UNCG's Kevin Oleksiak Named SoCon Player of the Week

UNC Greensboro's **Kevin Oleksiak** was named the Southern Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for the week ending January 6.

The senior guard averaged 28.5 points while shooting 57.7 percent (15-of-26) from the field and 85.0 percent (17-of-20) from the line as the Spartans posted victories over Central Arkansas (80-62 on Jan. 2) and Georgia Southern (79-67 on Jan. 5) to improve to 8-4 on the season.

The Abington, Pa. native scored 28 points against Central Arkansas and followed it up with a 29-point performance against Georgia Southern. He tallied 20 points in the first half against Central Arkansas and had 22 in the second half against the Eagles.

Other standout performances were turned in by Stephen McDowell (Chattanooga), Jason Richards (Davidson), Shane Nichols (Wofford), Michael Porrini (Western Carolina), Ola Atoyebi (Elon), Jermaine Johnson (College of Charleston), Julian Allen (Georgia Southern) and Donte Minter (Appalachian State).

Tournament Seeding Procedures

The team with the best overall conference won-loss percentage in the North and South Divisions shall receive the top two seeds in the conference tournament. Other seeds for the tournament shall be determined based on each team's overall Conference won-loss percentage regardless of division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed, the seed shall be determined as follows:

- A. If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- B. If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie;
- C. If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- D. If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's Rating Percentage Index (RPI) as published by RPIratings.com after the completion of the last regular season game;
- E. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- F. If the teams are still tied, the team's records against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so forth until the tie is broken;
- G. If there is still a tie, the seeded position of the teams will be determined by comparing each team's RPI ratings as published by RPIratings.com,
- H. For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie; and
- I. For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian State



■ The Mountaineers squared their conference record with their second-consecutive regular-season sweep in Charleston with wins over College of Charleston (70-66 on Jan. 3) and The Citadel (63-50 on Jan. 5). The win over the Cougars was the third straight for the Mountaineers while the triumph over The Citadel was the 16th straight.

■ Credit for the twin victories last week goes to the Appalachian State defense. The Mountaineers limited College of Charleston and The Citadel to 33.6 percent shooting with 30 total turnovers.

■ Donte Minter averaged 15.0 points in the two wins last week. He made 11-of-18 (61.1 percent) shots from the floor with 24 rebounds and six assists. The Salisbury, N.C. native also registered five steals and four blocked shots.



Elon

■ The Phoenix's 6-8 start in 2007-08 matches the program's best 14-game start since moving to the NCAA Division I level for the 1999-00 campaign. In 1999-00 and 2001-02, Elon also started the season with 6-8 marks.

■ Forward Ola Atoyebi averaged 14.5 points and 6.0 rebounds in two games last week. The Chicago, Ill. native shot 55.0 percent from the floor and converted all seven free throw attempts as the Phoenix split two contests last week.

■ Elon's 72-63 win at The Citadel on Jan. 3 marked the first road victory for the Phoenix this season after dropping its first seven road contests.



UNC Greensboro

■ Jersey number 42, worn by Kyle Hines, will be retired later this season, it was announced by Nelson Bobb, director of athletics. He will be the fifth player in UNCG men's and women's basketball history, to be honored.

■ The Spartans extended their winning streak to six with an 84-54 victory over The Citadel on Jan. 7. The Spartans had not won six consecutive games since January 2001.

■ Kevin Oleksiak has averaged 19.4 points during UNC Greensboro's winning streak including games of 28 and 29 points. The Abington, Pa. native shot 57.7 percent from the field in two games last week and made 17-of-20 (85.0 percent) free throws.

■ UNC Greensboro embarks on a five-game road trip. UNC Greensboro will not play at home again until Feb. 2 against Elon.



Chattanooga

■ Junior guard Stephen McDowell has made 18 three-pointers in the last three games (18-of-40, 45.4 percent). The Indianapolis, Ind. native has averaged 20.3 points per game over that span.

■ Chattanooga is 5-0 in conference play for the first time since the 2000-01 season. The last time the Mocs won six consecutive games to open conference play was in 1996-97.

