Notes

• Mercer and Wofford were the only SoCon teams to earn conference sweeps this week, with the Bears securing the sweep in their series against UNCG and the Terriers clinching the sweep in their series against ETSU.

• The Bears earned the sweep in Greensboro, North Carolina, defeating the Spartans 20-10 in Saturday's series finale. Mercer (31-5, 6-0 SoCon) belted five home runs in the squad's 12th consecutive win and sixth series sweep of the spring.

• Junior Angelo DiSpigna, who was named this week's SoCon Player of the Week, blasted two homers and drove in six runs to pace Mercer's offensive outburst in the 20-10 victory. He went 3-for-5 with three runs, six RBIs and two home runs in the win.

• Wofford earned the series sweep over the Bucs, downing ETSU 5-3 on Thursday, 13-2 on Friday and 6-2 on Saturday.

• Mercer fell 15-2 to the Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets on Tuesday, April 19.

• The Terriers overall winning streak now stands at seven, and the home winning streak improves to 14. This is the first time in program history the Terriers have swept both of the first two conference series, with the sweep marking the fourth of the season.

• The victory on Saturday marks the 400th career win for head coach Todd Interdonato.

• The 24th-ranked Wofford baseball team plated two runs to pull ahead and outlast Presbyterian 8-7 in 11 innings in midweek action against the Blue Hose on Tuesday.

• Samford and VMI both went 2-2 overall this week, with the Bulldogs and Keydets both going 2-1 in their series against Western Carolina and The Citadel before falling to Jacksonville State and Virginia Tech on Tuesday.

• Red-shirt sophomore Trey Morgan tossed seven innings of five-hit, no walk ball Thursday against The Citadel in their 5-2 victory over the Bulldogs, earning his first victory of the season. He struck out five and allowed no extra base hits.

• In Saturday's 17-6 win at Western Carolina, Samford sophomore Colton Ledbetter hit two three-run home runs and drove in nine runs. The nine RBIs are the most ever for a Samford player in a Southern Conference game.

• Blake Bortak earned the win in Samford's 7-4 win at Western Carolina on Friday, tossing 4.1 innings in relief, allowing no runs on just two hits and striking out five batters without allowing a walk.

• UNCG finished the week going 1-3, falling in all three games in their series against Mercer before clinching a 13-1 victory over NC A&T on Tuesday.

• Jarman had a career night, going 3-for-3 with five RBIs in the win over the Aggies, both career highs. His home run in the contest was the second of his career, his first coming a few weeks ago against Davidson.

• The Catamounts also earned an 11-3 midweek victory over Gardner-Webb on Tuesday.

• Western Carolina tallied a trio of three-run innings and freshman pitcher Lucas Hartman struck out a career-best nine over a five-inning relief effort in the win.

Player of the Week

Angelo DiSpigna | INF | Jr. | Mercer

DiSpigna went 9-for-17 in his four appearances for Mercer last week, batting .529 and scoring six total runs with three home runs and nine RBIs in the Bears' midweek game against Florida A&M and Mercer's conference series against UNCG. He started the week going 2-for-4 with one RBI in the Bears' 4-3 victory over the Rattlers on Tuesday before going 4-for-4 with two RBIs and one home run in the Bears' 12-8 series-opening win over the Spartans on Thursday. The junior infielder went 0-for-4 on Friday, adding one run and one walk in Mercer's 5-2 victory over UNCG. In Mercer's 20-10 win over the Spartans on Saturday, DiSpigna went 3-for-5 with three runs, six RBIs and two home runs, helping the Bears earn the series sweep over the Spartans to collect Mercer's 12th consecutive victory. The Lawrenceville, Georgia, native concluded the week with a .550 on-base percentage and a 1.059 slugging percentage, while also recording 32 putouts in the field.

Pitcher of the Week

Dalton Rhadans | RHP | Sr. | Wofford

Rhadans threw five innings in his two appearances on the mound for Wofford this week, striking out six batters and allowing no runs and no walks in the Terriers' 5-3 win over ETSU on Thursday and Wofford's 6-2 victory over the Buccaneers on Saturday. He tossed 3.0 shutout innings in game one of the series to clinch the save and pitched two innings in the third game, allowing only two hits and finishing with one strikeout in the win. The Acworth, Georgia, native, surrendered just three total hits, holding ETSU to a .167 average.
