Quick Hits

- Division leaders Davidson and Western Carolina will square off Thursday at Belk Arena.
- Samford, Chattanooga, College of Charleston and Elon all rank in the nation's top 50 for made three-pointers per game.
- Wofford head coach Mike Young has 146 wins as head coach of the Terriers. Young needs just one more win to tie Lester Hooker (Richmond, 1952-63) for 15th place on the league's all-time wins list.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated Asheville Civic Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

Player of the Week

Davidson forward Jake Cohen has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games played January 3-9. Cohen averaged 19.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in two games last week as Davidson topped UNCG (92-63) and Georgia Southern (96-74).

After scoring nine points in just 14 minutes of action against the Spartans, Cohen turned in a career performance against Georgia Southern. The Berwyn, Pa., native tallied career highs in points (29) and rebounds (12) as the Wildcats moved to 4-0 in league play with the win over Georgia Southern. Cohen missed just two shots against the Eagles as he was 8-of-9 from the field and 11-of-12 from the free

throw line. He finished the week shooting 11-of-16 (.687) from the floor and connected on 93 percent of his free throw attempts (13-of-14).

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Omar Carter, College of Charleston's Anthony Stitt, The Citadel's Cosmo Morabbi, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, Chattanooga's Drazen Zlovacic, Samford's Drew Windler, Western Carolina's Keaton Cole and Wofford's Karl Cochran.

MOUNTAINEERS

NORTH DIVISION

Freshmen Tab Hamilton and Mike Neal have started each of the last three games for ASU. Hamilton has notched career highs in each of the last two games, with 12 points at Samford and 22 at UTC, including six three-pointers. He averages 8.7 points per game, and 12.0 points in his last six outings. Neal leads the Apps with 40 assists in 13 games and averages 5.5 points per game on 41.3 percent shooting. ASU last started two true freshmen in the same game in 2004-05.

The Mountaineers host Furman Thursday. ASU will play host to Davidson Saturday.



PHOENIX

NORTH DIVISION

Sophomore Lucas Troutman is tied for the league lead with 1.6 blocked shots per game. He also ranks 15th in the SoCon with 5.8 rebounds per contest.

Elon has limited its opponents to just 29.8 percent shooting from three-point range, the 41st best mark in the nation. Conversely, Elon averages 8.0 triples per contest, the 45th best mark in the country.

The Phoenix visit The Citadel Thursday. Elon travels to College of Charleston Saturday.



SPARTANS

NORTH DIVISION

The Spartans lead the Southern Conference with 15.7 offensive rebounds per game. UNCG has grabbed 38 percent of the available rebounds on the offensive end of the floor, the second-best mark in the league.

UNCG's Trevis Simpson scored a season-high 36 points as UNCG fell at Miami (99-89) last week. Simpson's 36 points is the highest single-game output of any SoCon player this season. Simpson is second in the Southern Conference in scoring (16.4 ppg).

The Spartans travel to College of Charleston January 12.



BULLDOGS

NORTH DIVISION

Since moving into the starting lineup against UTSA on Dec. 5, Samford's Tyler Hood is averaging 12.1 points per game. Hood has made an immediate impact for the Bulldogs and is also averaging 4.3 rebounds per contest during that span.

In his 15th season as the head coach at Samford, Jimmy Tillette owns a 221-211 overall record and an impressive 140-117 mark against conference opponents. He is Samford's all-time winningest coach and piloted the Bulldogs to NCAA Tournament appearances in both 1999 and 2000.



MOCS

NORTH DIVISION

Chattanooga came away with a 65-63 win over Appalachian State Saturday. The two-point win over ASU was the first final score inside 10 points in nine games. UTC is 2-2 when the final margin is within two points.

Chattanooga has won five of its last six games. During that span, the Mocs scoring margin is +18.2. UTC is outshooting opponents 46.5 percent to 34.1 percent from the field and 38.4 percent to 27.5 percent from three-point range. UTC has a +11 rebound margin and has taken 70 more free throws as well.



CATAMOUNTS

NORTH DIVISION

Western Carolina went 1-1 last week with a road loss at SoCon North Division favorite, Chattanooga, and a home victory over two-time defending tournament champion Wofford. WCU fell to 2-32 all-time against UTC at the McKenzie Arena, while the Catamounts' home win over Wofford was their sixth-straight home win over the Terriers in the head-to-head series

WCU squares off against Davidson on Thursday night at the Belk Arena. Davidson, preseason favorites in the South Division, is the lone unbeaten team in league play at 4-0 while the Catamounts currently pace the North Division at 3-1.



