### Nkang National Player of the Week

Eastern Washington quarterback Erik Meyer, **Elon** linebacker **Chad Nkang** and Samford safety/return specialist Cortland Finnegan have been honored as I-AA players of the week by The Sports Network, the division's most widely recognized sports information service.

Nkang recorded a career-high 25 tackles, including 14 solo stops, as Elon fell to Chattanooga, 10-7...Recorded three tackles for a loss...25 tackles were the most for a Southern Conference player since Chattanooga's Josh Cain had 30 stops in 2001...Nkang leads the nation with 102 tackles and averages 14.6 tackles per game.

### Two-Minute Drill

- Three teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll. Furman moved to No. 2 with Appalachian State at the No. 16 spot. Georgia Southern remains in the top 25 at No. 24. Western Carolina, Wofford and Chattanooga also received votes.

- The ESPN/USA Today Poll has two SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman remains in the top 10 at No. 2 with Appalachian State at the No. 17 spot. Georgia Southern, Wofford and Chattanooga also received votes.

- The SoCon has played in four overtime games this season, the most in league history since the NCAA brought the overtime rule into effect. Furman is 2-0 in those games this season, including a 39-31 triple overtime win over The Citadel last weekend. The SoCon is also 3-0 against non-conference teams in overtime in 2005.

- Six student-athletes were named to the national award watch lists. Appalachian State's Richie Williams, Furman's Ingle Martin and Georgia Southern's Jermaine Austin are among the players on the Payton Award watch list. Appalachian State's Marques Murrell, Elon's Chad Nkang and Furman's William Freeman and are all on the Buchanan Award watch list.

- Elon's Chad Nkang recorded 25 tackles against Chattanooga on Saturday, the most since UTC's Josh Cain amassed 30 against The Citadel in 2001. Nkang leads the nation averaging 14.6 tackles per game.

- Appalachian State's Kevin Richardson rushed for 208 yards on Saturday, the most by a SoCon player since ASU's Jeremy Watkins rushed for 216 against William & Mary in the I-AA Playoffs in 2001.

# Around the SoCon This Week

## Appalachian State (4-2, 2-1 SoCon)

Appalachian State moved to 2-1 in the league with a 24-7 win over No. 16 Georgia Southern Saturday in Boone, its second win over a nationally-ranked opponent this season...The game was played in front of 21,486 fans, marking the first time since 1992 that the Mountaineers have had back-to-back home games of 20,000 or better...RB **Kevin Richardson** rushed for a career-high 208 yards on 22 carries vs. the Eagles...One of Richardson's runs went for a career-best 73 yards...In addition, he also caught six passes for 77 yards...QB **Richie Williams** was 13-of-20 for 161 yards and also picked up 82 yards on the ground...The ASU defense held GSU to 271 yards of offense, 178 below its season average...DB **Jeremy Wiggins** led the defensive attack with a team-high 13 tackles while LB **Zodd Kelly** added 10 stops.

## The Citadel (2-4, 1-2 SoCon)

The Bulldogs fell to fifth-ranked Furman, 39-31, in triple overtime Saturday in Charleston...In his second career start, QB **Justin Knox** was 22-of-36 for 130 yards and a touchdown...Knox also added a TD on the ground...RB **Nuru Goodrum** rushed for a career-high 89 yards and also caught one pass for 13 yards...LB **Porter Johnson** registered 12 tackles, tying for game-high honors, and also had a pair of tackles for a loss...PK **Blake Vandiver** equaled his career long with a 45-yard field goal in the second overtime period...The Citadel travels to Georgia Southern on Saturday.

## Chattanooga (5-2, 2-1 SoCon)

The Mocs won their third straight to move to 5-2 with a 10-7 win at Elon on Saturday, giving the team their first five-win season since 2000...Three of UTC's wins this year have come on the road...PK **Esteban Lopez** kicked the game-winning 19 yard field goal with 5:16 left in the fourth quarter, his second game-winner in as many weeks...RB **Eldra Buckley** had 124 yards on a career-high 31 carries for his third 100-yard game of the season and second in a row...WR **Emanuel Hassel** had four catches for 41 yards, while TE **John Parkinson** set career highs with four receptions for 41 yards...LB **Chris Johnson** had six tackles, two for a loss and one sack, in addition to a pair of quarterback hurries...The Mocs' defense allowed no points in the first half for the first time since blanking Kentucky State in 2001...UTC hosts Western Carolina on Saturday, the first of three home games over the final five weeks of the season.

## Elon (3-4, 0-3 SoCon)

The Phoenix lost 10-7 to Chattanooga, its second loss by five points or less in two weeks...A week after rushing for a career-high 59 yards, RB Joe Baptiste scampered for a new high of 148 yards on 24 carries...Dwayne Ijames returned a kick off 46 yards and also added a punt return of 32...LB **Chad Nkang** had 25 tackles (14 solo and 11 assisted), the most by a SoCon player in four years...QB **Kye Hamilton** became the 13th player in school history to pass for more than 2,000 yards in a career...Elon heads to Furman on Saturday, the first of three straight games on the road.

