## PLAYER OF THE WEEK Andrew Goudelock College of Charleston

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games November 25-December 1. Goudelock helped lift the Cougars to an 82-80 overtime victory over South Carolina last week. He scored 20 points, including a jump shot with 2.6 seconds left in regulation that sent the game to overtime.

Goudelock recorded a game-high six assists in the victory over the Game-cocks. He went 8-for-18 from the field and connected on 3-of-4 free throw attempts. The Lilburn, Ga., native added a steal and blocked shot in the win. It was the third time this season Goudelock has recorded at least 20 points. He leads the Cougars and is second in the conference in scoring (17.8 ppg) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.6). Goudelock leads the Southern Conference in minutes played per game (35.5).

## **TEAM REPORTS**

#### APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- ASU's faster pace of play has yielded results on the offensive side of the floor with the team averaging 82.4 points, the 28th highest average in the nation through its first five games. The team is averaging 80.8 possessions per 40 minutes after averaging 68.7 with last year's slower lineup.
- ASU is averaging 44.6 rebounds per game, this sixth highest mark in the nation. The Mountaineers are +9.8 in rebounding margin.
- The Mountaineers visit Wofford on Saturday (Dec. 6).

#### **CHATTANOOGA MOCS**



- Senior Nicchaeus Doaks has recorded at least 10 rebounds in four of Chattanooga's six games this season. Doaks leads the league in rebounding (11.7 rpg) and is ninth in scoring (15.0 ppg). He has three doubledoubles this season.
- Senior Stephen McDowell is sixth in the league in scoring (16.0 ppg) and ranks second in made three pointers per game (3.7 3fg).
- The Mocs have 13 days off before facing Davidson on December 13.

#### **ELON PHOENIX**



- Ola Atoyebi scored a team-high 15 points in Thursday's loss to College of Charleston. Junior Devan Carter pulled down a career-best seven rebounds, while Chris Long recorded a career-high eight assists.
- Senior Brett James is just 11 points shy of the 1,000-point plateau. James is on pace to become just the 32nd player in school history to reach the career milestone. He
- is the league's active career leader in blocked shots with 71.
- The Phoenix then host The Citadel Saturday evening.

#### **UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS**



- UNC Greensboro used its fifth different starting lineup of the season in Thursday's 57-50 loss to The Citadel. Landon Clement scored a game-high 15 points against the Bulldogs after being held scoreless the past two games.
- Mikko Koivisto has at least one three-pointer in 29 consecutive games, the second longest streak in school history. Scott Hartzell holds the record with a trey in 42 straight games from Feb. 21, 1994 through Jan. 13, 1996. Koivisto has at least one trey in 44 of the last 45 games.
- The Spartans host College of Charleston Saturday afternoon.

#### **SAMFORD BULLDOGS**



- Samford has been one of the top defensive teams in the league this season. The Bulldogs lead the SoCon in points allowed (58.6 ppg) and field goal percentage allowed (.385). The Bulldogs also average 6.4 steals per game.
- The Bulldogs have made at least one 3-point field goal in 506 consecutive games. The last time that Samford did not make a 3-point basket was on Jan. 19, 1991, against Texas-San Antonio. The Bulldogs have also made at least two 3-pointers in 475-straight contests dating back to Feb. 8, 1992, when Samford finished 1-of-6 from beyond the arc against Mercer.
- Samford will face Georgia Southern for the first time in 16 years on Saturday (Dec. 6) in Statesboro. The teams last met on March 7, 1992. It is Samford's first league game as a member of the SoCon.

### WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- The Catamounts have three players averaging doublefigures including Harouna Mutombo (14.8 ppg), Brandon Giles (14.0 ppg) and Jake Robinson (12.8 ppg).
- Junior Brandon Giles had his consecutive double-digit scoring game streak snapped at 20 against San Diego State. Classmate Jake Robinson has the team's longest current consecutive streak at 10 games.
- Western Carolina travels to face Kent State Saturday at 7:00 p.m.

### **COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS**



- Sophomore Antwaine Wiggins scored a career-high 20 points in CofC's 77-69 win over Elon Thursday. Wiggins made a career-best six three pointers in the win. CofC is off to its best start (6-1) since the 2003-04 season when the Cougars started 9-1.
- Head coach Bobby Cremins is two wins shy of 500 for his career. He currently ranks 74th on the NCAA's all-time victories list, while his 498 career wins ranks 17th on the active wins total list.
- The Cougars visit UNC Greensboro Saturday.

#### DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Senior Andrew Lovedale is one of just two players in the SoCon to rank in the top ten in both scoring (14.8 ppg) and rebounding (10.7 rpg). He leads the league with four double-doubles in 2008-09.
- Davidson owns the top scoring offense in the league. The Wildcats average 89.2 points per game and are +21.3

points per game in their six games this season. Davidson also leads the league in assists with 16.7 assists per game.

