### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Donald Sims - Appalachian St.

Sims averaged 22.5 points and shot 50 percent from the field last week as the Mountaineers picked up road wins over Western Carolina (89-77) and UNC Greensboro (75-69).

Sims opened the week with 19 second-half points at Western Carolina. He finished the game with 29 points as the Mountaineers earned a season sweep over the Catamounts. Sims led ASU with 16 points at UNC Greensboro Monday night. The Gaffney, S.C., native connected on 12-of-24 field goal attempts for the week, including 6-of-12 from three-point range. Sims added six rebounds, three assists and three steals over the two games last week.

The junior guard is second in the conference in scoring with 19.2 points per game. He leads the nation in free throw shooting, having connected on 95 percent of his attempts from the charity stripe. Sims leads the league with 3.0 made three-pointers per game and is 12th in the conference in field goal percentage (.463).

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- The Mountaineers ended WCU's 15-game home winning streak and swept the season series with an 89-77 win in Cullowhee last Saturday. With wins this week over UNC Greensboro and Elon, the Mountaineers have moved into first place in the division.

- Appalachian State has held a rebounding advantage in 22 of 25 games this season. ASU owns a +6.4 rebound margin, the top mark in the league and rank in the top 25 nationally. ASU's 47.2 field goal percentage is also tops in the SoCon.
- Appalachian State hosts Georgia Southern Saturday afternoon.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Five members of the Phoenix scored in double figures Monday as Elon topped Western Carolina, 81-76 at home. Drew Spradlin led Elon with 16 points in the win. The Phoenix are 4-1 this season when at least four players score in double figures.

- Chris Long recorded three assists Thursday night against the Cougars and sits in eighth place on Elon's all-time career assist list with 294. Long is seventh in the league in assists per game (3.7 apg).
- The Phoenix host The Citadel Saturday. The game will be televised on SportSouth.

## UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Ben Stywall moved into the Top 10 on the UNCG career scoring list Monday night, despite being held without a field goal for just the second time in the last 88 games. Stywall also became just the third player in school history to record 250 rebounds in consecutive seasons, joining Eric Cuthrell and Kyle Hines.

- Stywall and Kendall Toney have both played in 115 consecutive games -- having never missed a game in their careers. The school record for consecutive games played is 119 by Jay Joseph.
- The Spartans host Western Carolina February 15.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Josh Davis poured in a career-high 30 points as Samford knocked off Chattanooga, 78-54, Wednesday night. Davis connected on 7-of-13 three-pointers as the Bulldogs recorded their highest scoring output of the season.

- Wednesday's victory snapped Samford's five-game losing streak, which was its longest of the 2009-10 campaign. The last time the Bulldogs had dropped five in a row came during the 2006-07 season when Samford was defeated by Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky, Morehead State, Evansville and Southeast Missouri from Feb. 10-22
- Samford hosts Wofford Saturday at 3:00 p.m.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Junior Ridge McKeither's 18 rebounds at The Citadel tied for the third highest single-game total since the Mocs moved to Division I. The school's single game rebounding record is 21 by Mindaugas Katelnyas in the March 4, 2005 win over Appalachian State during the team's run to its ninth SoCon Tournament Championship.

- Chattanooga is 11-0 when leading with five minutes to play, 1-1 when tied. The Mocs have eight wins this season when tied or trailing in the second half.
- Chattanooga will entertain Furman Saturday night at McKenzie Arena.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina has 18 wins on the season, the most under head coach Larry Hunter. At 18-7, the Catamounts have guaranteed themselves a second consecutive winning season. WCU has not enjoyed back-to-back winning seasons since 1995-96 (17-13) and 1996-97 (14-13).

- Western Carolina suffered its first home loss with an 89-77 setback against Appalachian State Saturday. The Catamounts are 12-1 at the Ramsey Center this year, including a 5-1 mark in league play.
- Western Carolina hosts Davidson Saturday night.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars are 8-3 in their last 11 games and have averaged 80.7 points per game, while limiting their opponents to 74.0. College of Charleston is shooting 39.9 percent from beyond the three-point arc in the last 11 contests.

- Andrew Goudelock is just one point away from moving into the top five on the school's all-time scoring list. The junior guard is currently in sixth place with 1,540 career points. He has made 238 career three-pointers and recently eclipsed Marion Busby's school record of 220.
- College of Charleston will host Appalachian State February 15.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Junior point guard Cameron Wells continues to climb up the school's all-time scoring list, moving past Gary Daniels (1,380) into fifth place. Wells finished with 15 points in the victory over College of Charleston, giving him 1,386 points for his career.

