Two-Minute Drill

- The Southern Conference has four teams ranked in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 poll this week. Furman is ranked 9th, Wofford at No. 20, Western Carolina at No. 21 and Appalachian State at No. 22. Georgia Southern and Chattanooga also received votes.
- For the second time in three weeks, the Southern Conference has four teams ranked in The Sports Network I-AA Top 25 poll. Furman is ranked ninth, followed by Western Carolina at No. 19, Wofford at No. 21 and Appalachian State at No. 22. Chattanooga and Georgia Southern also received votes in the poll.
- Appalachian State's Kevin Richardson raked in the honors after his career performance on Saturday. Richardson was named The Sports Network Co-Offensive Player of the Week after rushing for 178 yards and three touchdowns.
- Georgia Southern's Jermaine Austin and Jayson Foster remain in the NCAA top 10 rushing statistics. Appalachian State's Corey Lynch ranks second among NCAA Division I-AA player averaging 1.33 interceptions per game, followed closely by Francis Brown of Western Carolina with one pick per game, good for fourth in the nation.

Richardson Named National Player of the Week

Appalachian State running back Kevin Richardson, New Hampshire quarterback Ricky Santos, Cal Poly defensive end Chris Gocong and Murray State running back/return specialist Nick Turner have been honored as national I-AA players of the week by The Sports Network, the division's most widely recognized sports information service.

Richardson set new career highs with 178 rushing yards and three touchdowns to lead Appalachian State past Coastal Carolina, 30-3. Santos threw for three scores, ran for two more, and completed 23-of-33 passes for 422 yards in New Hampshire's 62-21 win at Towson. Gocong recovered a fumble in the endzone for a touchdown and also tallied three sacks and 10 tackles in Cal Poly's 38-10 win against Montana State. Turner returned a kickoff 91 yards for a score for one of his three touchdowns on the day in Murray State's win against Indiana State.

Around the SoCon This Week

Appalachian State (2-1, 0-0 SoCon)

Appalachian State put together 582 yards of total offense in the Mountaineers' 30-3 win over No. 17 Coastal Carolina, while the defense limited the Chanticleers to 225...The team rushed for 353 yards, the school's highest output since running for the same figure against William & Mary in the 2001 I-AA Playoffs...RB Kevin Richardson rushed for a career-high 178 yards on 18 carries and scored three touchdowns (59, 18, 5), all of them coming in the first half...Richardson's three first half scores tied for the third most rushing TDs in one half in SoCon history — and the first since Wofford's J.R. McNair scored three against Chattanooga in 2003...QB Richie Williams recorded 270 yards of total offense, 185 in the air and 85 on the ground...Sophomore DB Corey Lynch intercepted two passes, giving him a league-high four INTs on the season...A total of 23,267 fans attended the game in Boone, the largest home-opening crowd in school history...It was also the sixth-highest in school annals...The win for the Mountaineers was their 13th consecutive win at Kidd Brewer Stadium...ASU opens up conference play on Saturday against The Citadel.

The Citadel (1-1, 0-0 SoCon)

The Bulldogs were idle last week after dropping a 62-10 decision to No. 11 Florida State on Sept. 10...The Citadel open up conference play at home against Appalachian State on Saturday, marking the first time since 2002 that the Bulldogs begin league play at home.

Chattanooga (2-1, 0-0 SoCon)

Chattanooga dropped its first game of the season, a 59-14 decision at Memphis...RB Eldra Buckley picked up his first career 100-yard rushing game, running for a career-best 143 yards...Buckley's total is the 19th highest output in school history...Greg McConico moved from strong safety to cornerback this week and ended up recording a game-high 11 tackles, all solo stops...It was the second straight double-digit tackle game of the season for McConico and fourth of his career...The Mocs have yet to score a touchdown via the air in the team's first three games...This Saturday's game at Georgia Southern is the third of three straight games on the road for UTC, the team's longest stretch of away games since 2001.

Elon (2-1, 0-0 SoCon)

The Phoenix improved to 2-1 on the season with a 34-19 win on Homecoming over Presbyterian...RB **Reggie Hall** rushed for a career-high 136 yards on 34 carries and scored three touchdowns...Hall also had four catches for 31 yards...QB **Kye Hamilton** completed 59 percent of his passes (16-for-27) for 208 yards and one score...WR **Michael Mayers** caught six balls for 114 yards, including a 39-yard reception for a touchdown...Chad Nkang had a game-high 12 tackles and also registered one of the team's four sacks...Elon concludes non-conference play on Saturday against North Carolina A&T...The Phoenix host Georgia Southern in the team's SoCon opener on Oct. 1.