## Furman (6-1, 2-1 SoCon)

Furman overcame a 14-point deficit in the fourth quarter and knocked off The Citadel in triple overtime, 39-31...The win for the Paladins is their fifth in a row and second in overtime this season...Backup QB **Renaldo Gray** came in for **Ingle Martin** (lower body cramps) late in the third quarter and directed the Paladins to a pair of fourth quarter scores to send the game into overtime...Gray was 4-for-11 for 77 yards and one TD in the air and added 44 yards and a score on the ground...WR **Justin Stepp** caught a career-high eight passes for 114 yards...LB **Andrew Jones** led Furman with 12 tackles, including two for a loss...The Paladins host Elon on Saturday in their Homecoming Game.

## Georgia Southern (4-3, 3-2 SoCon)

Georgia Southern dropped a 24-7 decision to No. 19 Appalachian State Saturday...The Eagles didn't score in the first half for the first time since the Wofford game in 2002...RB **Jermaine Austin** rushed for a team-high 72 yards, snapping the team's streak of 17 straight games with a 100-yard rusher...QB **Jayson Foster** added 54 yards on the ground, ending his streak of six consecutive 100-yard games...FS **A.J. Bryant** led the Eagles with 14 tackles, while LB **John Mohring** added eight stops and an interception that he returned 46 yards...The defense allowed ASU's Kevin Richardson to rush for 208 yards, marking the first time since the Furman game in 2000 that GSU has allowed a rusher gain 200 yards in a contest...The Eagles play host to The Citadel on Saturday for Homecoming.

## Western Carolina (2-3, 1-2 SoCon)

The Catamounts return to action after an off week to face Chattanooga on the road...WCU lost its third straight game at Georgia Southern, 45-7 on Oct. 8...QB **Justin Clark** was 13-for-22 for 149 yards and a TD...RB **Darius Fudge** rushed for 68 yards and added 28 more on three receptions...Four different receivers caught at least three balls...WCU had the ball for only 10:29 in the second half...WCU hosts Elon on Oct. 29 for Homecoming.

## Wofford (4-2, 2-1 SoCon)

Wofford won its fourth in a row on Saturday, knocking off VMI, 38-23...The Terriers have won four straight home games and 21 of their last 22 games at Gibbs Stadium...RB **Michael Hobbs** rushed for 85 yards and a touchdown before leaving the game with an injury...WR **Brandon Berry** added 65 yards on the ground, while QB **Josh Collier** contributed 61 of his own...Collier was also 5-of-6 in the air for 40 yards and a pair of scores, his first two-touchdown passing game of his career...Wofford had five players rush for over 50 yards and finished with 441 yards on the ground...NT **Katon Bethay** had nine tackles and four sacks...The Terriers host Appalachian State on Saturday in their final home game of the regular season.

**#16/#17 Appalachian State (4-2, 2-1 SoCon) at Wofford (4-2, 2-1) SoCon), Noon**  
**Gibbs Stadium (13,000) • Spartanburg, SC**

**THE GAME:** It's the 22nd meeting between the two schools, with Appalachian State holding a 12-9 lead in the series...The Mountaineers won last year's game 38-17 in Boone...The Terriers are 7-3 against ASU at Gibbs Stadium...This is the final regular season home game for Wofford...ASU has won eight of the last 10 meetings but Wofford has won two of the last three...The Mountaineers are coming off a 24-7 win over Georgia Southern while the Terriers were 38-23 victors over VMI...ASU QB Richie Williams needs 120 yards of offense to become only the fourth player in SoCon history to record 7,500 yards of total offense...RB Kevin Richardson rushed for a career-high 208 yards vs. Georgia Southern and also caught six passes for a career-best 77 yards...Richardson is averaging a league-best 137.8 all-purpose yards per game...The Terriers have won four in a row overall and also four straight at home...Wofford rushed for a season-high 441 yards in its win over VMI...With 39 yards vs. VMI RB Gabriel Jackson became the 11th player in Wofford history to rush for 1,500 career yards.

**THE COACHES:** The winningest coach in SoCon football history, Jerry Moore (Baylor '61) is in his 17th season at the helm of the Mountaineer program in 2005...Moore has a 133-65 mark at Appalachian over the course of his 16-plus seasons with the school and is 6-2 vs. the Terriers...Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 114-82-1 in his 17 years at the helm...Ayers is 2-6 vs. ASU.

