Furman travels to Georgia Southern on Saturday, November 5 for a 4:00 game on Fox Sports Net South.



Two-Minute Drill

• Three teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll. Furman jumps to No. 1 in the poll with Appalachian State continuing to move up the ladder at the No. 7 spot. Georgia Southern jumps five spots to No. 14 this week. Wofford also received votes.

• The ESPN/USA Today Poll has three SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman remains slides up one spot to No. 1 with Appalachian State at the No. 7 spot. Georgia Southern checks in at No. 15. Western Carolina and Wofford also received votes.

• Furman is the first SoCon team to be ranked No. 1 since Georgia Southern held the top spot on October 22, 2001. It is also the Paladins' first time at the No. 1 spot since September 17, 1990.

• Appalachian State's Richie Williams became ASU's all-time career passing leader on Saturday. His 256 yards pushed his career total to 6,725, fifth in the SoCon career annals. His 326 yards of total offense took his career total to 8,028, second in SoCon career records.

• Six student-athletes were named to the national award watch lists. Appalachian State's Richie Williams, Furman's Ingle Martin and Georgia Southern's Jermaine Austin are among the players on the Payton Award watch list. Appalachian State's Marques Murrell, Elon's Chad Nkang and Furman's William Freeman and are all on the Buchanan Award watch list.

• GSU's Jermaine Austin and Jayson Foster became the sixth duo in SoCon history to rush for 1,000 yards apiece in one season. Austin, who rushed for 146 yards and four touchdowns on Saturday, also became the fourth player in league history to rush for 5,000 career yards.

Around the SoCon This Week

Appalachian State (6-2, 4-1 SoCon)

Appalachian State notched its third win in a row with a 35-25 Homecoming win over Chattanooga...It was ASU's 14th consecutive home win and 15th straight home regular season victory...QB **Richie Williams** passed for 256 yards to become the school's career passing leader with 6,725 yards...His total also moves him into fifth place in league history...Williams also rushed for 70 yards and accounted for four touchdowns (2 rushing, 2 passing) for his 12th career game of 300-plus yards of total offense, tying him with UTC's Chris Sanders for the most career games of 300 or more yards of total offense...RB **Kevin Richardson** rushed for 109 yards and a touchdown, his third 100-yard game of the season...WR **Jermaine Little** caught seven passes for 90 yards and also carried the ball four times for 30 yards...LB **Zodd Kelly** led the ASU defense with 13 tackles while also recovering a fumble...The Mountaineers wrap up non-conference play on Saturday as they travel to face I-A LSU.

The Citadel (2-6, 1-4 SoCon)

The Citadel lost its fourth game in a row, a 28-10 decision, to Wofford...RB **Nuru Goodrum** had a game-high 76 yards on the ground and also caught a pass for 12 yards...WR **Kinta Palmer** tossed his second touchdown pass of the season, a 41-yard strike to WR **Ta'Mar Jernigan**...Jernigan and WR **Rontreal Tyler** led the Bulldogs with four catches apiece...P **Mark Kaspar** averaged 42.3 yards on six punts and landed two of them inside the 20...LB **Andrew Rowell** had a career-high 17 tackles, including 1.5 tackles for loss...S **Avery Dingle** had 11 tackles, 10 of them solo...The Bulldogs hit the road for their final conference road contest Saturday against Chattanooga.

Chattanooga (5-4, 2-3 SoCon)

The Mocs dropped their second straight league tilt, 35-25 at nationally-ranked Appalachian State...RB **Eldra Buckley** rushed for a career-best 210 yards on 33 carries...Buckley's total was also a season high by a SoCon player and the most during the regular season since Western Carolina's Fred Boateng rushed for 213 yards vs. Georgia Southern in 2000...RB **Levonte Barber** rushed for a career-best two touchdowns, matching his season rushing TD total entering the game...The Mocs converted all four of its chances in the red zone and were 3-for-3 on fourth down conversions...DB **Jarvis Newson** led the Mocs defense with 12 tackles, while DB **Jeffrey Harrison** added 11...UTC hosts The Citadel on Saturday, the first of its final two home games of the regular season.

Elon (3-6, 0-5 SoCon)

The Phoenix dropped its fifth game in a row, 31-26 to Western Carolina...Elon scored 16 fourth quarter points to fall short...Three of Elon's losses in league play have been by five points or less...QB **Kye Hamilton** was 15-of-32 for 156 yards and two touchdowns...WR **Michael Mayers** and RB **Reggie Hall** each led the team with five catches each, with Mayers netting 78 yards on his catches...Hall added 91 yards on the ground, while RB **Jarrett Meadors** chipped in 59 yards rushing...LB **Chad Nkang** tied for game-high honors with 12 tackles, including 2.5 tackles for loss...Elon is off this week and returns to face The Citadel on the road on Nov. 12.

