Davidson's Stephen Curry Named SoCon Player of the Week

Davidson sophomore **Stephen Curry** was named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for the week ending February 11.

Curry has earned or shared Played of the Week honors in each of the last three weeks and a total of four times this season.

Curry averaged 31.0 points and 7.0 rebounds with five assists, five steals and two blocked shots as Davidson downed Elon, 74-64, on Feb. 6 and College of Charleston, 81-55, on Feb. 9.

The guard tallied 36 points against Elon and added 26 against the College of Charleston.

The Charlotte, N.C. native ranks fifth nationally in scoring (25.0 ppg). For the week, Curry shots 19-of-35 (54.3 percent from the field), 9-of-17 (52.9 percent) from three-point range and was a perfect 15-of-15 from the free throw line.

Other standout performances were turned in by Georgia Southern's Louis Graham, Elon's Brett James, Appalachian State's Donte Minter, Chattanooga's Nicchaeus Doaks, UNC Greensboro's Kyle Hines, The Citadel's Cameron Wells and Wofford's Shane Nichols.

Tournament Seeding Procedures

The team with the best overall conference won-loss percentage in the North and South Divisions shall receive the top two seeds in the conference tournament. Other seeds for the tournament shall be determined based on each team's overall Conference won-loss percentage regardless of division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed, the seed shall be determined as follows:

- A. If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- B. If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie;
- C. If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- D. If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's Rating Percentage Index (RPI) as published by RPIratings.com after the completion of the last regular season game;
- E. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- F. If the teams are still tied, the team's records against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so forth until the tie is broken;
- G. If there is still a tie, the seeded position of the teams will be determined by comparing each team's RPI ratings as published by RPIratings.com,
- H. For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie; and
- I. For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian State



- Forward Jeremy Clayton needs 75 points to become the 28th Appalachian State player to join the 1,000-point club. He scored 12 against Wofford on Feb. 11. With two blocks against Wofford, he has a school-record 201 blocks and became the seventh player in SoCon history to with 200 rejections.
- Donald Sims has made 55 three-pointers this season, setting the school record for treys by a freshman. Rodney Peel set the previous record with 46 in 1987-88.
- The Mountaineers are second in the SoCon in free throw percentage (70.0 percent). In games with College of Charleston and The Citadel last week, the Mountaineers shot 83.3 percent from the line.
- Appalachian State will host Niagara in Bracketbusters on Feb. 23 in Boone, N.C. at 1:00 p.m.



Elon

- Elon snapped a season-long six-game losing streak with a 70-67 overtime win at Wofford on Feb. 9 and won again, 65-51, over The Citadel on Feb. 11. The Wofford win was Elon's first overtime game this year and the first overtime win for the Phoenix since beating UNC Greensboro on March 3, 2006.
- Brett James recorded his second double-double of the season with 13 points and 11 boards on Feb. 6 at Davidson. The junior scored a season-high 25 points in a Feb. 9 overtime victory at Wofford.
- Elon will host UT-Martin in Bracketbusters on Saturday, Feb. 23 at 7:00 p.m.



UNC Greensboro

- The Spartans have suffered four of their seven SoCon losses in the final 38 seconds of play this season.
- Kyle Hines surpassed the 2,000-point mark on Feb. 7. He needs 12 rebounds to reach the 1,000-plateau. Only 96 players have ever recorded 2,000/1,000 and Hines would become the sixth player to also add 300 blocked shots.
- Kyle Hines (27) and Kevin Oleksiak (26) combined for 53 points but Stephen Curry (41) and Jason Richards (16) combined for 57 as the Wildcats rallied from a 52-37 halftime deficit to defeat the Spartans, 83-78, on Feb. 13.



