## Quick Hits

- Appalachian State, Elon, and Wofford host conference games Saturday while The Citadel and Georgia Southern compete in nonconference action. Western Carolina is idle.
- Home teams are 16-15 in league games this season after going just 18-18 a year ago.
- Southern Conference teams are 8-2 against FCS nonconference opponents.
- Western Carolina's Rock Williams is second in the FCS with 13.1 tackles per game. Appalachian State's Jeremy Kimbrough ranks 12th with 11.1 stops per contest.

**AWARD CANDIDATES:** The Southern Conference has two candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List, five on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List and three on the Jerry Rice Award Watch List. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player. The Jerry Rice Award honors the top freshman in FCS.

**RANKINGS:** Three Southern Conference teams are ranked in both major FCS Polls this week. Georgia Southern is ranked seventh by both the FCS Coaches and the Sports Network. Appalachian State is 12th in both polls, while Wofford is ranked No. 14 by the coaches and 13th according to the Sports Network.

**THROUGH THE AIR:** The Southern Conference has had at least one wide receiver rank in the top five nationally for receiving yards per game in each of the last six seasons.

• Elon's Aaron Mellette leads the league and ranks third nationally with 123 receiving yards per game.

**ON THE GROUND:** A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in eight of the last 11 years.

• The Citadel, Georgia Southern and Wofford all rank in the top five of FCS for rushing yards per game.

**DEFENSIVE ROTATION:** All nine SoCon teams have led the league in total defense at least once since 2003.

• Georgia Southern leads the conference and ranks tenth nationally in total defense. The Eagles have given up 299 yards per game in 2012.

**BROKEN RECORDS:** The Southern Conference has produced record-setting performances in 2012, including the following SoCon records:

- Wofford vs. Lincoln (Pa.) - September 8  
Wofford's 82 points was the second-highest scoring output in league history
- Wofford vs. Western Carolina - September 15  
Wofford's 590 rushing yards was the seventh-highest single-game total in the SoCon
- Eric Breitenstein, Wofford - September 29  
Rushed for a SoCon-record 321 yards and two TDs at Elon
- Jerodis Williams, Furman - September 29  
Accounted for 370 all-purpose yards against Western Carolina, the second-highest total in league history
- Georgia Southern at Western Carolina - October 6  
GSU's 614 rushing yards was the fourth-highest single-game total in the SoCon
- Georgia Southern vs. Wofford - October 13

**MAKING THE GRADE:** In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 958, ranking sixth nationally and third among FCS conferences. It was the fourth consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- Ten Southern Conference's sports (football, men's basketball, men's indoor track & field, men's outdoor track & field, women's basketball, women's cross country, women's indoor track & field, women's outdoor track & field, women's tennis and volleyball) ranked among the top 10 of Division I for their four-year average.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores in October. Five of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for FCS programs.

**EXPERIENCED COACHES:** Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 337 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 214 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (123) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade.