Furman (7-1, 3-1 SoCon)

Furman was idle last week...The Paladins won their sixth in a row, a 45-6 Homecoming win over Elon on Oct. 22...It was also the sixth straight win over Elon...The Paladins racked up 486 yards of offense and limited the Phoenix to only 183 yards...Furman scored on four of its six possessions in the first half and on three of seven in the second half...QB **Ingle Martin** was 12-for-19 for 220 yards and one touchdown...The Paladins balance in the backfield continued as three players picked up 50 or more yards: **Jerome Felton** (56 yards), **Cedrick Gipson** (51) and **Brandon Mays** (50)...Felton also scored twice...LB **William Freeman** had three tackles for loss and nine total tackles, while LB **Gary Nelson** led the Paladins with 12 tackles...Furman travels to face Georgia Southern on Saturday in a game that will be televised on FSN South.

Georgia Southern (6-3, 4-2 SoCon)

Georgia Southern won its second game in a row, picking up a 55-42 win at South Dakota State...The two teams combined for 1,138 yards of offense...QB **Jayson Foster** rushed for a career-high 178 yards and scored three times to move past the 1,000-yard barrier for the season...Foster also passed for a career-best 131 yards...RB **Jermaine Austin** added 146 yards on the ground and four scores, surpassing 1,000 yards as well on the year...Austin also topped 5,000 career rushing yards, becoming only the fourth player in league history to reach this plateau...The Eagles scored eight times on the ground, tying for the fifth most in one game in league annals...LB **John Mohring** led GSU with 11 tackles and also added two pass deflections, an interception and a pair of tackles for loss...The Eagles host Furman on Saturday in a game that will be televised on FSN South.

Western Carolina (4-3, 3-2 SoCon)

The Catamounts picked up a 31-26 Homecoming win over Elon on Saturday despite being outgained 305-277...RB **Darius Fudge** scored on a 66-yard run and finished with 99 yards rushing...KR **Mike Malone** returned a kick-off 90 yards for a touchdown, the second by a Catamount this season...Malone also took the opening kickoff 80 yards, setting up a field goal...WCU moved to 16-1 under head coach **Kent Briggs** when scoring 25 points or more...LB **James Conklin** recorded a career-high 12 tackles, nine of them solo...WCU hosts Wofford in its final home game of the regular season on Saturday.

Wofford (5-3, 3-2 SoCon)

Wofford knocked off The Citadel for the seventh consecutive time, 28-10...It was also the Terriers' fourth straight win on the road against the Bulldogs...The Terriers scored 14 fourth quarter points, including a 20-yard interception return by DE **Layton Baker**...Wofford ran the ball 68 times for 291 yards...RB **Adrian Young** led the Terrier attack with 72 yards and a touchdown and was followed by 69 yards from RB **Gabriel Jackson**...QB **Josh Collier** passed for 60 yards and ran for another 61...PK **Nick Robinson** connected on all four of his PATs, moving him into sole possession of 11th place in SoCon history with 109...The Terriers head to Western Carolina on Saturday.

The Citadel (2-6, 1-4 SoCon) at Chattanooga (5-4, 2-3 SoCon), 2:00
Finley Stadium/Davenport Field (20,668) • Chattanooga, TN



THE GAME: The 39th all-time meeting between the two schools, with the Mocs leading the series 23-13-2...The Bulldogs won last years meeting, 44-24, in Charleston...The two teams have split the last six games in Chattanooga...The Citadel has not won back-to-back games in the series since 1996-97...The last three times the two teams have met, they have combined to average 60 points a game...The Citadel lost last week at home to Wofford, 28-10, while Chattanooga fell to Appalachian State, 35-25...In his last three games, Bulldog RB Nuru Goodrum is averaging 94.3 ypg...WR Ta'Mar Jernigan has caught four touchdown passes this season, second in the league...UTC RB Eldra Buckley is 96 yards from becoming the third SoCon player this year to rush for 1,000 yards...Buckley had a career-high 210 yards against Appalachian State, the first running back to rush for over 200 yards against the Mountaineers since 1998...Sophomore QB Antonio Miller needs 42 passing yards to reach 1,500 for his career...UTC needs one more win for its first winning season since 1997.

THE COACHES: Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is in his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 2-6 overall... Higgins was 56-26-1 at Lehigh from 1994-2000, his first collegiate head coaching position...Rodney Allison (Texas Tech '80) is 10-22 in his third season as Mocs head coach and is 1-1 vs. The Citadel...Prior to coming to UTC, Allison was the defensive ends coach at Clemson from 1999-2002.