- Monday's win over College of Charleston gave the Bulldogs their third consecutive league win. It also gave The Citadel a season split with the Cougars and marked the second consecutive season the Bulldogs have won at Carolina First Arena.
- The Citadel will visit Elon Saturday night.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- With recent wins over College of Charleston, The Citadel, and Georgia Southern, Davidson improved to 6-2 against SoCon South Division opponents. Only three of those seven games have been at home. The Wildcats are now 7-5 in conference play and have won four of their last

- five league games.
- With 10 points at Appalachian State Thursday, senior Will Archambault is became the 38th Davidson player to score 1,000 for his career. He is averaging 11.5 points per game, the 18th best mark in the league.
- Davidson visits Western Carolina Saturday night.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- The Paladins lead the league, and rank 32nd nationally, in blocked shots per game (5.3 bpg) after recording six blocks against Wofford Wednesday night. Freshman Colin Reddick is fourth in the league with 1.4 blocks per game while teammate Bryson Barnes is eighth with 1.2 rejections per contest.

- The Paladins boast two of the top eight scorers in the league in Amu Saaka and Jordan Miller. Saaka is averaging 15.9 points per game, the fifth best mark in the league. Miller's 13.9 points per contest rank eighth in the Southern Conference. Furman is the only school in the league to have two of the league's top ten scorers.
- Furman will visit Chattanooga Saturday night.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Willie Powers III has scored in double figures in six straight games which includes three 20-point performances. Powers has sparked Georgia Southern's comebacks with double digit scoring in the second half in four of those six games and nine games overall this season.

- Georgia Southern recorded several season-highs in January with two of its highest point totals, two of its best team free throw percentages while tying a season-best steals total. The Eagles also had their second-best assists total with 17.
- Georgia Southern will travel to Appalachian State February 13.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Wofford's win over Furman Wednesday night gave the Terriers their 18th victory of the season, the highest single-season win total in school history since moving to NCAA Division I prior to the 1995-96 season.

- The Terriers had five players score in double figures against UNC Greensboro Saturday night, the first time that has happened since March 1, 2008 against The Citadel.
- The Terriers will travel to take on Samford Saturday afternoon in Birmingham, Ala.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Wofford junior Noah Dahlman has led the league in field goal percentage each of the past two seasons. Dahlman shot .609 from the field as a freshman and .601 last year. If he is able to lead the conference shooting percentage again, he would be the first player to lead the league in field goal percentage three straight seasons since Joe Holup of George Washington (1954-56).

Western Carolina junior Brigham Waginger led the league in steals in 2008 (69) and 2009 (81). Should he lead the league in steals again this season it would be the first time the same player has led the conference for three consecutive seasons. East Tennessee State's Keith Jennings is the only other player in league history to lead the league in steals for three seasons (1988, 1989, 1991).

Davidson has led the league in scoring each of the past four seasons. The only team to lead the conference in scoring for more than four straight years was West Virginia. The Mountaineers were the top scoring team in the league for seven consecutive seasons from 1957-1963.

### ALL-DECADE RECOGNITION

CollegeInsider.com recently released it's All-Decade team which featured the top 25 players from the past decade (2000-2009). Davidson's Stephen Curry (2006-09) was named to the All-Decade Team. He finished his career as the league's leading scorer with 2,635 points in three years.

- Western Carolina's Kevin Martin (2001-04) and East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2002-06) were named to the Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Martin led the league in scoring in 2003 and 2004 before being taken in the first round of the 2004 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. A two-time SoCon Tourney MVP, Smith was the league's leading scorer in 2005.

### SCHEDULE CHANGE

Following a 20-game league schedule each of the past two seasons, the SoCon Council of Presidents voted to move to an 18-game league slate beginning 2009-10. The last time the conference played 18 league games was during the 2006-07 season. The SoCon also played 18 games during the 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 5-8 in Charlotte. The first two round (March 5-6) will take place at Bojangles Coliseum while the semifinals and finals (March 7-8) will take place at Time Warner Cable Arena. It will mark the league's first conference tournament in Charlotte since 1971.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2010 will mark the 89th year of the post-season classic.

Appalachian State's Donald Sims scored 44 points on January 9 at Davidson. It was the highest scoring output for a SoCon performer since Davidson's Stephen Curry tallied 44 points at Oklahoma on November 18, 2008. It was just the 10th 40-point performance in a league game dating back to 1999.

### FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2009-10. No team had fewer than seven returning lettermen and seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 41 starters from last year, an average of 3.4 per team. Three teams (Furman, Western Carolina and Wofford) return all five starters.

### HEAD COACHES

Nine of the league's 12 head coaches return to the bench in 2009-10. The current head coaches have a combined 58 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Buzz Peterson returned to Appalachian State after guiding the Mountaineers from 1997-2000. Matt Matheny took over the Elon Phoenix after spending 16 years on Bob McKillop's staff at Davidson and Charlton Young returned to his alma mater to take over the Georgia Southern Eagles.
- Four SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments last season. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

- The Mocs made their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005 before falling to UConn last year.
- Davidson made its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 3-5 all-time in the NIT after losing at Saint Mary's in the second round.
- College of Charleston lost at Richmond in the second round of the College Basketball Invitational. It was the eighth postseason appearance for CofC.
- The Citadel fell to Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.
