## Last Game

Nov. 22 - No. 15 South Carolina State 55, North Carolina A&T 0  
S.C. State recorded its third-straight shutout with a resounding 55-0 win at North Carolina A&T. Running back Will Ford rushed for 169 yards and a touchdown to claim the MEAC rushing title while Travil Jamison scored three times on the day. The Bulldogs' defense limited the Aggies to 41 yards of total offense and three first downs.

Nov. 22 - No. 2 Appalachian State 35, Western Carolina 10  
Appalachian State overcame a 10-7 halftime deficit by outscoring Western Carolina 28-0 in the second half to complete a perfect SoCon season. Freshman QB DeAndre Presley, starting in place of an injured Armani Edwards, accounted for 314 yards and four touchdowns while making his first career start.

## Game Notes

Three-time defending national champion Appalachian State is making its 16th playoff appearance since 1987 ... The Bulldogs are making their third postseason appearance and first since 1982 ... ASU has won nine consecutive home playoff games ... SCSU's last playoff victory was a 17-0 shutout of SoCon member Furman in 1982.

Nov. 22 - No. 10/9 Wofford 35, No. 23/20 Furman 10  
 The Terrier defense stopped the Paladins on fourth down on five-of-six attempts, and Ben Widmyer scored two rushing touchdowns and added a passing touchdown for Wofford. Wofford was led by Dane Romero with 97 yards and one touchdown, while Ben Widmyer had 80 yards rushing with two touchdowns, plus 125 yards and a touchdown passing. The Wofford defense had two sacks and Jason Leventis led the team with nine tackles.

Nov. 22 - No. 1 James Madison 58, Towson 27  
 James Madison completed its winningest regular season in school history as well as the program's first outright league title at the Division I level. Rodney Landers ran for 117 yards and three touchdowns and completed nine of 12 passes for 86 yards and a score to lead JMU. Eugene Holloman ran for 131 yards and Griff Yancey ran for three scores.

## Game Notes

Saturday's matchup is the second straight first round game between JMU and a SoCon team - Appalachian State edged the Dukes, 28-27, in 2007 ... Wofford also faced a seeded team in 2007, defeating Montana, 23-22, in Missoula.

# SoCon News and Notes



**Appalachian Sits Atop SoCon Mountain Again:** Appalachian State wrapped up at least a share of its fourth straight Southern Conference championship on Nov. 15 with a 24-16 win over Elon and completed the perfect SoCon season a week later at WCU. The Mountaineers joined an exclusive list of teams who have won at least four SoCon titles in a row.

**SoCon Teams Set Winning Standard This Decade:** In research compiled by the Big Sky Conference, the Southern Conference boasts three of the top five winningest teams in FCS football this decade (2000-present). Appalachian State's 89 overall victories during that span trail only Montana (102) while Furman (77) and Georgia Southern (76) sit in the fourth and fifth spots, respectively.

**Evans Crosses the 1,000-Yard Plateau Again:** Samford sophomore running back Chris Evans became the first SoCon player to surpass the 1,000-yard mark this season in the Nov. 8 27-17 win at Georgia Southern. He finished his sophomore campaign with 1,284 yards. Evans rushed for 1,033 yards as a freshman in 2007. With 2,317 yards in just 22 career games (105.3 ypg), Evans ranks seventh among all active FCS players in career yards per game average. He is also the leading active rusher in the FCS among sophomores.

**Georgia Southern Sets FCS Overtime Record:** In its 44-41, triple overtime victory over The Citadel on Nov. 1, Georgia Southern became the first team in the 31-year history of the FCS to play in four overtime games in one season. The Eagles finished 3-1 in overtime games this season, coupling a loss to Wofford with extra-session victories against Northeastern, Western Carolina and The Citadel. Seven FCS teams have played three overtime games in a season - most recently done in 2007 by Morgan State (MEAC) and Rhode Island (Colonial).

**SoCon Pair Among Nation's Rushing Elite:** Appalachian State junior quarterback Armanti Edwards and Samford sophomore running back Chris Evans are among the nation's elite when it comes to 100-yard rushing games. Through Nov. 22, both rank in the FCS top 25 in active career 100-yard games; however, a deeper look at the rankings shows the each is tops nationally among his classmates. Edwards' 17 100-yard performances are equaled only by fellow juniors David McCarthy of Albany and Trevyn Smith of Weber State, and Evans' 11 games over the century mark are the most nationally among sophomores.

