NOTES

•Nine games have gone into overtime so far this season with six of them going into double overtime.

•ETSU's senior Cameron Woodfin is now one assist from tying the all-time career record for assists. He currently sits second on the all-time list with 19, trailing only ETSU legend David Geno (2010-13) with 20.

•ETSU's all-time record is 96-72-31, making them four wins away from the programs 100th win.

•RPI updates have ETSU's strength of schedule as high as third in the nation with matchups against two top-five teams and five of its seven opponents thus far finishing in the top-100.

•Mercer is now 4-1-2 on the season, matching the new best seven-game winnings percentage (.714) under head coach Brad Ruzzo.

•Hurricane Florence had an impact on this past weeks games. UNCG had two home contests cancelled, one against Elon (Sept. 15) and one against North Carolina (Sept. 18). The Sept. 15 game against Elon has been rescheduled for Sept. 18 and the Spartans will still no longer play in-state rivals North Carolina. Wofford's game against Bowling Green and VMI's game against Gardner-Webb were also cancelled and postponed, respectively.

•Conference match-ups begin Oct. 6.

The Paladins went 1-0 on the week, picking up a 2-1 win over South Carolina on Tuesday. The junior from Wichita, Kansas, netted the winning goal against the Gamecocks in the 82nd minute, marking Furman's second goal in 46 seconds.
