## Quick Hits

- All six teams in the North Division enter the weekend within a game of first place.
- The Citadel's Mike Groselle leads the league in both scoring (16.9 ppg) and rebounding (9.7 rpg).
- Wofford head coach Mike Young has 148 wins as head coach of the Terriers and is tied with Herman J. Stegeman (Georgia, 1921-31) for 14th place on the league's all-time wins list.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated Asheville Civic Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

## Player of the Week

Davidson forward Jake Cohen has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games played January 10-16 the league office announced Tuesday (Jan. 17). It is the second consecutive week Cohen has won the award and the third time he has claimed the honor this season. The junior averaged 23.5 points and 6.5 rebounds in two games last week.

A junior, Cohen entered Thursday's game against Western Carolina with 987 points. The Berwyn, Pa., native scored Davidson's first 13 points of the game to reach 1,000 for his career. He finished the game with 26 points and six rebounds. Saturday afternoon against

Appalachian State, Cohen tallied 21 points and seven rebounds.

Cohen shot 67 percent from the field (16-of-24) and made five of seven three-point attempts last week. Cohen added five assists, five blocked shots and a steal in the two games.

Other top performers in the SoCon included ASU's Andre Williamson, CofC's Adjehi Baru, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Furman's Brandon Sebirumbi, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, UNCG's Trevis Simpson, Chattanooga's Z. Mason, Samford's Drew Windler, and Wofford's Brad Loesing.

**MOUNTAINEERS**

Andre Williamson recorded game highs in points (20) and rebounds (9) but the Mountaineers fell at Wofford (73-61) Thursday night. The senior forward was 8-for-12 from the floor, including 2-of-3 from three-point range.

ASU knocked down eight triples against the Terriers. Appalachian State leads the SoCon in three-point percentage (.365).

The Mountaineers host Western Carolina Saturday. ASU visits UNCG January 26.

**NORTH DIVISION****COUGARS**

Andrew Lawrence led the Cougars with 18 points but College of Charleston lost at Davidson (87-69) Thursday night. Antwaine Wiggins scored 17 for the Cougars while Nori Johnson added 15. The Cougars were outrebounded 48-34.

The Cougars have shot 44 percent from the field this season but were limited to just 39 percent at Davidson. College of Charleston was 7-of-26 from three-point range.

CofC travels to take on Georgia Southern Saturday evening. The Cougars host Furman Thursday night.

**PHOENIX****NORTH DIVISION**

Senior Drew Spradlin came off the bench and led the Phoenix with 19 points and six rebounds against Samford Thursday. Spradlin added four assists and a steal in 32 minutes of action.

Elon pulled down 33 rebounds against Samford. The Phoenix rank third in the Southern Conference with 37.4 rebounds per contest, but are last in rebounding margin (-4.1).

The Phoenix will take on Chattanooga Saturday at Alumni Gym. Elon travels to Western Carolina Thursday night.

**BULLDOGS****SOUTH DIVISION**

Mike Groselle, who finished with 17 points and 11 rebounds against Elon on January 12, took sole possession of third place on The Citadel's all-time double-double list with 17 in his career. He is now five short of Regan Truesdale for the most in program history.

Over the course of the last five games, Citadel senior Cosmo Morabbi has established several career firsts, including game-highs in rebounds (9 vs. Elon), assists (6 vs. Samford), and points (20 vs. Elon). He has also reached the double figure mark on four occasions in a single season, a career-first.

**SPARTANS****NORTH DIVISION**

After losing 11 consecutive games, the Spartans have now won three straight following Thursday's 81-72 win over Chattanooga. Derrell Armstrong led all scorers with 29 points off the bench, which tied for the fourth-highest scoring output by a SoCon player this season.

Aaron Brackett pulled down 11 rebounds, including three on the offensive glass. UNCG leads the SoCon with 14.8 offensive rebounds per game.

The Spartans host Samford Sunday afternoon and will welcome Appalachian State to the Greensboro Coliseum Thursday night.

**WILDCATS****SOUTH DIVISION**

The Wildcats have won 15 of their last 16 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season. Davidson is the last unbeaten team in league play this season.