**Edwards Becomes SoCon's Career Total Offense Leader:** With 440 yards of total offense on Oct. 31 against Wofford, ASU's Armanti Edwards became the SoCon's all-time leader in total offense, surpassing the mark of former Mountaineer quarterback Richie Williams (9,370, 2002-05). Edwards now boasts 9,976 total yards in 37 games (269.6 ypg).

**Hudgins Rewriting Record Books:** Elon junior wide receiver Terrell Hudgins continues to shatter records with his latest entry into the SoCon record book coming in the form of a career mark. With a seven-catch, 120-yard effort against Western Carolina on Nov. 8, Hudgins surpassed Marshall's Mike Barber for the most receiving yards in league history. Hudgins broke the league records for career receptions and receiving touchdowns earlier this season. Close on Hudgins' heels is The Citadel junior Andre Roberts whose three touchdowns against Wofford (Nov. 8) moved him to second all-time on the career charts with 29.

**Experienced Coaches:** Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 272 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 177 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (56 victories) needs eight victories to enter the top 10.

**SoCon Players Make NFL Impact:** 23 players (21 on active roster, 2 on practice squads) with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Efram Hill and Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and four Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... **SoCon Well-Represented on Payton/Buchanan Watch Lists:** Three Southern Conference players were named to the Payton Award watch list while Appalachian State sophomore safety Mark LeGree, the nation's leader in interceptions, was named to the final Buck Buchanan Award watch list ... ASU QB Armanti Edwards is joined on the Payton Watch List by wide receivers Terrell Hudgins (Elon) and Andre Roberts (The Citadel) ... Georgia Southern's Jayson Foster was the 2007 Payton Award winner, marking the fourth SoCon winner of that award.

**SoCon to Begin League Hall of Fame:** The Southern Conference will induct its first-ever hall of fame class in the spring of 2009 with a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C. ... the 88-year old league is the fifth-oldest Division I conference in the country and has seen such stars as Arnold Palmer (Wake Forest), Jerry West (West Virginia), Terrell Owens (Chattanooga) and "Hot Rod" Hundley (West Virginia) play in the league in addition to legendary coaches such as Adolph Rupp (Kentucky), Everett Case (North Carolina State), Wallace Wade (Alabama, Duke), Bear Bryant (Kentucky), General Robert Neyland (Tennessee) and Lefty Dreisell (Davidson).

## Southern Conference Tiebreaker Procedure

**NCAA Automatic Bid:** The Conference champion shall be awarded an automatic bid to the NCAA FCS Playoffs, provided it is eligible to compete in the post-season under NCAA guidelines. In the event that co-champions are declared, the automatic bid will be awarded as follows:

- A. In the case of a two-way tie, the automatic bid will be awarded to the winner of the game between the tied teams during the regular season;
- B.
  1. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss records of the tied teams against each other is first considered (i.e., head to head concept).
  2. If the teams are still tied, then each team's record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered.
  3. If the tie is still not broken, the teams' won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken.
  4. If the tie is still not broken, the team with the fewest points allowed among the tied teams shall be considered.
  5. If this does not resolve the tie, then the automatic bid will be determined by a random draw conducted by the Commissioner;
- C. In the event of multiple ties after a three-way tie, the same procedure as used to break a three-way tie will be applied until the tie is broken.

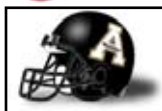

## Game Times Decrease with New Rule Changes in 2008

When the revised rules regarding the play clock went into effect this year, many thought game times would decrease again, much like during the 2006 season. Rules changes for the 2008 season include the institution of a 40-second play clock that begins immediately following the completion of a play, except in dead ball situations. Also, when a ball carrier runs out of bounds, the clock is stopped, but it is started again when the ball is set for play (except for the final two minutes of each half.)

Each week, a panel will select an Offensive, Defensive, Special Teams and Freshman of the Week. Honorees will be released to the media on Monday afternoons via the conference website (www.soconsports.com) and by e-mail.

## Postseason Awards

Following the conclusion of the regular season, two all-conference teams are selected. Voting will be conducted by the league's coaches and the Southern Conference Sports Media Association (SCSMA). Each group selects a first-team and a second-team as well as an Offensive Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and Coach of the Year. The conference coaches also select a recipient of the Jacobs Blocking Trophy, awarded to the top lineman in the conference.

The Southern Conference will host a weekly teleconference featuring the league's head coaches each Tuesday morning throughout the season beginning on August 26 through November 25. The teleconferences will continue throughout the FCS postseason, as needed.
