### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Omar Carter - Appalachian St.

Carter averaged 25.0 points and 6.0 rebounds in victories over Davidson (74-66) and Georgia Southern (79-51) last week.

Playing at Davidson, the Charlotte, N.C., native scored a game-high 25 points to lift ASU past the Wildcats last Wednesday. Carter scored 19 of his points in the second half, including three late free throws which helped ice the win for the Mountaineers. The junior guard then scored a game-high 25 points in the win against Georgia Southern Saturday afternoon. Carter did the bulk of his scoring from three-point range, connecting on 5-of-8 attempts from beyond the arc against the Eagles. Carter was 17-of-32 (.531) from the floor for the week and added 12 rebounds, four steals and three assists.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock, The Citadel's Cameron Wells, Elon's Drew Spradlin, Georgia Southern's Ben Drayton III, Chattanooga's Omar Wattad, Western Carolina's Trey Sumler and Wofford's Noah Dahlman.

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Omar Carter bounced back from a five-point outing against Milligan on Dec. 30 to lead Appalachian State with 25 points in each game last week. He also led the squad in rebounds (6.0) and steals (2.0). The junior transfer has stepped into the ASU lineup this season and ranks second on the team with 15.7 points per game, good for fifth-best in the league.
- ASU is on a three-game winning streak and owns a 3-1 league record. The Mountaineers broke open a tight game at Davidson in the second half and knocked off Georgia Southern in its SoCon home opener.
- Appalachian State hosts UNCG Thursday night.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Chris Long became the 33rd player in school history to reach the 1,000-point plateau with 21 points Monday against UNCG. Long is averaging 14.2 points per game this season which ranks 10th in the Southern Conference. He is second in the league with 4.7 assists per contest.
- Elon has seen an increase in its scoring from last season to 2010-11. The Phoenix rank third in the league with an average of 75.4 points per contest, nine points better than 2009-10 when Elon averaged 66.9 points per game.
- The Phoenix travel to Western Carolina Thursday night.

