## Quick Hits

- Southern Conference teams are 37-10 at home in nonconference play and 7-7 in neutral court contests.
- The 2015 Southern Conference tournament will be held March 6-9 at the U.S. Cellular Center in Asheville, N.C.
- The league's men's basketball programs combined for a Graduation Success Rate score of 83, topping the national average of 73 by 10 points.
- UNCG's R.J. White leads the SoCon with 7.5 rebounds per game. The sophomore has recorded a league-high five double-doubles this season.
- Furman's Stephen Croone became the third active player to reach 1,000 career points in the SoCon. A junior, Croone now has 1,009 points.

## Weekly Awards

### Player of the Week

**Tyler Hood, Samford, Sr., F**

Tyler Hood averaged 15.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists, one block and shot 56 percent from the field last week as Samford earned wins over Presbyterian (81-71) and Louisiana-Monroe (64-50). Hood tied his career high with six 3-pointers in the win at Presbyterian and pulled down a team-high five rebounds against the Blue Hose. The Lenoir City, Tenn., native also grabbed five rebounds and dished out five assists against Louisiana-Monroe. The senior was 9-of-16 (.563) from 3-point range for the week.



### CRONS Freshman of the Week

**Geoff Beans, Furman, F**

Furman's Geoff Beans has been named the CRONS Freshman of the Week award for the second time this season after averaging 15.0 points and 3.0 rebounds in a pair of games at Florida Gulf Coast and Minnesota. The forward opened the week with 16 points and three rebounds at FGCU before tallying 14 points and three rebounds at Minnesota Monday night. Beans added two steals on the week and has now scored in double figures in each of his last five games for Furman.



## Conference News and Notes

### One-Possession Games

Southern Conference teams have played six conference games to date. One game was decided by one possession or went into overtime.

- In 2014 the league had 17 of 88 (19 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2013 the league had 30 of 108 (28 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2012 the league had 32 of 108 (30 percent) conference games decided by one possession.

### Athletes of the Month

Western Carolina guard James Sinclair averaged 19.3 points and 5.7 rebounds in six November games to help the Catamounts to a 3-3 mark. Sinclair opened the season with four straight 20-plus games, scoring 20 in a 10-point loss at Mississippi State to open the season. He followed that up with a career night in another close loss at an SEC opponent, scoring 31 points in an 80-74 setback at Alabama. The senior from Savannah, Ga., then led WCU to its first win of the season with 25 points and nine rebounds against Hiwassee before capping his 20-point spurt with an even 20 and another nine boards in a double-overtime win at Oakland in the CBE Hall of Fame Classic. He averaged 10 points and four rebounds per game. For the month, Sinclair was second in the SoCon in scoring and steals per game (2.2). He was the SoCon Player of the Week on Nov. 18.

### New Schools

The Southern Conference officially added East Tennessee State University, Mercer University and Virginia Military Institute to the league on July 1, 2014.

- ETSU was a league member from 1978-2005, while VMI was in the Southern Conference from 1924-2003.

### Nonconference Scheduling

Six of the 10 SoCon teams participated in an exempt tournament this year. SoCon teams took part in the All-Military Classic (The Citadel and VMI), Battle 4 Atlantis (Chattanooga), CBE Classic (Western Carolina), Great Alaska Shootout (Mercer) and Maui on the Mainland (Samford).

### Head Coaches

Six of the 10 Southern Conference head coaches returned to the bench in the league this season. The current head coaches have a combined 30 years of experience in the SoCon. Three coaches joined the league this season with the additions of ETSU (Murry Bartow), Mercer (Bob Hoffman) and VMI (Duggar Baucom). Scott Padgett took over the reigns at Samford during the summer.

- Wofford head coach Mike Young ranks 10th on the league's all-time wins list. Young has tallied 194 wins with the Terriers and needs just one more victory to move past Norman Shepard into tenth place. Young was named the 2014 Coach of the Year by the league's coaches, while UTC's Will Wade earned the nod from the league's media.

### Schedule Adjustment

With ten teams in the SoCon, league teams will play an 18-game double-round robin conference schedule. League teams played 18 conference games from 2007-13, but this season marks the first time since the 1993-94 that SoCon teams will play a double-round robin schedule.

## Southern Conference News and Notes

### Close Encounters

Southern Conference teams lost 13 nonconference games in 2013-14 that were decided by one possession or went into overtime. Conversely, league teams won just six contests that were decided by a singel possession or went into overtime.

- SoCon teams are 7-6 this season in games decided by one possession or that went into overtime.

### Postseason Experience

Five Southern Conference teams participated in postseason play in 2013-14. Mercer and Wofford advanced to the NCAA tournament, while ETSU, Chattanooga and VMI participated in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason tournament.

### Sudden Impact

UNCG's Tevon Saddler was named the league's Freshman of the Year by the conference's coaches in 2014. Saddler became just the third Spartan to win the award, joining Jay Joseph (2001) and Kyle Hines (2005). Saddler was named the league's Freshman of the week a season-high five times last year.

### Annual Leaders

Wofford limited its opponents to just 62.2 points per game last season. It was the third straight year the Terriers led the Southern Conference in scoring defense.

Chattanooga led the league in rebounding for the second time in the last four seasons. The Mocs averaged 37.4 rebounds per game in 2013-14 and were +1.8 in rebounding margin.

### Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 966, 10 points higher than the national average of 956 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the sixth consecutive year that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate.

- The Southern Conference's APR score of 966 in men's basketball was the seventh-highest among all Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 28. Southern Conference men's basketball earned a 83, topping the Division I average of 72.

### Digital Network

The Southern Conference launched the SoCon Digital Network during the summer of 2014. All men's and women's basketball home games not selected for broadcast television will be available through the league's digital platform, which is available on computers, smartphones and tablets. Live games, on-demand content and features are all available at [socondigitalnetwork.com](http://socondigitalnetwork.com).

### Preseason Honors

Wofford was picked to win the 2014-15 Southern Conference championship in preseason balloting conducted by the league's head coaches. The Terriers return all five starters and 11 lettermen from last season's team that went 20-13 and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament.

- Chattanooga was picked second and earned two first-place votes while ETSU was tabbed third.
- Wofford's Karl Cochran was named the league's preseason Player of the Year and was joined on the preseason all-conference team by teammates Spencer Collins and Lee Skinner. Eight of the league's ten teams had at least one player on the preseason all-conference team.

### Conference Tournament

The 2015 Southern Conference Tournament presented by General Shale will be held March 6-9 in Asheville, N.C., at the U.S. Cellular Center. This year's tournament final will be Monday, March 9 at 7:00 p.m. The oldest conference tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2015 marks the 95th year of the postseason classic.