Chattanooga

- Junior forward Nichaeus Doaks averaged 16.0 points with 13 boards and five blocked shots last week. He was 13-of-16 (83.3 percent) from the line during that span.
- The Mocs have been buoyed by the return of junior forward Khalil Hartwell (ACL deficiency) and junior guard Keyron Sheard (dislocated clavicle), who came off the bench to spur a win over Furman.
- Senior guard Kevin Bridgewater had a career-high nine assists in a Feb. 7 66-63 win over Furman in Chattanooga. Junior guard Stephen McDowell played 39 minutes in the win over the Paladins.



Western Carolina

- The Catamounts are 0-10 on enemy courts this season and play at The Citadel on Feb. 14 and at College of Charleston on Feb. 16.
- Western Carolina's lone win away from Cullowhee, N.C. was a 63-60 triumph over Bowling Green in the season-opener on Nov. 9 in the first round of the Peggy Cronin Classic in Cincinnati, Ohio.
- The depleted Western Carolina roster includes just eight players leaving coach Larry Hunter with limited options.



SOUTH DIVISION

College of Charleston



- The Cougars scored the game's final 10 points to earn a 68-63 win at Appalachian State on Feb. 7.
- College of Charleston is 6-1 in SoCon games when leading at the half. The Cougars are 7-0 on the year and 16-1 overall under Bobby Cremins when limiting opponents to less than 40 percent shooting.
- The 81-56 loss at Davidson loss was just the second loss of 20+ points in 157 SoCon games.

The Citadel



- The Citadel is ranked 17th in the nation in three-pointers made per game. The Bulldogs connected on 15 treys on Feb. 9 at Appalachian State and made eight at Elon on Feb. 11.
- The Bulldogs host Western Carolina on Valentine's Day, the first meeting between the two teams this season. The last Bulldogs win over the Catamounts was in 2005 when The Citadel won, 65-60.
- Cameron Wells' free throw with three seconds left sent the Feb. 9 game with Appalachian State into overtime. Wells has scored double-digits in each of the last six contests.

Davidson



- Davidson has won 14 consecutive games and 26 straight SoCon regular-season contests and 39 of its last 40 against SoCon competition. The Wildcats are 16-0 in league play for the second time in coach Bob McKillop's tenure.
- Davidson's 14-game winning streak is the third longest winning streak in the nation.
- Stephen Curry (41) and Jason Richards (16) combined for 57 as the Wildcats rallied from a 52-37 halftime deficit to defeat the Spartans, 83-78, on Feb. 13.
- Winthrop will host Davidson in a nationally televised Bracketbusters game in on Friday, Feb. 22. The game will be televised on ESPN2 at 7:00 p.m.

Furman



- Senior George Brozos registered his first career double-double with 18 points and a career-high 10 rebounds in a 69-59 win over UNC Greensboro on Feb. 10.
- Furman held UNCG to 30.2 percent (19-of-63) shooting, the lowest against Furman this year.
- Brozos was 11-of-21 from the field and 4-of-8 from three-point range last week and averaged 16.5 points and 8.0 rebounds in two games.

Georgia Southern



- Senior forward Louis Graham has averaged 20.3 points per game in his last 12 outings. The Eagles are 8-4 in that span.
- Graham scored all 18 of his points in the second half in an 81-61 triumph over Chattanooga on Feb. 9. In three games last week he shot 21-of-35 (60.0 percent) from the floor.
- Dwayne Foreman set a school career assist record against UNC Greensboro on Feb. 4. He passed Charlton Young (1989-93), who had 530 career assists.

Wofford



- Shane Nichols moved into third place on Wofford's all-time three-point attempts lists with 559. He needs one trey to move into third place on the career three-pointers list.
- Drew Gibson was perfect from the floor against Elon on Feb. 9. He was 2-for-2 from the field including 1-of-1 from three-point range and was 7-of-7 from the line. He also dished out 10 assists.
- Shane Nichols averaged 17.5 points last week, shooting 12-of-23 (52.2) from the field. He made four three-pointers and was 7-of-9 (77.8 percent) from the line.