Furman (2-1, 0-1 SoCon)

Furman won its sixth consecutive home opener on Saturday, a 45-23 victory over Samford...The Paladins racked up 392 yards on the ground and rushed for five touchdowns...Furman had three players gain over 100 yards on the ground — **Daric Carter** (132 yards), **Jerome Felton** (121) and **Cedrick Gipson** (100)...It was Carter's first career 100-yard game, while Felton's total was also a career high...It marked the first time since 1985 that Furman had three players rush for 100 yards in a game...LB **Andrew Jones** registered a game-high 13 tackles, including two sacks and three total tackles for a loss...QB **Ingle Martin**, who passed for only 135 yards, moved tackles for aloss...QB Ingle Martin is 207 yards from moving past David Henderson (1976-79) for eighth...The Paladins host No. 17 Hofstra on Saturday, the second of four in a row at Paladin Stadium.

Georgia Southern (1-2, 0-1 SoCon)

Georgia Southern opened conference play for the second time in three years with a loss, falling 21-17 to Wofford...Each of those losses have come on the road to the Terriers...QB Jayson Foster rushed for his third straight 100-yard game, finishing with 121 yards...Of Foster's total, 101 of those yards came in the second half...John Mohring made 12 stops for the Eagles, six solo and six assisted...The GSU defense gave up 354 yards on the ground, the first time in 59 games that it has allowed a team to rush for 300 yards in a game (last time was 404 yards by Furman in November 2000)...The Eagles host Chattanooga Saturday in a game that will be televised on Charter/Comcast Sports Southeast (CSS)...GSU has won 17 of 18 meetings with the Mocs, including eight in a row.

Western Carolina (2-1, 1-0 SoCon)

Western Carolina dropped a tough 7-3 decision at Cincinnati on Saturday...The Catamounts outgained the Bearcats 284-273 but were only able to muster a third quarter field goal...QB Justin Clark was 19-for-39 for 201 yards and completed passes to 10 different receivers...WCU held UC to its lowest output at home since 1998 and nearly won its first game against a I-A opponent (0-36)...LB Lamar Brown led the Catamounts with 10 tackles, including two for a loss...RB Darius Fudge, who had 66 yards against Cincinnati, is 185 yards shy of reaching 1,000 yards for his career...WCU concludes non-league play on Saturday when it travels to Nicholls State.

Wofford (2-1, 1-0 SoCon)

Wofford avenged a 58-14 loss to Georgia Southern in 2004 with a 21-17 win on Saturday...It marked the second straight home win in the series with the Eagles and third win in the last four meetings between the two schools...The Terriers piled up 354 rushing yards, led by 114 yards from Michael Hobbs...Hobbs scored two touchdowns, the first of his career, while six of his 26 carries resulted in first downs...QB Josh Collier rushed for a career-high 91 yards and a TD, while Corey Dunn and Brandon Berry combined for another 86...NT Katon Bethay recorded a career-high 11 tackles, six solo and five assisted stops...The win over the 14th-ranked Eagles was Wofford's ninth win in 15 tries since 2002 against nationally-ranked I-AA opponents...The Terriers are idle this week and return to action on Oct. 1 at Chattanooga.

Players of the Week

Kevin Richardson, Appalachian State So., 5-9, 190lb Elizabethtown, NC

A 5-9, 190-lb sophomore from Elizabethtown, NC, Richardson turned in a career performance in Appalachian State's 30-3 win over No. 17 Coastal Carolina on Saturday. He ran for a career-high 178 yards on 18 carries and added three touchdowns for the Mountaineers. Richardson had topped his previous career high of 67 yards by the end of the first quarter, which included a 59-yard touchdown run seven minutes into the game. He became the first Mountaineer to rush for three touchdowns since Trey Elder on October 2, 2004 against Texas State. His 178 yards helped ASU to 353 yards on the ground, the most since amassing the same mark against William & Mary in the first round of the 2001 NCAA playoffs.

Katon Bethay, Wofford Sr., 6-2, 285lb. Milton, WI

Bethay, a 6-2, 285-lb. senior from Milton, WI, recorded a career-high 11 tackles, six solo stops, in Wofford's 21-17 win over No. 14 Georgia Southern. He also forced a fumble with 23 seconds left in the first quarter on a Georgia Southern first-and-goal, knocking the ball from Jermaine Austin and recovering it on the seven yard line. Bethay's previous careerbest was nine tackles against GSU in 2002 as a freshman.

THE GAME: Hofstra and Furman have met only one previous time, with Atlantic-10 school winning 31-24 in 2000 in Greenville...Last week, the Pride defeated Stony Brook, 55-0, while the Paladins knocked off Samford, 45-23...Hofstra moved up six spots in The Sports Network poll to No. 17, while Furman climbed one spot to No. 9.

THE COACHES: Bobby Lamb (Furman '86) enters his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater in 2005...Lamb has compiled a 26-13 record while at the head of the Paladins program...During his playing days, Lamb quarterbacked the Paladins from 1982-85...Joe Gardi (Pacific '76) owns a 114-58-2 record over his 15 years at the helm of the Pride, and 1-0 record over the Paladins.