## UNCG SPARTANS



- Sophomore guard Kyle Randall has proven to be a threat for the Spartans in the backcourt. Randall is second on the team in scoring (10.4 ppg) and leads UNCG in assists (3.5 apg). He also owns a 1.4 assist-to-turnover ratio which ranks in the top 10 of the conference.
- UNCG has displayed a balanced offensive attack this season. Aloysius Henry, Korey Van Dussen and Randall all average double figures in scoring for the Spartans. The trio has led UNCG in scoring in 10 of 15 games this season.
- The Spartans visit Appalachian State Thursday night.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Senior Josh Davis scored 25 points in games against UNCG and Elon last week to become the 22nd player in school history to reach the 1,000-point plateau. A native of Lubbock, Texas, Davis has recorded exactly 1,000 points in his career.
- Samford has made at least five 3-point baskets in each game dating back to its 64-61 season-opening loss at Youngstown State on Nov. 12. The Bulldogs have knocked down five or more 3-point shots in 15-consecutive games, including a season-high total of 18 in road wins at Auburn on Nov. 19 and at UTSA on Dec. 20.
- Samford visits Chattanooga Saturday night.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- The Mocs carry a 4-0 conference mark in league play and travel to face The Citadel on Thursday. The last time the Mocs started 4-0 in conference play was the 2007-08 season which was a 7-0 start.
- The Mocs knocked off UNCG 70-65 on Saturday. Chattanooga is now 7-0 this season when holding its opponents to 70 points or less. The Mocs have given up 73.0 points per game this season and rank third in the league in field goal percentage defense (.417).
- After travelling to The Citadel on Thursday, the Mocs will host Samford Saturday night.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- WCU's victory at Georgia Southern snapped a six-game losing skid, which was the longest winless drought since an eight-game slide during the 2004-05 season. It also halted GSU's six-game winning streak in the series at Hanner Fieldhouse.
- The Catamounts knocked off Davidson 81-73 Saturday afternoon. It was WCU's first home game since the end of November and gave the Catamounts their first home victory over the Wildcats since 2000, ending a seven-game home slump in the head-to-head series.
- The Catamounts host Elon Thursday night.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- CofC has shot 50 percent or better in all four of its conference games this season including a league season-high 55.8 percent (29-of-52) against Furman. The Cougars are ranked No. 42 among NCAA statistical team leaders in field-goal percentage (.476).
- For the second consecutive season, the Cougars are off to a perfect 4-0 start with back-to-back wins over Furman on Jan. 6 and Wofford on Jan. 8. They currently lead the South Division and are tied with Chattanooga for the best record in the league.
- College of Charleston hosts The Citadel Saturday afternoon.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The backcourt combination of Zach Urbanus and Cameron Wells have eclipsed the double figure scoring plateau in each of their last six games. The six-game stretch ties earlier streaks by Austin Dahn and Mike Groselle, trailing only a 15-game span by Wells that carried over from the 2009-10 season.
- Sophomore center Mike Groselle, who finished with back-to-back double-doubles against Clemson (14 points, 10 rebounds) and Wofford (19 points, 16 rebounds) became the first Bulldog since John Brown in the 2009-10 season to accomplish the feat.
- The Citadel hosts Chattanooga Thursday night. The Bulldogs will visit College of Charleston Saturday afternoon.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Senior guard Brendan McKillop needs 16 three-pointers to move into the top five on the career list. McKillop has knocked down 171 career triples. He is second in the SoCon this season with 2.9 made three-pointers per game.
- Head coach Bob McKillop is 10 wins away from his 400th career victory. A total of 353 of his 390 wins have come while Davidson has been a member of the Southern Conference, making him the all-time wins leader in league history.
- The Wildcats return to Belk Arena to host Furman (Wednesday) and Wofford (Saturday) this week.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman scored 88 points in its win over The Citadel on Saturday. It was the Paladins' second-highest point total this season. Furman leads the SoCon in scoring margin at +7.2 points per game. The Paladins are averaging 72.1 points per contest.
- Senior Justin Dehm has moved into third in Furman history with 194 career three-pointers. Dehm is averaging 1.9 made three-pointers per game and has made 51 percent of his attempts from beyond the arc.
- The Paladins visit Davidson Wednesday night.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- GSU's nine steals against Western Carolina and Appalachian State helped the Eagles maintain a top-15 national rankings in the steals per game category. Georgia Southern is currently ranked 11th nationally, averaging 9.9 steals per contest.
- Six different players have led the Eagles in scoring or rebounding in four SoCon games. Ben Drayton III, Tré Bussey and Eric Ferguson have topped the scoring list while Sam Mike, Marvin Baynham and Rory Spencer have led in rebounding. Drayton and Baynham have finished first in their respective categories twice.
- The Eagles host Wofford Wednesday.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Noah Dahlman has led the team in scoring in ten of the 15 games this season. He has moved up to 8th place on the schools' all-time scoring list with 1,609 points. Dahlman ranks third in the SoCon with 19.2 points per game.
- Wofford fell to College of Charleston 77-73 Saturday night at the Benjamin Johnson Arena. It was the Terriers' first SoCon defeat since a 70-68 loss to the Cougars on January 22, 2010, ending a streak of 13 straight regular season SoCon wins for Wofford.
- The Terriers visit Georgia Southern Wednesday night.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### COUSY CANDIDATES

The Southern Conference boasts four candidates for the 2011 Bob Cousy Award, given to the nation's top point guard. The Award is presented through the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mass. The Southern Conference Candidates Include:

- Keegan Bell, Jr., Chattanooga
- Brendan McKillop, Sr., Davidson
- Cameron Wells, Sr., The Citadel
- Mike Williams, Sr., Western Carolina

### RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- Chattanooga grabbed 60 rebounds against Reinhardt (Dec. 21). It was the sixth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.

### MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

### FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2010-11. Seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 35 starters from last year, an average of 2.9 per team. Furman is the only team in the league to return all five starters from last season. Wofford and The Citadel each return four starters.
- Eight of the ten members from the 2010 Coaches All-Conference team returned for 2010-11.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

### HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2011 marks the 91st year of the post-season classic.
