### Two-Minute Drill

- Three teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll. Furman holds at No. 2 with Appalachian State at the No. 12 spot. Georgia Southern jumps five spots to No. 19 this week. Wofford also received votes.

- The ESPN/USA Today Poll has three SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman remains in the top 10 at No. 2 with Appalachian State at the No. 12 spot. Georgia Southern checks in at No. 20. Wofford also received votes.

- Appalachian State's Richie Williams is just one yard shy of tying for second in the SoCon career all-purpose yards records. His 7,702 yards continues to build on an Appalachian State record for career yards.

- Six student-athletes were named to the national award watch lists. Appalachian State's Richie Williams, Furman's Ingle Martin and Georgia Southern's Jermaine Austin are among the players on the Payton Award watch list. Appalachian State's Marques Murrell, Elon's Chad Nkang and Furman's William Freeman and are all on the Buchanan Award watch list.

- Georgia Southern running back Jermaine Austin recorded his 29th 100-yard rushing game against The Citadel, moving into second place in SoCon history. With 4,858 career rushing yards, Austin needs 142 yards to become the fourth player in league annals to reach 5,000 rushing yards.

# Around the SoCon This Week

## Appalachian State (5-2, 3-1 SoCon)

Appalachian State improved to 5-2 overall and 3-1 in the league with a 49-17 win at Wofford last Saturday...The Mountaineers piled up 566 yards of total offense, 342 of them passing...QB **Richie Williams** was 19-of-26 for 249 yards and also added 73 yards on the ground...The 322 yards of total offense was Williams' 11th career game of 300-plus yards of total offense...The QB combo of Williams and **Trey Elder** combined to hit ten different receivers...RB **Kevin Richardson** rushed for 72 yards and scored twice, as did TE **Daniel Bettis**, who caught four passes for 54 yards...LB **Cam Speer** had a game-high 12 tackles in his first career start...Speer also had his first career interception...The Mountaineers host Chattanooga Saturday in their annual Homecoming game.

## The Citadel (2-5, 1-3 SoCon)

The Citadel dropped a 49-14 decision to Georgia Southern on Saturday...RB **Nuru Goodrum** rushed for a career-high 118 yards on 18 carries and also scored a touchdown on a 37-yard run...Three Bulldog players had 10 or more tackles: **Joshua Lawson** (12 tackles), **Andrew Rowell** and **Porter Johnson** (10 each)...QB **Justin Knox** was 14-of-21 for 115 yards and a TD...The Bulldogs host Wofford in a game that will be televised on SC-ETV.

## Chattanooga (5-3, 2-2 SoCon)

The Mocs had their three-game win streak snapped following a 38-20 loss at home to Western Carolina...RB **Eldra Buckley** led UTC with 85 yards on the ground and also caught four passes for 21 yards...WR **Michael Gilmore** recorded a career-high 120 yards on seven catches...Gilmore caught a 27-yard TD pass from **Matt Lopez** and also had a 46-yard catch from **Antonio Miller**...Lopez, who relieved Miller in the third quarter, tossed the first two TD passes of his career...Gilmore's touchdown reception was the first thrown to a UTC receiver this season...LB Jeff Phillips led the Mocs with nine tackles, including two tackles for loss...UTC travels to Appalachian State on Saturday in a game that will be televised on CSS.

## Elon (3-5, 0-4 SoCon)

The Phoenix lost its fourth in a row on Saturday at Furman, 45-6...Elon's lone points came on a pair of **Andrew Wilcox** field goals of 41 and 32 yards...RB **Joe Baptiste** had a game-high 95 yards on the ground...Four different players caught a team-best two passes...LBs **Zach McAlister** and **Chad Nkang** had 11 and 10 tackles, respectively...Nkang had two tackles for loss, giving him 13 on the season...The Phoenix head to Western Carolina on Saturday.

## Furman (7-1, 3-1 SoCon)

Furman won its sixth in a row on Saturday, a 45-6 Homecoming win over Elon...It was also the sixth straight win over Elon...The Paladins racked up 486 yards of offense and limited the Phoenix to only 183 yards...Furman scored on four of its six possessions in the first half and on three of seven in the second half...QB **Ingle Martin** was 12-for-19 for 220 yards and one touchdown...The Paladins balance in the backfield continued as three players picked up 50 or more yards: **Jerome Felton** (56 yards), **Cedrick Gipson** (51) and **Brandon Mays** (50)...Felton also scored twice...LB **William Freeman** had three tackles for loss and nine total tackles, while LB **Gary Nelson** led the Paladins with 12 tackles...Furman is off this week and will travel to face Georgia Southern on Nov. 5.

