


Wes Pope Elon Junior Quarterback Jamestown, N.C.

His .857 completion percentage was the highest by a Mountaineer since Richie Williams completed an NCAA record 40-of-45 passes in a 30-29 win over Furman in 2004. In just four career starts, the true freshman has 906 yards and seven touchdowns.

The No. 11 ranked Bison scored the game's final 24 points in handing the Eagles their worst home loss since 1994. John Mohring registered a game-high 12 tackles for the Eagles. The Bison was led by quar-terback Steve Walker, who passed for 171 yards and two TDs

Game Notes

Elon might yield 370.2 yards per game to opponents but don't blame senior linebacker Chad Nkang. He leads the league in tackles, averaging 11.0 per game with 7.5 tackles for loss. Georgia Southern's balanced offense features a pair of talented running backs in sophomore Chris Covington (112.2 ypg rushing) and Lamar Lewis (97.5 ypg) along with quarterback Travis Clark (160.0 ypg passing while completing 56.4 percent of his passes). The Eagles have outscored the Phoenix 97-21 the last two years.

Tyler Thigpen's TD pass to Jerome Simpson with 5:41 left in the contest proved to be the difference as Coastal Carolina (3-2) stopped Furman (4-2, 2-0) in Conway, S.C. The Paladins rushed for 210 yards in the contest.

Game Notes

Both teams lost heart-breakers last week as The Citadel drove inside the red zone at game's end only to turn the ball over on downs. Furman lost a 29-27 decision to non-conference foe Coastal Carolina. Southpaw quarterback Duran Lawson is second in the league in passing (191.4 ypg) while completing 64.4 percent of his passes. Junior defensive back Joshua Lawson (no relation) is fourth in the conference in tackles with 9.4 tpg. Furman's Jerome Felton is second in the nation in scoring with 16 TDs. He (85.7 ypg) and teammate Cedrick Gipson (83.2 ypg) combine for 168.9 yards per game. Furman has won nine of the last 11 meetings with The Citadel but the Paladins struggled to a 39-31 victory in 2005 in three overtimes and Furman has won four of the last seven games against the Bulldogs in Greenville.


