## SoCon PLAYER OF THE WEEK (3/28)

### Maycin Brown, Jr., 3B, UNCG

Brown was perfect at the plate over the weekend, going 8-for-8 with six RBIs and eight runs scored in UNCG's three-game sweep of Mercer. Six of her eight hits went for extra bases, as she complemented her 1.000 batting average with a 2.500 slugging percentage. She was also hit by a pitch and hit a sacrifice fly, giving her an on-base percentage of .900 for the week. She was 2-for-2 with two doubles, a sac fly and two runs scored in Saturday's first game before hitting two-run home runs in each of the first two innings in Saturday's second game as part of a 3-for-3 effort in which she scored three runs. In Sunday's game, she fell a triple short of the cycle, scoring three times on the day.



## SoCon PITCHER OF THE WEEK (3/28)

### Morgan Scott, Jr., UNCG

Scott picked up two of UNCG's three wins over Mercer on the weekend, going 2-0 with a 1.75 ERA in 8 innings of work. She earned her first win of the weekend in Saturday's first game, allowing a run on five hits and two walks in 3 innings, striking out six. The next day, she picked up a 5-inning complete-game win, allowing a run on three hits and a walk, striking out seven. For the weekend, she struck out 13 against just three walks.



## NOTES

- Defending Southern Conference champion UNCG visits 2021 runner-up Western Carolina to highlight this weekend's softball schedule.
- The Spartans and Catamounts faced off five times last season, with UNCG sweeping WCU on the final weekend to clinch the regular-season title and topping the Catamounts twice in the SoCon tournament, including in the title game.
- UNCG opened league play with a three-game sweep of Mercer last weekend, riding its high-octane offense to a trio of run-rule wins. Junior third baseman Maycin Brown hit 1.000 on the weekend, going 8-for-8 at the plate en route to SoCon Player of the Week and Louisville Slugger/NFCA Player of the Week honors. Morgan Scott, who earned two wins in the circle against Mercer to claim SoCon Pitcher of the Week laurels, was even better in a 4-0 shutout of Radford on Wednesday, striking out a career-best 16 batters against no walks.
- The Catamounts, who have played just two games at home this season so far, won their league-opening series against ETSU, 2-1. After the squads split the first two games of the series, Western Carolina claimed the rubber match 14-6 in six innings. In the first game of Wednesday's doubleheader at North Carolina A&T, junior Brooklyn Brewington broke the program record for stolen bases in a season with her 17th of the year. She would add two more for the day.
- Chattanooga, which hosts ETSU this weekend, also won its opening SoCon series, sweeping last Saturday's doubleheader against Furman before dropping the finale Sunday. Freshman first baseman Acelynn Sellers hit .455 and slugged .818 against the Paladins. This weekend's series will mark the end of a stretch of 12 out of 13 games at home for the Mocs.
- ETSU snapped a 17-game losing streak with its 3-2 win over Western Carolina in the first game of last Sunday's doubleheader. The Bucs saw senior outfielder Andrea Sarhatt hit .700 and slug 1.000 on the weekend.
- Chattanooga swept ETSU last season, posting a pair of shutouts in the April 2 doubleheader before completing the sweep with a 3-2 win in 11 innings the following day.
- Samford opens SoCon play this weekend when it visits Mercer. The Bulldogs dropped a doubleheader at Mississippi State last weekend, losing both games by 2-1 scores. Samford's doubleheader against Troy on Wednesday was postponed due to inclement weather.
- After suffering a sweep at the hands of UNCG last weekend, Mercer bounced back with a 7-1 win over Florida A&M on Wednesday, snapping a six-game losing streak. Diamond Williams and Kylie Helm had three hits apiece against the Rattlers.
- Samford took two of three from the Bears last season, splitting a doubleheader on March 26 before clinching the series the following day.
- Furman, which swept a Wednesday doubleheader against College of Charleston to push its winning streak to three games, is idle this weekend but returns to action Wednesday when it visits No. 18 Clemson.