COUGARS

SOUTH DIVISION

The Cougars got back to their winning ways with a 66-43 road victory at Furman on Jan. 7. It was their best defensive performance of the season holding the Paladins to a season-low 43 points and an opponent season-low 29.6 percent shooting from the floor (16-of-54) and 18.2 percent from beyond the arc. Furman also committed 23 turnovers in which the Cougars turned into 27 points offensively.

The Cougars currently rank 34th nationally in three-point field goals per game averaging 8.3 a contest and having knocked down 10-or-more three-pointers in six games this season including a league season-high 12 against Chattanooga on Dec. 3 and 10 at Wofford on Jan. 5.



BULLDOGS

SOUTH DIVISION

Senior guard Cosmo Morabbi has reached double figures in four of the last five games, including a career-high 20 points against Samford on Jan. 7. Morabbi hit 6-of-12 from the field, knocked down 4-of-7 from 3-point range, dished out six assists, was responsible for four steals and grabbed three rebounds against Samford.

The Citadel hit 14-of-23 (.609) in the first half against Samford, marking the first time that a Bulldog team has shot better than 60 percent in a half since The Citadel shot 67.9 percent against Western Carolina (Jan. 22, 2011).



WILDCATS

SOUTH DIVISION

The Wildcats have won 12 of their last 13 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season. Davidson is last unbeaten team in league play this season.

Davidson, which is shooting free throws at an 81 percent clip as a team, has made 20 or more in six games this season. Guard Nik Cochran leads the country in free throw shooting percentage (.938).

The Wildcats host Western Carolina Thursday night at Belk Arena. Davidson travels to face Appalachian State Saturday afternoon.



PALADINS

SOUTH DIVISION

Sophomore guard Richard Brown leads the Paladins and ranks seventh in the SoCon with 3.5 assists per game. Brown is tied for third in the conference with a 1.9 assist-to-turnover ratio. He is fifth in the league in free throw percentage (.848).

Furman has made 74.9 percent of its free throws, the second best mark in the SoCon and the 22nd best average in the country.

Furman travels to Appalachian State Thursday night. The Paladins visit Western Carolina Saturday.



EAGLES

SOUTH DIVISION

Georgia Southern improved to 3-0 in conference play with the win over Elon and snapped a 26-game road losing streak. The victory also snapped a 20-game losing streak in North Carolina.

The Eagles lead the conference in field goal shooting (.474) and three-point shooting (.385). Sophomore Eric Ferguson ranks fourth in the SoCon, shooting 56 percent from the floor.

Georgia Southern hosts Samford Thursday night. The Eagles travel to Wofford Saturday.



TERRIERS

SOUTH DIVISION

After going with five different starting line-ups in the first ten games of the season, the Terriers have started the same five in each of the last six games.

The Terriers are 9-0 when leading at the half, but 0-7 when trailing at the break. Wofford is also 7-1 when scoring first in a game.

Wofford is first in the SoCon in scoring defense at 62.1 ppg, but the Terriers are also last in scoring offense at 62.0 ppg.

Conference News and Notes

Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 78.7 points per game. College of Charleston ranks second with 72.5 points per contest.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

Athlete of the Month

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball. Groselle recorded five double-doubles in November. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

Cousy Nominees

Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, Davidson's JP Kuhlman and Western Carolina's Trey Sumler have been named to the Cousy Award Watch List. The Cousy Award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

Southern Conference News and Notes

Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

Freshman Honors

UNCG's Trevis Simpson was named to the league's all-freshman team in 2011. It was the third consecutive year that a Spartan was named to the league's all-freshman squad.

- Point guard Kyle Randall was named to the all-freshman team in 2010, while Damian Eargle was selected in 2009.

Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

Annual Leaders

Furman limited its opponents to just 64.4 points per game last season. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

Western Carolina's Mike Williams led the league in steals last year (2.0 spg) making it four consecutive seasons that a Catamount has led the Southern Conference in steals.

- Brigham Waginger, now an assistant coach at WCU, led the league in steals three consecutive seasons (2008-10).

College of Charleston led the league in scoring with 76.2 points per game. It was the second straight year the Cougars led the conference in offense after posting 75.0 points per game in 2010. The Cougars' 2,173 points last year was the seventh highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson led the Southern Conference in scoring four straight seasons from 2006-09.

College of Charleston also led the league with 306 made three-pointers last year, the fifth highest single-season total in league history.

- Elon connected on 285 made triples last season, which tied for the ninth-best single season total.

SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.
