## PLAYER OF THE WEEK RELEASE

**SPARTANBURG, S.C.** – Furman's Jake Raine and Belmont's Drew Romig have been named the Southern Conference men's soccer offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively, for all competition from March 9-15.

Freshman Raine netted a pair of goals, including the match-winning score at the 105:15 mark, to hand Furman a 2-1, double-overtime victory at ETSU in the Paladins' Southern Conference opener on Friday night. The Stoke, England, native opened the scoring with a shot from the top of the box in the 24th minute. In the second overtime period, he beat the ETSU goalkeeper to a cross toward the far post and scored the match-winner with his right foot. Raine has totaled four goals and an assist in his first four matches for the Paladins and is tied for the lead in the SoCon with nine points on the season. His four goals are also tied for first in the conference.

Furman (3-1, 1-0 SoCon) continues SoCon action against Wofford (0-4, 0-1) on Tuesday at 7 p.m. in Greenville, South Carolina.

Romig, the league's defensive player of the week, earned his first career shutout as a Bruin and his second consecutive win in goal for the team. He tallied a pair of saves on eight shots faced in Belmont's 1-0 win over Wofford on Saturday. Romig logged Belmont's third clean sheet of the spring slate and holds the second-best goals against average in the conference at 0.50.

Belmont (4-0-1, 1-0) is set to host conference foe VMI (2-3, 0-0) at 5 p.m. ET on Tuesday in Nashville, Tennessee.



#### Notes

- Conference action began last week, as the race for the 2021 title is off to a start. The Furman/Wofford game scheduled for March 16 was postponed due to inclement weather and wet field conditions.
- Belmont (5-0-1, 2-0 SoCon) remains unbeaten through its first six matches of the spring season for their best start in program history. Belmont's six-game unbeaten streak sets the program record for consecutive results, which was last set in 2007. The Bruins deafeted conference opponents Wofford, 1-0, and VMI, 5-0, last week and is first in the conference standings. Belmont has recorded four shutouts through its first six appearances this year, as it only received four clean sheets in 19 matches last season.
- ETSU (1-4-1) won its first game of the 2021 spring season against the SoCon preseason favorite Mercer Bears. The Bucs improve their unbeaten run against the Bears to nine games, moving to 6-0-3 the last nine attempts. The win marks three straight for ETSU against their hosts.
- Furman beat ETSU with a 2OT win on March 13, earning its first SoCon win of the season in the conference opener. The Paladins are scheduled to return to action on Saturday, March 20, when it travels to UNCG for a 7 p.m. kickoff at UNCG Soccer Stadium. The match will be streamed live on ESPN+.
- Mercer dropped its SoCon matchup to ETSU on March 16, 1-0, and tied with UNCG a few days earlier. Both teams scored one goal each. Against the Bucs, Mercer placed a season-high nine shots on target. The team will hit the road on Saturday to take on VMI at 2 p.m. ET.
- The Spartans (4-1-1, 0-0-1 SoCon) tied with Mercer on March 13. Freshman goalkeeper Niclas Wild made three saves for UNCG. Wild has a 0.67 goals-against average. UNCG plays again at 7 p.m. Saturday, when the Spartans host Furman in a Southern Conference match at UNCG Soccer Stadium.
- VMI goalkeeper Broaden Schull, who is ranked 4th among the NCAA DI with 5.60 saves per game, made seven stops in the Keydets' 5-0 loss to Belmont.
- Wofford fell in another one-goal game Saturday afternoon to the Belmont Bruins, 1-0. All four of Wofford's losses this season have come by one goal.
- The 2020-21 SoCon Men's Soccer Championship is set to be contested on consecutive weekends in April. The top two seeds will host semifinal matches on either April 9 or 10, with the top remaining seed hosting the final on April 16 or 17.