Wofford (5-3, 3-2 SoCon) at Western Carolina (6-3, 3-2), 2:00
E.J. Whitmire Stadium (13,742) • Cullowhee, NC



THE GAME: This is the 27th meeting between the two schools...Wofford holds a 16-11 advantage in the series and has won the last three times the two have met...Since joining the SoCon, the Terriers are 7-1 against the Catamounts...Wofford knocked off The Citadel on the road, 28-10, while Western Carolina held off Elon, 31-26...RB Gabriel Jackson is tenth in the league in rushing, averaging 66.1 ypg...The Terriers have rushed for better than 250 yards in each of their last four games and is second in the league averaging 296 ypg...With 217 yards rushing, WR Brandon Berry is one of six Wofford players with better than 200 yards rushing...In its last four weeks, WCU has returned two kickoffs for touchdowns and have blocked two punts, each resulting in a score...RB Darius Fudge is averaging 71.7 yards per game on the ground, seventh in the SoCon...Fudge went over the 1,000 yard mark following a 99-yard performance vs. the Phoenix...The Catamounts lead the league in total defense, giving up only 314.3 yards per game.

THE COACHES: Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 115-83-1 in his 17 years at the helm...Ayers is 8-4 all-time vs. WCU, 8-1 while at Wofford...Western Carolina head coach Kent Briggs (Western Carolina '79) is in his fourth season as coach of his alma mater...Briggs has tabulated an 18-23 record in his three-plus seasons and is 0-3 vs. Wofford.

THE GAME: This is the 17th meeting in the series, with Georgia Southern holding an 11-5 advantage in the series...The game pits the top two scoring teams in the SoCon...Furman is averaging 39.1 points a game, while the Eagles are second scoring 36.8 points a contest...Furman won last year's game, 29-22, in Greenville...The last two games in the series have been decided by a total of 12 points...GSU is 6-1 all-time at home against Furman, with the Paladins' lone win coming in the 2001 NCAA Playoffs (24-17)...Furman is the first SoCon team to be the top-ranked team in the country since Georgia Southern on Oct. 22, 2001...It is also the Paladins' first time in the top spot since Sept. 17, 1990...QB Ingle Martin needs 148 yards to reach 5,000 yards of total offense for his career...Martin is also 28 yards from moving into the top-10 on Furman's single season passing yardage list and is 339 shy of becoming the first quarterback in school history to pass for 2,000 yards in more than one season...With his next rushing touchdown, Jerome Felton will become only the eighth Furman player to rush for 20 touchdowns in a career...GSU QB Jayson Foster rushed for a career-high 178 yards and scored three times vs. South Dakota State, giving him 1,091 on the season...Foster has 16 touchdowns this year on the ground, tied for the tenth-highest total in league history...RB Jermaine Austin added 146 yards on the ground for his 30th career 100-yard game...Austin also rushed for four touchdowns, only one less than his season-to-date total entering the game...Austin and Foster are only the sixth duo in SoCon history to rush for 1,000 yards in the same season.

This Date in Southern Conference History

Nov. 5, 1983: The Citadel's Lee Glaze caught six passes for 148 yards in the Bulldog's 44-17 loss to eventual NCAA Division I-AA finalist Western Carolina.

Nov. 5, 1977: VMI deftly stepped out of conference against the state's biggest university, soundly beating the University of Virginia 30-6 in Charlottesville. The Keydets had a 23-0 lead at halftime against their Atlantic Coast Conference foe.

Nov. 5, 1977: Chattanooga scored 13 points in the final quarter to pull away from Bowling Green, 37-33 in Bowling Green, Ohio. Gwain Durden rushed 21 times for 144 yards and a 50-yard touchdown for the Mocs in their win over Bowling Green.

Nov. 5, 1983: Randy Joyce was basically the highlight for Appalachian State in their 33-7 loss to Atlantic Coast Conference foe N.C. State. Joyce went 15-for-28 for 144 yards in the contest, which included the Mountaineers only touchdown on the afternoon - a six-yard pass from Joyce to wide receiver Rusty Fuller.

Nov. 5, 1994: Furman's 31-26 loss to Georgia Southern ensured the Paladins their first losing season since 1979, snapping the Southern Conference's longest season non-losing streak in the process at 14.

Nov. 5, 1994: Marrio Greer rushed 15 times for 109 yards and a touchdown in Chattanooga's 42-26 loss to The Citadel. The loss dropped the Mocs to 1-5 in the SoCon and 2-7 overall in Buddy Green's first season at the helm.

Nov. 5, 1994: Travis Jervey rushed for two touchdowns and a then career-high 195 yards in The Citadel's 42-26 win over UTC.

Nov. 12, 1994: It only took a week, but The Citadel's Travis Jervey bested his previous week's career-high by rushing for 224 yards in the Bulldogs' 58-14 win over VMI in the 48th annual Oyster Bowl.

Nov. 5, 1994: Appalachian State finally was able to exhale in the final seconds of the fourth quarter in their 41-40 win over Liberty at Kidd Brewer Stadium. The Flames had pulled the game to within a point when they scored with 19 seconds left on the game clock, but went for the win with a two-point conversion call and failed to convert to give the Mountaineers a narrow escape.