## Georgia Southern (5-3, 4-2 SoCon)

Georgia Southern knocked off The Citadel 49-14 on Saturday behind 516 yards of offense...RB **Jermaine Austin** rushed for 137 yards on 18 carries, while QB **Jayson Foster** passed for a career-best 123 yards...Foster also rushed for 76 yards...As a team, the Eagles ran the ball 63 times for 385 yards against a Bulldog team that was giving up only 112 yards a game...GSU scored five times on the ground, all by different players...After The Citadel scored the game's first touchdown, the Eagles rattled off 35 straight points...FS **A.J. Bryant** and LB **John Mohring** each registered a team-high nine tackles...Georgia Southern steps out of league play to face South Dakota State on Saturday on the road.

## Western Carolina (3-3, 2-2 SoCon)

The Catamounts ended a three-game losing streak Saturday with a 38-20 win at Chattanooga...WCU recorded a pair of blocked punts for touchdowns, while also intercepting a pass for a score...RB **Lamont Reid** rushed for a career-high 108 yards, while **Darius Fudge** added 95 yards...Reid, who scored once on the ground, also caught a 63-yard pass from QB **Justin Clark** for his second touchdown of the game...Clark finished 13-of-18 for 144 yards...CB **Carlton Bailey** had a career- and game-high 10 tackles in the win and also returned an interception 28 yards for a touchdown...S **Mitchell Dukes** had four of his seven tackles go for a loss, including three sacks...The Catamounts host Elon on Homecoming Saturday.

## Wofford (4-3, 2-2 SoCon)

Wofford lost for the ninth time in its last 11 meetings with Appalachian State, 49-17...The Terriers had 257 yards on the ground and was led by QB **Josh Collier**, who had 88 yards on 13 carries...Collier's fifth career rushing touchdown came on a career-long 57-yard run...RB **Gabriel Jackson** added 68 yards and a touchdown, while RBs **Adrian Young** and **Corey Dunn** combined for 98 yards...Wofford heads to Charleston to face The Citadel on Saturday.

**Elon (3-5, 0-4 SoCon) at Western Carolina (3-3, 2-2 SoCon), 2:00**  
**E.J. Whitmire Stadium (13,742) • Cullowhee, NC**



**THE GAME:** The 35th all-time meeting between the two schools...Elon holds a slim 17-15-2 advantage over the Catamounts...This is only the third time the two have met since the Phoenix joined the SoCon...It's WCU's Homecoming, where the Catamounts are 15-15-1 all-time in Homecoming games at Whitmire Stadium since 1974...WCU has won the last three encounters, including a 28-7 decision a year ago at Elon...During the last three meetings, the Catamounts have outscored the Phoenix 64-17...Elon is coming off a 45-6 loss at Furman, producing only 183 yards of offense...RB Joe Baptiste rushed for 95 yards in the loss for the Phoenix...K Andrew Wilcox kicked a pair of field goals (41, 32) for Elon and is tied for the league lead with nine made this year...WCU snapped a three-game losing streak with a 38-20 win over Chattanooga...The Catamounts registered two blocked punts, each for scores, and also returned an interception for a touchdown...RB Darius Fudge needs four yards to reach 1,000 for his career...P Tim Mayse leads the league in punting average (43.5).

**THE COACHES:** Paul Hamilton (Appalachian State '81) is 6-13 in his second year as head coach of the Phoenix...Hamilton is 44-54 in nine years as a collegiate head coach and 3-5 vs. WCU...Western Carolina head coach Kent Briggs (Western Carolina '79) is in his fourth season as coach of his alma mater...Briggs has tabulated a 17-23 record in his three-plus seasons and is 2-0 vs. Elon.

**#19/#20 Georgia Southern (5-3, 4-2 SoCon) at South Dakota State (4-3), 2:00**  
**Coughlin-Alumni Stadium (14,000) • Brookings, SD**



**THE GAME:** This is the second all-time meeting between the two schools...The Eagles won last year's first meeting 63-7...SDSU came off its bye week with a 64-28 win over Missouri-Rolla...The Eagles are coming off a 49-14 win over The Citadel...QB Jayson Foster passed for a career-high 123 yards and also rushed for 76...RB Jermaine Austin had 137 yards on the ground for his 29th 100-yard game of his career -- second in SoCon history -- and enters the game needing seven yards for his third career 1,000-yard season...Austin also needs 142 rushing yards to become the fourth player in SoCon history to record 5,000 career rushing yards...Austin also is 42 all-purpose yards shy of becoming only the seventh SoCon player to amass 5,000 all-purpose yards in their career...Foster also needs 87 yards for his first 1,000-yard rushing season...Austin and Foster are aiming at becoming only the sixth duo in league history to rush for more than 1,000 yards in the same season...The Jackrabbits rushed for a school-record 567 yards vs. the Miners and finished with 689 yards of offense.

**THE COACHES:** Mike Sewak (Virginia '81) is 32-13 in three-plus years as head coach of Georgia Southern and is 1-0 vs. SDSU...Since he joined GSU in 1997, the Eagles have compiled a 92-21 record and won national championships in 1999 and 2000...In his ninth year at the helm of the Jackrabbit program, John Stiegelmeier is 52-41 and is 0-1 vs. GSU.

