POLL POSITION: Appalachian State is ranked No. 1 in the FCS Coaches Poll and No. 2 by the Sports Network. The Mountaineers have held the No. 1 ranking in the coaches poll for the second week in a row.

- Elon is ranked 11th by the coaches and 10th by the Sports Network.
- Georgia Southern is ranked No. 24 by the FCS Coaches.
- Furman is ranked No. 23 in the Sports Network Poll.

ELITE COMPANY: Elon quarterback Scott Riddle has led the conference in passing yards each of the past three seasons. If Riddle leads the SoCon again in 2010, he will become the first player in league history to lead the conference in passing yards for four consecutive seasons. Marshall's Michael Payton (1990-92) is the only other player to lead the conference in passing three straight years.

- Samford's Chris Evans has led the league in rushing the past two years. He has a chance to join Furman's Stanford Jennings (1981-83) and VMI's Thomas Haskins (1994-96) as the only players in SoCon history to lead the league in rushing three straight seasons.

PASSING FANCY: Elon's Scott Riddle became the Southern Conference's all-time leading passer with 244 yards through the air against Shaw University on September 11. Riddle now has 10,877 career passing yards, surpassing Armanti Edwards' (Appalachian State 2006-2009) career mark of 10,392. It is one of five major career passing marks the senior signal caller owns.

DEFENSIVE ROTATION: Elon led the conference in total defense last season, yielding just 248.3 yards per game. It was the eighth straight season that a different school led the conference in total defense. Chattanooga is the only team that has not led the league in total defense at least once, dating back to 2002.

- Georgia Southern currently boasts the No. 11 total defense in the nation. The Eagles limited their first three opponents to 268.7 total yards per game. Georgia Southern limited Navy to just 109 yards rushing last week, the lowest output on the ground for the Midshipmen since 2002.
- The Eagles have held their opponents to just 14.0 points per game, the seventh best mark in the nation.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 952, eight points higher than the national average of 944 for Division I football programs. It was the second consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

HELMET DECAL: Throughout the 2010 season, Southern Conference football teams will show their support for those being negatively impacted along the Gulf Coast by wearing helmet decals with the initials GC.



More than 160 SoCon football players come from states that share a coastline being affected by the oil spill. The nine institutions that play SoCon football agreed to display the decals to express their support and encouragement for the people living in the region.

Use of the decal was approved by the NCAA's rules committee and supervisory officiating organization upon request by the conference.

EXPERIENCED COACHES: Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 290 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 192 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (100) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (63 victories) needs one more victory to tie Jim Donnan for tenth place.

FAMILIAR FACES: Wofford returned a league-high 20 starters for the 2010 season. The Terriers boast nine returning starters on both offense and defense. The Citadel's offense and Western Carolina's defense returned the fewest amount of starters (5) of any offensive or defensive unit in the league.

- The league's nine teams combined to return 66 percent of their starters (148 of 225) from 2009.

APPALACHIAN BUILDS SOCON WIN STREAK: After pulling out a dramatic 42-41 victory over Chattanooga on September 4, the Appalachian State Mountaineers currently boast a 21-game conference win streak. The Mountaineers' run is the longest streak of its kind in school history and is the second-longest win streak in league history. Appalachian State puts its streak on the line Saturday at Samford.

West Virginia holds the record with 30-straight SoCon wins from 1952-59.

PAYTON AWARD PEDIGREE: Appalachian State senior quarterback Armanti Edwards became the first player to win the Walter Payton Award in back-to-back years after being named the top offensive player in FCS football in 2008 and 2009. He was the second straight SoCon quarterback to win the award, following Jayson Foster (Georgia Southern) in 2007. Five SoCon student-athletes have been honored with the award.

APPALACHIAN JOINS SOCON RECORD BOOKS: Appalachian State finished 8-0 in the Southern Conference last season, wrapping up its fifth consecutive league title. The Mountaineers are now just the second SoCon team to win five league titles in a row.

SOCON TEAMS SET WINNING STANDARD DURING DECADE: The Southern Conference boasts three of the top 10 winningest teams in FCS football (among playoff-qualifiers) from 2000-2009. Appalachian State's 101 overall victories during that span trailed only Montana (118) while Furman (83) and Georgia Southern (81) ranked sixth and eighth, respectively.

SOCON PLAYERS MAKE NFL IMPACT: Fifteen players with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Pro Bowl DB Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and two Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ...
