### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Stephen Curry Davidson

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - Davidson's Stephen Curry has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games January 20-26 the league office announced Tuesday (Jan. 27). Curry helped the Wildcats earn South Division wins over Furman (83-43) and Wofford (79-56) last week. He averaged 31.5 points, 6.0 assists and connected on 63 percent of his field goal attempts. It is the sixth time this season he has won the award, setting a new single-season record since the award was created in 1968.

Curry scored a game-high 30 points in Davidson's victory over Furman and tallied 33 against Wofford, marking the 25th time in his career he has scored at least 30 points. He has scored at least 30 points 10 times this season, one off the school record of 11 he set in 2007-08. Curry leads the nation with 29.3 points per game. He also leads the league in assists (6.4 apg) and steals (2.9 spg). Curry has moved into 21st place on the NCAA's Division I career made three-pointers list (358).

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Guard Kellen Brand scored 31 points against Western Carolina on Saturday. It was the highest output by a Mountaineer in over two years, and a career high for the junior. He has scored in double-figures seven of his last eight games. Brand has led the team in scoring seven times this season.
- Appalachian State is second in the league in rebounding (39.8 rpg). The Mountaineers are tops in the Southern Conference with a +6.5 rebounding margin which is the 28th best mark in the nation.
- ASU will host Wofford Thursday night at Holmes Center.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Senior forward Nichaeus Doaks is one point shy of 1,200 for his career. He passed the 700 mark in rebounds at Elon. With 705 rebounds for his career, he is 42 short of the UTC record for the Division I era of 747 by Lance Fulse (1985-88).
- Senior forward Kevin Goffney has scored at least 20 points in three of his last four games. He is averaging 15.2 points and 7.7 rebounds per game in SoCon play, while shooting 54.9 percent (56-102) from the field. He is shooting 65.8 percent (52-79) from inside the arc.
- Chattanooga hosts Davidson on Wednesday. The Mocs will then host Georgia Southern Saturday afternoon.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Senior guard Brett James continues to climb Elon's career scoring chart. James now ranks 22nd in program history with 1,157 points. He ranks fifth in the conference in steals per game (1.6 spg).
- Elon played back-to-back overtime games for the first time since Feb. 23 and 28, 2004. The Phoenix went into double overtime with Chattanooga before playing one extra period at Wofford. In 2004, Elon lost an 83-80 overtime game at Georgia Southern before coming home to beat UNCG 112-108 in three extra periods.
- The Phoenix travel to Charleston, S.C. to face The Citadel Thursday night and College of Charleston Saturday afternoon.

## UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Junior Mikko Koivisto leads the conference in free throw percentage. Koivisto has connected on 89 percent of his free throw attempts this season. He is 14th in the conference in scoring with 13.0 points per game.
- Junior forward Ben Stywall has scored in double figures in eight of his last nine games. He is UNCG's second-leading scorer with 10.2 points per game. Stywall is second in the conference with 9.2 rebounds per game.
- The Spartans travel to face College of Charleston Thursday. UNCG will then visit The Citadel on Saturday.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford's recent four-game winning streak was its longest winning streak since a similar stretch was snapped on Dec. 28, 2006, against Wright State at the Hispanic College Funds Classic hosted by LSU.
- The Bulldogs' 50 percent (10-of-20) performance from three-point range at UNC Greensboro on Saturday was its second-best of the 2008-09 campaign. Conversely, Samford's 18.8-percent outing from beyond the arc Monday versus The Citadel was its third-worst of the season.
- Samford hosts Georgia Southern Thursday night.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- The Catamounts are a perfect 3-0 at home in league play and are 1-4 on the road in the conference. WCU dropped it's last outing, a 76-70 decision at Appalachian State Saturday afternoon.
- WCU is second in the league with a +3.3 rebounding margin. The Catamounts are tops in the conference with 14.9 offensive rebounds per game.
- Western Carolina hosts Furman Thursday night in Cullowhee.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- Sophomore Andrew Goudelock tallied a career-high 33 points in College of Charleston's 88-80 win over Appalachian State last Wednesday. Goudelock became the first Cougar to reach the 30-point plateau since Dontaye Draper scored 38 points in Charleston's 89-87 overtime win over the Mountaineers on March 2, 2007.
- Guard Tony White, Jr., has continued his consistent play in the backcourt for CofC. White has hit 28 straight free throws, a new CofC NCAA Division I record. He has scored in double figures in eight of his last ten games. White is eighth in the league in assists (2.9 apg)
- College of Charleston hosts UNC Greensboro Thursday. The Cougars will entertain Elon Saturday afternoon.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Bob McKillop, the all-time winningest coach in SoCon history, notched his 200th career league victory with the Wildcats' 79-56 triumph over Wofford Jan. 24. McKillop leads all league coaches with 319 wins at a SoCon school.
- Davidson has won 26 straight games at Belk Arena, the third-longest active home court win streak in Division I basketball. The Wildcats last loss at home was an 81-74 decision against Appalachian State on January 20, 2007.
- The Wildcats travel to face Chattanooga Wednesday night. The Wildcats visit Samford Saturday afternoon in Birmingham, Ala.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Sophomore Bryson Barnes has scored in double figures in each of the last two games for Furman. Barnes is seventh in the league in blocked shots (1.1 bpg).
- Sophomore guard Jordan Miller is 11th in the conference in scoring. Miller is averaging 14.0 points per game and also ranks eighth in the conference in free throw percentage (.810). Miller scored 19 points in Furman's win over UNC Greensboro Monday night.
- The Paladins travel to Western Carolina Thursday night.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Georgia Southern picked up wins over Furman and Wofford last week. The Eagles held both teams to just 53 points, the lowest output for a GSU opponent this season.
- Antonio Hanson had made only five three pointers in his previous four games but hit 5-of-10 in the Furman contest, part of his team-high 17 points. Hanson is third in the conference with 2.8 three pointers per game this season
- The Eagles visit Samford Thursday night. Georgia Southern then travels to take on Chattanooga Saturday afternoon.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Senior Demetrius Nelson scored 16 points in last Thursday's win over Western Carolina to reach the 1,000-point plateau for his career. He became just the 25th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points and is the fifth-leading active scorer in the SoCon (1,031).
- The Citadel picked up three wins last week in which it outscored its opponents by an average score of 69-53. The Citadel shot 53 percent from the field over the three games, while limiting its opponents to just 38 percent.
- The Citadel hosts Elon at McAlister Field House Thursday evening.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- The Terriers enter the week 4-4 in league play after an overtime win over Elon Monday night. Wofford is averaging only 14.8 fouls per game this season, which is ranked 11th in the nation
- Wofford knocked off Elon despite trailing at the half. The Terriers are 6-0 when leading or tied at the half this season, but just 2-9 when trailing at the intermission.
- Wofford travels to Appalachian State Thursday evening, before visiting Western Carolina Saturday.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### RPI STRENGTH

The Southern Conference ranks 12th in the Men's Basketball RPI Report, released January 26. The league has garnered the second toughest strength of schedule rating among 31 Division I conferences. Three of the league's teams (Davidson, 37; College of Charleston, 114; Wofford, 139) rank in the top 150.

### STREAKING

Davidson owns a 39-game conference winning streak after defeating Wofford, 79-56, on January 24. The Wildcats won their final 10 games during league play in 2006-07, before posting a 20-0 mark last year. Davidson's streak is the third-longest conference consecutive wins streak in league history.

- West Virginia won a league-best 44 straight conference games from 1956-1960. North Carolina won 34 straight league games from 1923-25.

### TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

### NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Southern Conference teams took on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams participated in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams participated in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

### BRACKETBUSTERS 2009

Four Southern Conference teams will take part in the 2009 ESPNU BracketBusters event February 20-21. The event will feature 13 nationally televised games - on either ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU - selected from a pool of 102 teams.

- Davidson and Georgia Southern have been designated as home teams during the event, while Appalachian State and Elon will take to the road. The matchups for the 13 nationally televised games will be announced Feb. 2.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### TOURNEY TIME

The 2009 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 6-9 at The McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga. All 12 members of the Southern Conference will take part in the conference tournament. The championship game, scheduled for March 9, will be televised by ESPN2.

- The 2009 tournament will be the second time the league has held its conference championship in Chattanooga, after using the same site in 2005. The host Mocs downed UNC Greensboro, 65-62, in the final that year.

### HALL OF FAME

Southern Conference Commissioner John Iamarino announced the formation of the SoCon Hall of Fame for 2009. The league will induct its inaugural class during a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C., on May 4. The Southern Conference is in its 88th season of intercollegiate competition and will begin recognizing many prominent student-athletes, coaches and administrators from the 43 current and former institutions that have been a part of the league's distinguished history.

- Among the nominees for consideration from Southern Conference men's basketball are Dick Groat (Duke), "Hot" Rod Hundley (West Virginia), Frank Selvy (Furman) and Jerry West (West Virginia).

### EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches return to the bench for 2008-09. The current league head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

### EXPERIENCE ON THE COURT

The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

### SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

### PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.

### NEW MEMBERSHIP

Samford University, located in Birmingham, Ala., begins its first season as a member of the Southern Conference after officially joining the league on July 1, 2008. The Bulldogs, who play their home games in the 5,000-seat Pete Hanna Center, finished last season 14-16, including a 10-10 mark in Ohio Valley conference play.
