#### **QUICK HITS**

- Two weekends of SoCon play remain. Five teams have six games left, while Chattanooga has a bye this weekend and ETSU next week, the last of regular-season play.
- UNCG was tabbed to win the 2021 SoCon title in voting by the league's head coaches and currently sit atop the league at 16-8 overall.
- Chattanooga infielder Emily Coltharp was named the preseason player of the year, Chattanooga's third-straight preseason POTY selection. Samford pitcher Abby Swaney was selected as the preseason pitcher of the year.
- The SoCon Championship will be held May 13-15 at the site of the No. 1 seed and will feature the top four teams in the standings.

The SoCon is celebrating its 100th anniversary in 2021. The fifth-oldest NCAA Division I college athletic association, the SoCon contested the first-ever collegiate conference basketball tournament in 1921, tackled freshman eligibility in 1922, became the first conference to adopt the 3-point field goal in basketball in 1980 and developed women's championships in 1984.