**THE GAME:** This is the 29th meeting between the two schools, with Appalachian State holding an 18-10 lead in the all-time series...It is the Mountaineers' homecoming...Last year the Mocs won a shootout, 59-56, in Chattanooga, where the two teams combined for 950 yards of offense...ASU is 13-2 in the last 15 meetings with UTC and have won its last 10 against the Mocs at Kidd Brewer...ASU has won 13 straight home games and 10 consecutive league victories at Kidd-Brewer...The Mocs had a three-game losing streak snapped this past Saturday to Western Carolina, 38-20, the team's longest since 1997...WR Emanuel Hassell is one catch away from reaching 100 for his career...Backup QB Matt Lopez threw the first two TD passes of his career vs. WCU...QB Richie Williams has 7,702 yards of total offense and needs two more to move into sole possession of second place in league history...Williams also needs 31 passing yards to become the third Mountaineer -- and ninth player in SoCon history -- to reach 6,500 career passing yards.

**THE COACHES:** Rodney Allison (Texas Tech '80) is 10-21 in his third season as Mocs head coach and is 1-1 vs. ASU...Prior to coming to UTC, Allison was the defensive ends coach at Clemson from 1999-2002...The winningest coach in SoCon football history, Jerry Moore (Baylor '61) is in his 17th season at the helm of the Mountaineer program in 2005...Moore has a 134-65 mark at Appalachian over the course of his 16-plus seasons with the school and is 14-2 vs. the Mocs.

**THE GAME:** It's the 58th meeting between Wofford and The Citadel...The Bulldogs are 40-16-1 vs. the Terriers but Wofford has won the last six games between the two...Wofford won 38-17 a year ago in Spartanburg and have won four of the last five times the game has been played in Charleston...Wofford had its four-game win streak end with a 49-17 loss to Appalachian State...QB Josh Collier rushed for 88 yards and scored on a career-long 57-yard run in the fourth quarter...S Dan Tavani led the Terriers with 10 tackles...The Citadel RB Nuru Goodrum rushed for a touchdown and finished with 118 yards on 18 carries in the team's 49-14 loss to Georgia Southern...LB Porter Johnson is fifth in the league in tackles per game (8.4) and is tops in tackles for loss (13.5).

**THE COACHES:** Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 114-83-1 in his 17 years at the helm...Ayers is 11-8 vs. The Citadel, 9-7 while at Wofford...Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 2-5 overall and is 2-0 vs. the Terriers, with both wins coming while at Lehigh... Higgins was 56-26-1 at Lehigh from 1994-2000, his first collegiate head coaching position.

## This Date in Southern Conference History

**Oct. 29, 1983:** Citadel quarterback Robert Hill posted three Bulldog passing records in a 26-10 loss to Marshall, bettering former Citadel quarterback Marty Crosby's record of 237 pass attempts in a season and surpassing Tony Passander's single season mark of 1,542 passing yards in a contest. Hill also bested his own record of attempts in a game after throwing 46 passes in the loss to the Thundering Herd.

**Oct. 29, 1977:** Down 13, Presbyterian scored 13 points in the fourth quarter to tie Furman 13-13, and give the Paladins their second tie of 1977. The Blue Hose had a chance to win the game, but were unsuccessful on their point after kick.

**Oct. 29, 1977:** UTC fumbled the ball five times in their game with The Citadel, losing three of the fumbles, but they found a way to win, besting the Bulldogs, 21-14, at home.

**Oct. 29, 1994:** Western Carolina quarterback Chad Greene threw for four touchdowns, including three in the second half, in the Catamounts 33-7 win over VMI. The win improved Western Carolina to 5-1 in conference play.

**Oct. 29, 1994:** Furman free safety Mark Tate had two interceptions to lead Furman's defensive effort against East Tennessee's passing game in the Paladins' 33-21 triumph over the Buccaneers. The win gave the Paladins their eighth straight win against the Buccaneers.

**Oct. 29, 1977:** With the score knotted 14-14 in the latter part of the fourth quarter, Chattanooga's I.V. Reeves sprinted eight yards untouched for a touchdown with 4:27 remaining on the game clock to give the Mocs a dramatic 21-14 win over The Citadel.

**Oct. 29, 1983:** The Catamounts found their way to 14 points in the first quarter without the offense even touching the ball in their 44-17 blowout win over The Citadel. Miles Nicholson got things going for the Cats when he intercepted a Bulldog pass on the first play of the game and returned it for a touchdown. Shortly thereafter Ricky Pate blocked a Bulldog punt and fell on it in the end zone for the score to net a 14-0 with just 1:53 gone in the first quarter.

**Oct. 29, 1994:** Todd Donnan threw for three touchdowns and a career-high 302 yards in Marshall's 42-30 defeat of The Citadel in Huntington, W.Va.

**Oct. 29, 1994:** Scott Satterfield passed for 209 yards and a touchdown and ran for another in Appalachian State's 30-16 win over UTC.
