- Defending regular-season champion UNCG was picked by the league's head coaches to retain the crown, narrowly edging two-time defending tournament champion Furman in the preseason poll (see below).
- ETSU forward Fletcher Ekern returns this season after leading the league in goals with 10 and finishing second in points with 23 in 2015.
- Wofford senior forward Matthew Aurednik enters the 2016 season as the SoCon's active leader in career points (47) and goals (21). Teammate and classmate Garrett Closs is the league's active leader in most goalkeeper stats, including goals against average (1.55), saves (127), wins (20) and shutouts (eight).
- Mercer senior keeper Jeremy Booth, who has been active in the league for just one year, shares the active shutout lead with Closs with eight.
- VMI will be under the direction of new head coach Michael Bonelli, who came to the Keydets after two years at the helm for St. Mary's University in San Antonio, Texas. He was also the head coach at Slippery Rock from 2010-13.



SPARTANBURG, S.C. – Defending Southern Conference men's soccer regular-season champion UNCG was picked to win the league again in 2016 in voting among the six league head coaches, edging two-time defending SoCon tournament champion Furman in the preseason poll. The SoCon coaches also selected an 11-member preseason all-conference team, with UNCG leading the way with four selections.

Coaches were not allowed to vote for their own teams or players in the balloting.

The Spartans collected 23 points in the poll, garnering three first-place votes. Furman was close behind with two-first place votes and 21 points, with ETSU and Mercer tying for third in the poll with 16 points each.

The Spartans, who return eight starters from last year's squad, put forward Damieon Thomas, midfielder Leeroy Maguraushe, defender Nicholas Downs and keeper Jon Milligan on the preseason all-conference team.
