Conference News and Notes

Close Encounters

Southern Conference teams are 13-7 this season in nonconference games that have been decided by one possession or went into overtime.

- SoCon teams went 7-5 in nonconference games that were decided by one possession or went into overtime last year.
- League teams went 6-13 in nonconference games that were decided by one possession or went into overtime during the 2013-14 season.

Athletes of the Month

- November - QJ Peterson, Jr., G, VMI

Peterson averaged 20.6 points per game during the month of November and scored at least 20 points in each of his last four games during the month, including a 26-point performance at Virginia Tech. Peterson averaged 5.6 rebounds per game.

- December - Stephon Jelks, So., F, Mercer

Jelks averaged a double-double over six games in December as the Bears went 4-2. The sophomore averaged 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds and closed the month with three straight double-doubles at Auburn, Arkansas and Kennesaw State. Jelks pulled down 15 rebounds in both games against SEC opponents and scored a career-high 21 points in a win at KSU.

- January - Spencer Collins, Sr., G, Wofford

Collins averaged 19.8 points, 4.2 rebounds and 2.3 assists in 10 games as the Terriers went 7-3 during the month. Collins scored 20 points in five different games and produced three games of at least 25 points, including a 30-point effort in an overtime loss at Mercer. Collins connected on 44 percent of his field goal attempts and was 40-of-72 (.556) from 3-point range.

- February - Torrian Brummit, Sr., F, Western Carolina

Torrian Brummitt led the Catamounts to a 7-2 record during February. The senior nearly averaged a double-double as he posted 16.0 points and 9.0 rebounds during February. The Columbus, Ga., native posted four double-doubles during the month and scored in double figures in eight of nine games. Brummitt shot 56 percent from the field and was even better from 3-point range, connecting on 60 percent of his attempts from beyond the arc. He added 16 assists, nine blocked shots and eight steals in February for the Catamounts

One-Possession Games

Southern Conference teams played 90 league games during the 2015-16 regular season. Twenty one games (23 percent) were decided by one possession or went into overtime.

- In 2015 the league had 23 of 90 (26 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2014 the league had 17 of 88 (19 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2013 the league had 30 of 108 (28 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2012 the league had 32 of 108 (30 percent) conference games decided by one possession.

Southern Conference News and Notes

Annual Leaders

Furman led the league in scoring defense as the Paladins allowed just 66.5 points per game.

- Wofford led the SoCon in fewest points allowed for four straight seasons (2012-15).
Furman was the last team other than Wofford to lead the league in scoring defense back in 2011.

Wofford led the league in 3-point field goal percentage (.408). It was the highest percentage by a SoCon team since Davidson connected on 41.7 percent of its 3-pointers during the 2002-03 season.

Mercer leads the league in rebounding margin (+8.8). It is the highest margin in the league since College of Charleston was +9.0 in 2006.

Player of the Year

Furman's Stephen Croone was named the Player of the Year by both the league coaches and media. Croone is the first Paladin to win the award since Chuck Vincent in 1998.

Sudden Impact

Wofford's Fletcher Magee was named the leagues Freshman of the Year, becoming the third Terrier to earn the award (Karl Cochran, 2012; Ian Chadwick, 1998).

Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 955. It was the seventh consecutive year that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate.

Preseason Honors

Chattanooga was picked to win the 2015-16 Southern Conference championship in pre-season balloting conducted by the league's head coaches. The Mocs returned four starters and nine lettermen from last season's team that went 22-10.

- Wofford was picked second and earned two first-place votes while Mercer was tabbed third and earned the final first-place vote.
- Chattanooga's Casey Jones was named the league's preseason Player of the Year and was joined on the preseason all-conference team by teammate Justin Tuoyo. Eight of the league's ten teams had at least one player on the preseason all-conference team.

Familiar Faces

Southern Conference teams returned 85 lettermen for the 2014-15 season. Eight of 10 schools boasted at least eight returnees from last season. League teams averaged 8.5 returners from 2014-15.

- Conference teams returned 31 starters from last year, an average of 3.1 per team. Furman returned all five starters from last season, while Chattanooga and VMI brought back four.
- Three of the 10 members from the 2015 Coaches All-Conference team returned for 2015-16.

Tournament Title

Chattanooga won the Southern Conference tournament title, giving the Mocs their 11th tournament crown. UTC is now 11-7 in the tournament title game and trails only Davidson for the most tournament championships (12). ETSU and Furman have both won six tournament crowns and Wofford has won four tourney titles.

- Chattanooga's Matt McCall won the conference tournament in his first season at the helm. The last head coach to win the tournament in his first season was Chattanooga's John Shulman in 2005.
- UTC's women's team also won the Southern Conference Tournament, making Chattanooga the only school in league history that has swept both tournaments.