THE GAME: The Catamounts travel to Thibodeaux, LA to take on the Colonels for the second meeting in the series...Western Carolina defeated Nicholls State, 28-7, in 2004 in Cullowhee to own the only game in the series history...Nicholls State picked up its first win of the season with a 54-0 win over Cheyney...WCU lost its first game of the season, a 7-3 setback at Cincinnati last Saturday.

THE COACHES: Western Carolina head coach Kent Briggs (Western Carolina '79) is entering his fourth season as coach of his alma mater ...Briggs has tabulated a 16-21 record in his three seasons at the helm of the Cats...Jay Thomas (Ole Miss '87) is in his second year as the Colonels head coach...Thomas guided Nicholls to a 5-5 mark in his first season and is 1-1 in 2005.

THE GAME: Appalachian State and The Citadel each open up league play against each other...Appalachian won last year 28-14, while The Citadel triumphed 24-21 in 2003...Appalachian State has a 22-11 lead in the all-time series and has won 10 of the last 11 meetings...After a 30-3 win over then-No. 17 Coastal Carolina last Saturday in Boone, the Mountaineers moved back into the TSN Top-25 poll at No. 22...The Bulldgos were idle this past week.

THE COACHES: The winningest coach in Southern Conference football history, Jerry Moore (Baylor '61) is in his 17th season at the helm of the Mountaineer program in 2005...Moore has a 130-65 mark at Appalachian over the course of his 16 seasons with the school...Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 1-1... Higgins was 56-25-1 at Lehigh from 1994-2000, his first collegiate head coaching position...He comes to The Citadel from the Detroit Lions, where he was most recently the wide receivers coach.

THE GAME: The Phoenix are looking to break a four-game slide against the Aggies...Elon last won in the rivalry in 2000, 13-0...Overall, the series between the two programs stands with the Aggies owning a 5-2 all-time record against their in-state rival...Last Saturday, Elon picked up a 34-19 win at home over Presbyterian while NC A&T lost 31-14 to Hampton.

THE COACHES: Paul Hamilton (Appalachian State '81) is 5-9 in his second year as head coach of the Phoenix...Hamilton is 43-50 in nine years as a collegiate head coach...George Small (North Carolina A&T, '79) is 14-13 in two years at the helm of his alma mater.

THE GAME: Chattanooga opens up league play, looking to break an eight-game losing streak to Georgia Southern in the series history...GSU has won 17 of 18 meetings between the two and are 9-0 at Paulson Stadium...The Eagles won 51-17 last year in Chattanooga...Last Saturday, the Mocs dropped a 59-14 at Memphis, while the Eagles began league play with a 21-17 loss at Wofford.

THE COACHES: Rodney Allison (Texas Tech '80) is 7-19 in his third season as Mocs head coach...Allison came to Chattanooga from Clemson where he was the defensive ends coach from 1999-2002...Mike Sewak (Virginia '81) is 28-12 in four years as head coach of the Georgia Southern program...Since he joined GSU in 1997, the Eagles have compiled a 90-21 record and won national championships in 1999 and 2000.

This Date in Southern Conference History

Sept. 24, 1983: Western Carolina rallied for 11 points in the latter part of the fourth quarter to best ETSU 17-16.

Sept. 24, 1983: The Citadel's Robert Hill was 30-for-45 in pass attempts, accumulating 345 yards in the air in the Bulldogs' 27-16 loss to Appalachian State. Hill also threw for two touchdowns on the evening.

Sept. 24, 1977: Furman netted 309 yards on the ground, including 113 from Kent Woerner, to wear down UTC and win 17-7.

Sept. 24, 1977: UTC's Mike Smith footed a seven-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter to put the Mocs within reach of Furman at 10-7, but Furman's Kent Woerner promptly scored on a two-yard run to give the Paladins a 17-7 win in Chattanooga.

Sept. 24, 1994: Seven different Georgia Southern players scored against Chattanooga to move the Eagles to the win column for the first time in 1994, with a 56-20 win over the Mocs.

Sept. 24, 1994: Furman led Western Carolina 24-7 with 11:10 left in the third quarter, but the Catamounts scored 28 unanswered to best the Paladins, 35-24 at Paladin Stadium. The win improved the Catamounts to 5-3 in the facility since its opening in 1981.

Sept. 24, 1994: Todd Donnan tied a Marshall record with five touchdown passes in the Thundering Herd's 48-0 shutout win over West Virginia State in front of 20,037 in Huntington, W. Va.

Sept. 24, 1983: Western Carolina's Leonard Williams finished the day in a 21-7 win over Marshall with 119 yards and two touchdowns.

Sept. 24, 1994: Chip Hooks ran for 110 yards and a touchdown in Appalachian State's Southern Conference-opening win over The Citadel, 56-14.
