PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Donald Sims - Appalachian St.

Sims averaged 27.5 points and shot better than 70 percent from the field last week as the Mountaineers earned victories over Davidson (66-56) and Georgia Southern (111-83).

Sims opened the week with 25 points against Davidson and tallied 30 points against Georgia Southern. He connected on 5-of-7 three-point attempts and was 10-for-10 from the free throw. Sims shot 71 percent from the field on 20-of-28 shooting for the week.

The Gaffney, S.C., native became just the 17th player in school history to record 500 points in a single season and ran his consecutive made free throw streak to 28.

The junior guard leads the conference in scoring with 19.8 points per game. He leads the nation in free throw shooting, having connected on 96 percent of his attempts from the charity stripe. Sims leads the league with 3.0 made three-pointers per game and is ninth in the conference in field goal percentage (.484).

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Appalachian State saw its four-game winning streak ended Wednesday as the Mountaineers fell at College of Charleston, 73-72. Junior Donald Sims led the Mountaineers with 18 points. He has scored in double figures in 26-of-27 games this season.

• With a lead in the division race and the head-to-head tiebreaker with Western Carolina, the Mountaineers need just one league win in their final three SoCon games to secure the North's top seed for the conference tournament.

- Appalachian State hosts Tennessee Tech Saturday night.

ELON PHOENIX



- Senior Adam Constantine recorded his seventh and eighth double-double of the season last week. Constantine scored 24 points and grabbed 14 rebounds against College of Charleston before tallying 25 points and 15 rebounds against The Citadel.

• Four players scored in double figures Wednesday night at Elon knocked off UNC Greensboro, 70-65. Drew Spradlin led the Phoenix with 14 points while Terrance Birdette added 12. Constantine poured in 11 points and Elon got 10 points from guard Chris Long in the win.

- Elon hosts UNC Greensboro Wednesday night.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Freshman Kyle Randall narrowly missed a double-double Monday night against Western Carolina. He poured in a season-high 20 points and added nine rebounds against the Catamounts. Randall is the team's second-leading scorer with 9.2 points per game.

• Ben Stywall and Kendall Toney have both played in 117 consecutive games -- having never missed a game in their careers. The school record for consecutive games played is 119 by Jay Joseph.

- The Spartans visit The Citadel Saturday afternoon.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- The Bulldogs have attempted 27 more shots from three-point range than they have from two-point range this season. Samford has taken a total of 1,129 shot attempts this season with 578 of them coming from beyond the arc. The Bulldogs are shooting 56.3 percent

from two-point range and 36 percent from beyond the arc.

- The Bulldogs have made at least one 3-point field goal in 559-consecutive games. The last time that Samford did not make a 3-point basket was on Jan. 19, 1991, against Texas-San Antonio.
- Samford hosts Chattanooga Saturday afternoon.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- In the last six games, Chattanooga has committed 72 turnovers, an average of 12 per game, and has +1.3 turnover margin. With 83 assists, that is a ratio of 1.15. Before that stretch, UTC was averaging 17.8 turnovers per contest with a -2.4 turnover margin.

• Sophomore Keegan Bell recorded seven assists against Furman last Saturday which is his most since finishing with 10 in UTC's home win over Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 23).

- Chattanooga visits Samford Saturday afternoon.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina has won 19 games this season, matching the most wins in a single-season as a NCAA Division I program. WCU's 19 wins tie the 1981-82 Catamounts who won 19 games under head coach Steve Cottrell. The 19 victories are the most for WCU under head coach Larry Hunter.

• WCU senior Jake Robinson moved into seventh place on the SoCon's career made three-pointers chart with 265, just five shy of sixth place D.J. Thompson of Appalachian State (270).

- Western Carolina travels to face Kent State Saturday night in an ESPN BracketBuster matchup.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars are 9-3 in their last 12 games and have averaged 79.9 points per game, while limiting their opponents to 73.8. College of Charleston is shooting 38.9 percent from beyond the three-point arc in the last 12 contests.

• With 18 points against Appalachian State Wednesday night, Andrew Goudelock moved into the top five on CofC's all-time scoring list. The junior guard is currently in fifth place with 1,558 career points. He has made 242 career three-pointers and recently eclipsed Marion Busby's school record of 220.

- College of Charleston visits George Mason Saturday night.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Cosmo Morabbi led four Bulldogs in double figures as The Citadel downed Western Carolina, 73-56 at McAlister Fieldhouse Thursday night. Morabbi scored a game-high 16 points off the bench while teammate Zach Urbanus scored 14. Cameron Wells added 13 points while Harrison DuPont posted a double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds in the win.

• Thursday's output was DuPont's first double-double of the season. He has been a force for the Bulldogs over the last three games, averaging 15.0 points and 8.3 rebounds per contest.