 Davidson faces NC State Saturday (Dec. 6) at Time Warner Arena in Charlotte. The Wildcats then take on West Virginia on Dec. 9 at Madison Square Garden.

#### **FURMAN PALADINS**



- Sophomore Jordan Miller has dramatically increased his production from last year. Miller averaged 5.2 points and 2.1 rebounds per game as a freshman in 2007-08. He leads the Paladins with 14.7 points per game through five games this season. Miller is shooting 49 percent from the field.
- Bryson Barnes has recorded at least 10 points and five rebounds in each of Furman's last three games. The sophomore ranks leads the SoCon with 2.0 blocked shots per game.
- Furman travles to face South Carolina Friday night (Dec. 5) in Columbia.

#### **GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES**



- Willie Powers recorded the first 20-point game by a GSU player this season against Austin Peay. He shot 6-for-12 from the floor, 3-for-5 from 3-point land and 5-for-6 from the charity stripe.
- Georgia Southern has been one of the better SoCon teams from beyond the three-point arc. The Eagles have

connected on over 37 percent of their attempts from three-point range, the fourth-best mark in the league.

 The Eagles host Samford Saturday in the league opener for both teams. GSU is 5-4 in league openers under Jeff Price.

#### THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Three Bulldogs scored in double figures as The Citadel downed UNC Greensboro Thursday night. Cameron Wells narrowly missed his third double-double of the season as he scored a teamhigh 12 points and pulled down nine rebounds.
- The Citadel is second in the conference in scoring defense. The Bulldogs have yielded just 63.5 points per game this season. The Citadel has allowed less than 60 points in four of its last five games.
- The Bulldogs face Elon on the road Saturday (Dec. 6).

#### **WOFFORD TERRIERS**



- Tim Johnson (8.4 rpg) and Noah Dahlman (7.0 rpg) are both on the league's top ten rebounding list. They have each led the team in rebounding twice this season. The duo has combined for three double-doubles through five games.
- Junior Salters is now tenth all-time at Wofford with 365 career three-point attempts.
- Wofford opens its conference slate Saturday night at home against Appalachian State.

## Conference Notes

### STREAKING

Davidson will carry a 30-game conference winning streak into league play December 13 against Chattanooga. The Wildcats won their final 10 games during league play in 2006-07, before posting a 20-0 mark last year. Davidson's streak is the third-longest conference consecutive wins streak in league history.

• West Virginia won a league-best 44 straight conference games from 1956-1960. North Carolina won 34 straight league games from 1923-25.

#### Two For Three

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

• Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

#### Non-Conference Scheduling

Southern Conference teams are scheduled to take on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams will participate in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

• SoCon teams are scheduled to participate in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

### **BRACKETBUSTERS 2009**

Four Southern Conference teams will take part in the 2009 ESPNU BracketBusters event February 20-21. The event will feature 13 nationally televised games - on either ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU - selected from a pool of 102 teams.

• Davidson and Georgia Southern have been designated as home teams during the event, while Appalachian State and Elon will take to the road. The matchups for the 13 nationally televised games will be announced Feb. 2.

## SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## Conference Notes

#### TOURNEY TIME

The 2009 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 6-9 at McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga. All 12 members of the Southern Conference will take part in the conference tournament. The championship game, scheduled for March 9, will be televised by ESPN2.

• The 2009 tournament will be the second time the league has held its conference championship in Chattanooga, after using the same site in 2005. The host Mocs downed UNC Greensboro, 65-62, in the final that year.

#### HALL OF FAME

Southern Conference Commissioner John Iamarino announced the formation of the SoCon Hall of Fame for 2009. The league will induct it's inaugural class during a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C., on May 9. The Southern Conference is in it's 88th season of intercollegiate competition and will begin recognizing many prominent student-athletes, coaches and administrators from the 43 current and former institutions that have been a part of the league's distinguished history.

• Among the nominees for consideration from Southern Conference men's basketball are Dick Groat (Duke), "Hot" Rod Hundley (West Virginia), Frank Selvy (Furman) and Jerry West (West Virginia).

#### Experience on the Bench

All 12 head coaches return to the bench for 2008-09. The current leage head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

• Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

### Experience on the Court

The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

• Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

#### SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

### Preseason Plaudits

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.

#### NEW MEMBERSHIP

Samford University, located in Birmingham, Ala., begins its first season as a member of the Southern Conference after officially joining the league on July 1, 2008. The Bulldogs, who play their home games in the 5,000-seat Pete Hanna Center, finished last season 14-16, including a 10-10 mark in Ohio Valley conference play.
