09 when the Bucs upset Kentucky 59-50 on the road.
- The triple-overtime loss to Chattanooga on Feb. 1 was the first 3OT game in and second-longest contest in history.
- Head coach Brittney Ezell coached her 200th game as the leader of the Bucs in the 65-60 win over South Alabama on Dec. 20 and won her 100th at ETSU on Feb. 6 against WCU. She is third in program history in wins, now just trailing Susan Yow (118) by 17 games.
- The Bucs have four road wins on the season, doubling last season's total (2-16).

Furman

- With Furman's win over Western Carolina on February 20, head coach Jackie Carson surpassed Marshall's Judy Southard for eighth all-time in wins by a SoCon coach.
- Le'Jzae Davidson moved is third place all-time at Furman for career points. She is also second in league history for made 3s in a career. Davidson currently has 1,729 points and 319 3-pointers made.
- Redshirt junior guard/forward Tierra Hodges has 14 double-doubles this season to lead the Paladins.
- In league play, Hodges is the only player averaging a double-double. She averages 11.7 points per game and 12.0 rebounds per game, a league high.
- Head coach Jackie Carson coached her 300th career game at Chattanooga on Jan. 19. All have come as the leader of the Paladins.
- Taylor Petty became the 24th player in program history on January 11 to reach 1,000 career points after finishing with 15 against Samford on Jan. 11.
- Furman ended Mercer's streak of 34 consecutive conference games won with a 62-49 win over the Bears in the conference opener on Jan. 9. The streak dated back to Feb. 4, 2017.

Mercer

- Mercer has 11 freshmen and sophomores on the roster, tied with Winthrop for the most in the country.
- Head coach Susie Gardner coached her 300th game as the leader of the Bears in the overtime loss to Jacksonville on Dec. 29. She won her 350th game as a head coach on Feb. 6 against Wofford and collected win No. 175 at Mercer in a win over Furman on Feb. 8.
- Jaron Dougherty has been the SoCon Player of the Week three times, one of three players to do that this season (along with UNCG's Nadine Soliman & Furman's Tierra Hodges).
- Mercer leads the league in blocks (152) and steals (245) and Shannon Titus leads the Bears in both, tallying 55 blocks & 81 steals.
- Mercer had won 34 consecutive conference games, dating back to Feb. 4, 2017, before falling to Furman 62-49 in Greenville, South Carolina, on Jan. 9.

UNCG

- Nadine Soliman scored 10 points in the Spartans' loss to Samford on Feb. 1, becoming UNCG's all-time leading scorer (1,912). The SoCon's active career leader surpassed 2,000 points in a win over Wofford on Feb. 20. Soliman also became the record holder for career field goals made earlier this season. She leads the league, averaging 17.0 PPG, and is eighth in SoCon history in career scoring. ETSU's DeShawnne Blocker (91-95) sits in seventh with Soliman just 31 points back.
- UNCG's win over Wake Forest was the Spartans' first victory over the Demon-Deacons since 2005.
- Te'ja Twitty became the 26th person in program history to surpass 1,000 career points after scoring 14 points against Coastal Carolina.
- Head coach Trina Patterson coached her 100th game as the leader of the Spartans on Nov. 17 against Maryland Eastern Shore. The Spartans won 86-48. She coached her 600th overall game in a 67-51 win over Mercer on Jan. 30.

Samford

- Carley Kuhns got her first win as the Samford leader with an 81-60 win over Montevallo to open the season. On Nov. 17, she coached her 100th career game at No. 12 Florida State.
- Maryland transfer Sarah Myers has had an immediate impact on the team so far. She is second on the team in scoring (13.9 ppg) and leads the team in rebounding (7.0 rpg). Myers had a career-high 27 points at ETSU and tallied her third double-double of the season in the win.
- Samford swept the Bears for the first time since they came into the league in 2015.
- Charity Brown, the league's active leader in career assists (497), surpassed 400 in the win over Murray State and set a new program record for career assists after amassing four in a loss to Furman on Feb. 6, passing Aimee Cochran from 1997-2001.
- In SoCon games, Natalie Armstrong leads all scorers, averaging 16.1 ppg.

Chattanooga

- The 3OT contest at ETSU was just the third 3OT game in program history, though the last was 21 years ago. The Mocs are 3-0 in triple-OT contests.
- Lakelyn Bouldin leads the Mocs in scoring (12.3 ppg) while Eboni Williams leads the squad in rebounding (8.1).

Western Carolina

- Head coach Kiley Hill coached his 500th overall game at UNCG on Saturday, Jan. 18. The next Catamounts win will be his 300th win as a head coach.
- Western Carolina picked up its first conference win in a 51-40 victory over Mercer on Feb. 1. The win broke a 17-game losing streak to the Bears. Earlier this season, the Catamounts snapped a 21 game losing streak against the Mocs, a streak that dated back to 2010.
- After going 0-14 in conference play last season, the win over Mercer was the Catamounts' first league win since Feb. 8, 2018 at Wofford (68-62). It was the first home conference win since Feb. 25, 2017 (1,171 days) when WCU beat UNCG 77-73. If the Catamounts can pick up one more SoCon win, it'll be the program's most since winning three in 2016-17.
- For the season, Jewel Smalls had 280 rebounds, despite being a 5-7 guard. She has recorded double-digit rebounds 13 times this season.
- Lauren LaPlant set a new program record for 3-pointers made in a season (68) in the loss at UNCG on Feb. 15. She now has 78 on the year.
- Smalls has scored in double figures in 19 games this season.

Wofford

- Chloe Wanink, the preseason player of the year and the Terriers' leading scorer, averaging 16.0 points per game, has been out with an injury since the Feb. 13 game against ETSU.
- Wofford's eight league wins are the most by the program since winning nine in 2001-02.
- Junior guard DaJa Green joined the 1,000 point club in the loss at UNCG on Feb. 20.
- Wofford won its first ever game at Samford on Feb. 8 and with the win over ETSU on Thursday, swept the Bucs for the first time in program history.
- Terriers' head coach Jimmy Garrity coached his 100th game at Wofford in a 70-57 loss to Georgia Southern on Dec. 1 & coached his 200th overall in a win over Mercer on Jan. 11.
- Garrity's squad has held opponents to less than 65 points in each of the last nine games, including holding UNCG to 49 in a loss on Feb. 20.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - MARCH 2

Furman's Tierra Hodges Redshirt junior guard/forward

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – Furman's Tierra Hodges has been named the Southern Conference women's basketball player of the week presented by GEICO for games played Feb. 25-29. The award is selected by the league office and is the final one of the 2019-20 campaign.

The redshirt junior scored 14 points and pulled down a career-high 18 rebounds in Furman's lone game of the week, a 62-56 home win over upstate rival Wofford in the regular-season finale on Saturday. The double-double was her team-leading 14th of the season. The native of Covington, Georgia, made a career-high eight free throws in the contest and went 4-4 from the charity stripe in the final 3:50 as Furman closed out the game on a 13-7 run. Her first two free throws of the span broke a 49-49 tie and her final two extended Furman's lead to six with seven seconds left, securing the win and helping Furman to the No. 4 seed in the upcoming Ingles Southern Conference Championship presented by General Shale.

Furman, which went 18-11 overall and 8-6 in SoCon play this season, will again square off with No. 5 Wofford (15-14, 8-6) in the quarterfinals on Thursday, March 5, in the second game of the day, beginning at approximately 1:15 p.m.

Also nominated: Shannon Titus (Mercer), Nadine Soliman (UNCG), Natalie Armstrong (Samford), Bria Dial (Chattanooga) and Jewel Smalls (Western Carolina).