■ Khalil Hartwell has found conference play to his liking. Hartwell is averaging 7.7 points and 6.4 rebounds in 2007-08 but is scoring 14.4 points with 8.6 boards in SoCon action.



Western Carolina

■ Western Carolina hosts Furman on Jan. 10, exactly one week after the Paladins posted a 64-60 win over the Catamounts. Furman holds a 20-7 leads the in series in Greenville, S.C. but the Catamounts hold a 13-11 edge in games played in Cullowhee, N.C.

■ Freshman Michael Porrini has scored in double figures in 10 of his first 13 collegiate games and the Massillon, Ohio native leads the Southern Conference in steals. The guard averages 4.0 rebounds.

■ The Catamounts are 0-7 on enemy courts this year and play three of the next four games at home.



SOUTH DIVISION



College of Charleston

- Junior forward Jermaine Johnson registered back-to-back double-doubles last week. The Los Angeles, Calif. native had 17 points with 15 boards against Appalachian State on Jan. 3 and followed it up with 12 points and 10 rebounds in a victory over Elon on Jan. 5.
- Tony White Jr. equaled his career-high with 19 points (10-of-11 from the line) in the Elon win.
- The Cougars are 7-3 under coach Bobby Cremins in January and 131-33 (81.1 percent) the last 18 seasons.



The Citadel

- The Bulldogs are 5-3 at home this season but 0-6 on the road in 2007-08. The Citadel will play five consecutive games at McAlister Field House. The schedule includes home dates with Georgia Southern (Jan. 12), College of Charleston (Jan. 14), Wofford (Jan. 19), Davidson (Jan. 24) and UNC Greensboro (Jan. 26).
- Freshman Cameron Wells leads the Bulldogs in scoring with a 14.1 average. He ranks ninth in the conference in free throw percentage (75.6 percent) and is 14th in steals (1.31 per game).



Davidson

- Sophomore Stephen Curry ranks sixth nationally in scoring. The Charlotte, N.C. native boasts a 24.6 average. The guard leads the SoCon in scoring and is averaging 6.9 points more than any player in the league. He is the only player to average more than four three-pointers per game (4.17 p/g).
- Davidson boasts a 4-0 record in Southern Conference play for the second straight season and for the fourth time under coach Bob McKillop. Playing a break-neck schedule, the Wildcats are 6-6 overall.
- The Wildcats are 5-0 at Belk Arena and 1-6 away from home in 2007-08. Davidson's next three contests are on the road at Elon (Jan. 9), at Wofford (Jan. 12) and at Furman (Jan. 16).



Furman

- Following a Jan. 10 date at Western Carolina, Furman plays four straight home games including Elon (Jan. 12), Davidson (Jan. 16), College of Charleston (Jan. 19) and Appalachian State (Jan. 24).
- Connor Nolte scored a team-leading 13 points in Furman's game with Chattanooga to become the fifth freshman to lead the Paladins in scoring this season.
- Freshman Jordan Miller posted career highs with 14 points, four rebounds and four assists in Furman's 64-60 win over Western Carolina on Jan. 3.



Georgia Southern

- Dwayne Foreman moved into second place on the Georgia Southern all-time assists list last week. He has 480 career assists, 50 shy of the school record of 530 held by Charlton Young.
- Julian Allen averaged 19 points and 8.5 rebounds in two games last week. He scored a career-high 21 points against Davidson and netted 17 against UNC Greensboro.
- Following a home date with College of Charleston on Jan. 10, the Eagles play at The Citadel (Jan. 12), at Elon (Jan. 17) and at Appalachian State (Jan. 19).



Wofford

- Wofford has shuffled the line-up and has had nine different starting line-ups in the season's first 13 contests. Eleven players are averaging more than 10 minutes per game.
- Wofford has outrebounded nine of 13 opponents this season. Freshman Noah Dahlman leads the squad in rebounds with 6.2 boards per game.
- Guard Shane Nichols averaged 18.5 points in two games last week while making 10 three-pointers. The Radford, Va. native made only one two-point field goal in the two contests.
