### Quick Hits

- After winning the Southern Conference tournament last week, Wofford is making its third trip to the NCAA tournament in the last five years as the Terriers won the Southern Conference tournament in 2010 and 2011.
- Davidson won the Southern Conference regular season championship with a record of 15-1 in league play. It is the third straight season the Wildcats have had the best mark in conference play and marks the third straight year Davidson has advanced to postseason play.
- Chattanooga finished the season 12-4 in conference play. It was the most conference wins for the Mocs since UTC went 12-6 in 2011. UTC is making its first postseason appearance since winning the league crown and advancing to the NCAA tournament in 2009.

## Conference News and Notes

### Nonconference Scheduling

Nine of the 11 SoCon teams participated in an exempt tournament this year. SoCon teams took part in the Battle 4 Atlantis (The Citadel), Charleston Classic (Davidson), Global Sports Shootout (Appalachian State), Las Vegas Invitational (Chattanooga), NIT Season Tip-Off (Elon), Cancun Challenge (Georgia Southern), Gulf Coast Showcase (UNCG), Roundball Classic (Samford) and Coaches vs. Cancer (Western Carolina).

### Head Coaches

Eight of the 11 Southern Conference head coaches returned to the bench in 2013-14. The current head coaches have a combined 67 years of experience in the SoCon. Three new coaches joined the league this season as Niko Medved took over at Furman, while Will Wade is in his first season at Chattanooga. After serving as the interim coach at College of Charleston to close the 2011-12 season, Mark Byington is now the head coach at Georgia Southern.

### Close Encounters

Southern Conference teams lost 13 nonconference games during the 2013-14 season that were decided by one possession or went into overtime. Conversely, league teams have won just six contests that were decided by a single possession or went into an extra frame.

### One-Possession Games

The Southern Conference played 88 league games during the regular season. A total of 17 games (19 percent) were decided by one possession or went into overtime.

- Last season the SoCon had 30 of 108 (28 percent) conference games be decided by one possession.
- In 2012 the league had 32 of 108 (30 percent) conference games be decided by one possession.

### Annual Leaders

Wofford limited its opponents to just 59.1 points per game last season, the second-best mark in Southern Conference history.

- The Terriers lead the league in scoring defense against this season. Wofford is holding its opponents to just 62.4 points per game.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per game.

The Citadel's Marshal Harris III led the SoCon with 5.2 assists per game in 2013, becoming the first Bulldog to lead the league in helpers since Jimmy Tharpe averaged 6.4 assists for The Citadel in 1985-86. Harris finished second in assists in 2014 with 4.2 assists per contest.

Wofford's Karl Cochran topped the league with 2.0 steals per game a season ago. It was the first time a Terrier led the league in steals since Wofford joined the conference in 1997-98.

Georgia Southern's Jelani Hewitt led the league in scoring (19.4 ppg) and is the first Eagle to lead the conference in scoring since Elton Nesbitt in 2006 (21.7 ppg).

### Point Production

Davidson led the Southern Conference with 78.6 points per game this season.

- It is the seventh time in the last nine years that the Wildcats led the SoCon in scoring.

## Southern Conference News and Notes

### Tournament Crown

Wofford won the 2014 Southern Conference tournament as the Terriers won their third title in the last five years. Davidson won the previous two Southern Conference tournaments (2012 and 2013). The Wildcats are the last team to win three consecutive tournaments as Davidson won in 2006, 2007 and 2008.

- NC State and West Virginia own the longest tournament streaks in league history. The Wolfpack were the first team to win six straight tournaments from 1947-52. The Mountaineers claimed six straight crowns from 1955-60.

### Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season but has returned to a single division this season. Eight of the 11 current members won at least a share of a division championship over the last 19 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, did not win a division crown.

- Davidson led the league with 12 division championships, while Chattanooga won eight.

### New Schools

The Southern Conference announced the addition of East Tennessee State, Mercer University and VMI to the league on May 30. All three schools will join the league on July 1, 2014.

- ETSU was a league member from 1978-2005, while VMI was in the Southern Conference from 1924-2003.

### Schedule Adjustment

Southern Conference teams played a 16-game league schedule in 2013-14. With 11 members this season, teams played six conference opponents twice (once at home and once on the road). League teams then faced two opponents only once at home and two other conference opponents once, with both games coming on the road.

- The SoCon will have ten teams in 2014-15 and will return to a double-round robin 18-game conference schedule next season.

### Two-Time Award Winner

Davidson's De'Mon Brooks was named the Southern Conference Tournament's Most Outstanding Player in 2013 after earning the award in 2012.

- Brooks joins East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2003-04), fellow Wildcat Stephen Curry (2007-08) and Wofford's Noah Dahlman (2010-11) as two-time winners over the last 10 years.

### Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had five teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last six years.

- Georgia Southern won 15 games in 2012 after winning just five in 2011.
- Furman won 22 games in 2011 after posting 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

### Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 965, nine points higher than the national average of 956 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the fifth consecutive year that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate.

- The Southern Conference's APR score of 965 in men's basketball was the seventh-highest among all Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 24. Southern Conference men's basketball earned a 78, topping the Division I average of 70. The eight point difference between the conference average and the Division I average is the largest of any sport in the league.