- The Bulldogs host UNC Greensboro Saturday afternoon. The game will be televised on SportSouth.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- The Wildcats have won 11 of their last 17 games and five of their last seven contests. Davidson is closing the season during a stretch in which the Wildcats play five times in 11 days, including three games at Belk Arena.

• With 10 points at Appalachian State last week, senior Will Archambault became the 38th Davidson player to score 1,000 for his career. He is averaging 11.1 points per game, the 20th best mark in the league.

- The Wildcats will welcome Furman to Belk Arena Saturday afternoon.

FURMAN PALADINS



- The Paladins are tied for the league, and rank 32nd nationally, in blocked shots per game (5.2 bpg). Freshman Colin Reddick is sixth in the league with 1.3 blocks per game while teammate Bryson Barnes is seventh with 1.2 rejections per contest.

• Junior Jordan Miller scored a career-high 31 points in Furman's 87-78 win at Chattanooga last Saturday. Miller and teammate Amu Saaka have combined for three of the seven 30-point games in the conference this season. Saaka is fifth in the league in scoring (16.4 ppg), while Miller ranks seventh (14.4 ppg).

- Furman will visit Davidson Saturday afternoon.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Willie Powers III has scored in double figures in eight straight games which includes four 20-point performances. Powers has sparked Georgia Southern's comebacks with double digit scoring in the second half in five of those seven games and nine games overall this season.

- The Eagles scored 54 points in the first half against the Appalachian State Saturday, the second-highest total in a half this season. Georgia Southern scored a season-best 58 first-half points in its season-opening win vs. Reinhardt.
- Georgia Southern hosts Wofford Saturday at Hanner Fieldhouse.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Noah Dahlman has scored in double-figures in all 28 games this season. In the last 55 games, he has scored ten or more points in 54 of them. Dahlman is fourth in the league in scoring with 17.1 points per game.

• Wofford earned a 73-51 win at Davidson Wednesday night. It was the Terriers' first win at Belk Arena since 1990. Wofford's 20th win this season marks the school record for wins since moving to Division I and is just the eighth 20-win season in school history.

- The Terriers visit Davidson Wednesday.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH

CONFERENCE NOTES

ANNUAL LEADERS

Wofford junior Noah Dahlman has led the league in field goal percentage each of the past two seasons. Dahlman shot .609 from the field as a freshman and .601 last year. If he is able to lead the conference shooting percentage again, he would be the first player to lead the league in field goal percentage three straight seasons since Joe Holup of George Washington (1954-56).

Western Carolina junior Brigham Waginger led the league in steals in 2008 (69) and 2009 (81). Should he lead the league in steals again this season it would be the first time the same player has led the conference for three consecutive seasons. East Tennessee State's Keith Jennings is the only other player in league history to lead the league in steals for three seasons (1988, 1989, 1991).

Davidson has led the league in scoring each of the past four seasons. The only team to lead the conference in scoring for more than four straight years was West Virginia. The Mountaineers were the top scoring team in the league for seven consecutive seasons from 1957-1963.

ALL-DECADE RECOGNITION

CollegeInsider.com recently released it's All-Decade team which featured the top 25 players from the past decade (2000-2009). Davidson's Stephen Curry (2006-09) was named to the All-Decade Team. He finished his career as the league's leading scorer with 2,635 points in three years.

- Western Carolina's Kevin Martin (2001-04) and East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2002-06) were named to the Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Martin led the league in scoring in 2003 and 2004 before being taken in the first round of the 2004 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. A two-time SoCon Tourney MVP, Smith was the league's leading scorer in 2005.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

Following a 20-game league schedule each of the past two seasons, the SoCon Council of Presidents voted to move to an 18-game league slate beginning 2009-10. The last time the conference played 18 league games was during the 2006-07 season. The SoCon also played 18 games during the 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 5-8 in Charlotte. The first two round (March 5-6) will take place at Bojangles Coliseum while the semifinals and finals (March 7-8) will take place at Time Warner Cable Arena. It will mark the league's first conference tournament in Charlotte since 1971.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2010 will mark the 89th year of the post-season classic.

FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2009-10. No team had fewer than seven returning lettermen and seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 41 starters from last year, an average of 3.4 per team. Three teams (Furman, Western Carolina and Wofford) return all five starters.

HEAD COACHES

Nine of the league's 12 head coaches return to the bench in 2009-10. The current head coaches have a combined 58 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Buzz Peterson returned to Appalachian State after guiding the Mountaineers from 1997-2000. Matt Matheny took over the Elon Phoenix after spending 16 years on Bob McKillop's staff at Davidson and Charlton Young returned to his alma mater to take over the Georgia Southern Eagles.
- Four SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments last season. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

- The Mocs made their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005 before falling to UConn last year.
- Davidson made its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 3-5 all-time in the NIT after losing at Saint Mary's in the second round.
- College of Charleston lost at Richmond in the second round of the College Basketball Invitational. It was the eighth postseason appearance for CofC.
- The Citadel fell to Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.
