QUICK HITS

- Chattanooga earned the first SoCon win of the season over an SEC opponent, downing Auburn 1-0 on Wednesday.
- UNCG was tabbed to win the 2021 SoCon title in voting by the league's head coaches and currently sit atop the league at 16-8 overall.
- Chattanooga infielder Emily Coltharp was named the preseason player of the year, Chattanooga's third-straight preseason POTY selection. Samford pitcher Abby Swaney was selected as the preseason pitcher of the year.
- UNCG is eighth nationally with 1.69 home runs per game & fifth in walks (163), while Samford is fifth in doubles plays per game (0.60).

- ETSU placed five on the preseason all-conference squad, led by first team selections Kelly Schmidt (pitcher) and outfielder Kelly Warren. Catcher Kylie Toler, infielder Julia Fritz and outfielder Andrea Sarhatt were named to the second team.

The fifth-oldest NCAA Division I college athletic association, the SoCon contested the first-ever collegiate conference basketball tournament in 1921, tackled freshman eligibility in 1922, became the first conference to adopt the 3-point field goal in basketball in 1980 and developed women's championships in 1984.