**THE GAME:** This will be the ninth meeting between the two schools, with Furman leading the series 7-1...Furman has won the last five meetings and have allowed only 24 points during that span...Elon is coming off a 10-7 loss to Chattanooga, while Furman needed three overtimes to defeat The Citadel, 39-31...Elon RB Joe Baptiste rushed for a career-high 148 yards and one TD vs. the Mocs...Phoenix QB Kye Hamilton completed only five of 16 passes for 65 yards...LB Chad Nkang recorded a career-high 25 tackles vs. UTC and leads the nation averaging 14.6 tackles per game...Furman WR Justin Stepp had a career-high eight catches for 114 yards and one TD against The Citadel...RB Daric Carter had 92 yards on 13 carries while Jerome Felton added 55 yards and three TDs...QB Ingle Martin played nearly three quarters before succumbing to lower body cramps and completed 15-of-30 passes for 182 yards... Renaldo Gray relieved Martin and directed the Paladins to two fourth quarter scores, as well as the OT win...Gray finished with 77 passing yards and a TD and 44 yards on the ground and one score...Furman has won nine consecutive regular season games at home.

**THE COACHES:** Paul Hamilton (Appalachian State '81) is 6-12 in his second year as head coach of the Phoenix...Hamilton is 44-53 in nine years as a collegiate head coach and 2-5 vs. Furman ...Bobby Lamb (Furman '86) is in his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater in 2005...Lamb has compiled a 30-13 record while at the head of the Paladins program and is 3-0 vs. Elon.

**THE GAME:** This game will mark the 15th meeting between the two schools...Georgia Southern holds an 11-3 lead in the series...The Eagles won last year's game 42-7, while the Bulldogs claimed the last meeting in Statesboro, 28-24...GSU has won six league games in a row at home...RB Nuru Goodrum rushed for a career-high 89 yards on 18 carries...WR Ta'Mar Jernigan is fourth in the league with 26 receptions and is third averaging 4.2 rpg...In his second career start, QB Justin Knox passed for 130 yards and a TD and also added another score on the ground...LB Porter Johnson had a pair of tackles for loss vs. Furman, increasing his league lead to 12.5 TFL...GSU RB Jermaine Austin needs 144 yards to reach 1,000 rushing yards for the third time in his four-year career...QB Jayson Foster scored his league-leading 12th touchdown of the season vs. Appalachian State and will move into a tie for ninth place in SoCon history with his next rushing TD.

**THE COACHES:** Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 2-4... ## This Date in Southern Conference History

**Oct. 22, 1983:** The Citadel's Lee Glaze threw a school-record 84-yard touchdown pass to John Murphy in the Bulldog's 41-12 win over the Wildcats. Starting quarterback Robert Hill was 18-for-30 in the game, connecting with Victor Frazier on one of the 18 on the final play of the first half to surpass Marty Crosby's record of 117 completions in a single season.

**Oct. 22, 1977:** Mark Stowers scored on a two-yard run in the fourth quarter to give Furman enough to beat Appalachian 28-20 in Greenville, S.C.

**Oct. 22, 1977:** The two-headed monster of freshman running backs for the Mocs in Gwain Durden (106) and Mike Smith (102) amassed 208 of the 257 yards that UTC gained on the ground in their 18-14 win over Jacksonville State.

**Oct. 22, 1994:** In Harold Hines first start at tailback for Western Carolina, the usual starting fullback racked up 114 yards to pluck the Catamounts first 100-yard rushing game of 1994 in the Catamounts' 53-15 takedown of Chattanooga. Hines also picked up a touchdown in Western Carolina's homecoming day win before a crowd of 11,000 in Cullowhee, N.C.

**Oct. 22, 1994:** Georgia Southern senior defensive end Michael Morris batted down East Tennessee State quarterback Greg Ryan's two-point pass attempt with 45 seconds remaining, enabling the Eagles to hold off the Buccaneers, 24-23.

**Oct. 22, 1994:** Mark Moore nailed down a 112 yard rushing day with a 72-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter of Furman's 28-11 win over VMI that snapped a four-game slide by the Paladins.

**Oct. 22, 1983:** After a 20-tackle performance in Western Carolina's 25-15 win over Chattanooga, linebacker Ricky Pate was tabbed as the Southern Conference Defensive Player of the Week.

**Oct. 22, 1994:** Current NFL superstar and Philadelphia Eagles wide receiver Terrell Owens caught 11 passes for 136 yards for Chattanooga in their 53-15 loss to Western Carolina.

**Oct. 22, 1994:** Army's Kurt Heiss hit a 24-yard field goal with no time remaining to give Army a 25-24 win over The Citadel at Mitchie Stadium on the West Point campus. Heiss' kick gave Army its only lead of the game.

**Oct. 22, 1994:** Appalachian State may not have put as gaudy of numbers as Marshall did in their game, but the Mountaineers did come out on top in the one category that mattered - the score, as they took out the Thundering Herd, 24-14, in a pivotal mid-season Southern Conference game.