Jake Cohen led all scorers with 29 points against College of Charleston Thursday as the Wildcats topped the Cougars, 87-69. The junior forward added 14 rebounds and was 9-of-9 from the free throw line. Nik Cochran added 16 points.

The Wildcats host The Citadel Saturday at Belk Arena.

**BULLDOGS****NORTH DIVISION**

Samford's 86 points scored against Elon Thursday was its second best scoring total of the season. The Bulldogs' performance against the Phoenix has only been bested by a home victory over Spring Hill (90).

Samford made a league-high 16 three-pointers at Elon. The Bulldogs lead the conference with an average of 9.4 triples per contest.

Samford visits UNCG Sunday. The Bulldogs return home to host Georgia Southern Thursday in a game the can be seen on ESPN3.

**PALADINS****SOUTH DIVISION**

Charlie Reddick recorded a double-double with 16 points and a game-high 14 rebounds as Furman topped Georgia Southern Thursday in Greenville, S.C. Brandon Sebirumbi added 16 points for the Paladins who have won two straight in league play.

Furman gave up just 54 points to Georgia Southern. The Paladins rank second in the league in scoring defense (63.4 ppg).

Furman will play six of its next 10 games at home. The Paladins host Wofford Saturday afternoon.

**MOCS****NORTH DIVISION**

Drazen Zlovaric posted a double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds against Samford Thursday. It was his second double-double of the season.

Keegan Bell passed Tim Brooks (1992-93) at Samford to move into first place all-time at Chattanooga with 224 assists in SoCon play.

Senior guard Ricky Taylor (1,096) is 12 points shy of the top 10 in scoring during UTC's Division I era.

The Mocs visit Elon Saturday night.

**EAGLES****SOUTH DIVISION**

Eric Ferguson led a trio of Eagles in double figures but Georgia Southern fell at Furman, 64-54 Thursday. Ferguson tallied a team-high 15 points and grabbed eight rebounds for GSU.

The Eagles lead the conference in field goal shooting (.465) and rank third in three-point shooting (.356). Ferguson ranks fourth in the SoCon, shooting 57 percent from the floor.

Georgia Southern hosts College of Charleston Saturday night. The Eagles welcome The Citadel to Statesboro Monday.

**CATAMOUNTS****NORTH DIVISION**

Western Carolina's 141 points against Toccoa Falls was the third highest scoring output in the history of the SoCon. WCU's 102 point margin of victory was the third largest in NCAA history.

Sophomore Trey Sumler has made 91.0 percent of his free throw attempts this season, the fifth best average in the nation.

Western Carolina travels to take on Appalachian State Saturday afternoon. The game will be televised by the SoCon Sports Network and will be available on ESPN3.

**TERRIERS****SOUTH DIVISION**

Drew Crowell's 19 points led three Terriers in double figures as Wofford topped Appalachian State Thursday. Wofford shot 53.8 percent from the field and outrebounded ASU, 33-25.

The Terriers are 8-1 at home this season. They are also 11-0 when leading at the half.

The Terriers will visit Furman Saturday afternoon. Wofford travels to face The Citadel Thursday night.

## Conference News and Notes

### Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 80.0 points per game. College of Charleston ranks second with 71.4 points per contest.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

### Cousy Nominees

Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, Davidson's JP Kuhlman and Western Carolina's Trey Sumler have been named to the Cousy Award Watch List. The Cousy Award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

### Athletes of the Month

Antwaine Wiggins was earned December Athlete of the Month honors in men's basketball. Wiggins led College of Charleston to a 5-2 record in the month. He averaged a team-and conference-leading 18.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Wiggins tied a career-high with 24 points against his home state Tennessee Vols, including 15 in the second half of play. Wiggins also reached a milestone of his own becoming the 29th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points with his jumper at the 8:32 minute mark of the first half at Louisville on Dec. 20.

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball in November. Groselle recorded five double-doubles during the month. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

### Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

### Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

### NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

## Southern Conference News and Notes

### Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

### Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

### Freshman Honors

UNCG's Trevis Simpson was named to the league's all-freshman team in 2011. It was the third consecutive year that a Spartan was named to the league's all-freshman squad.

- Point guard Kyle Randall was named to the all-freshman team in 2010, while Damian Eargle was selected in 2009.

### Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

### Annual Leaders

Furman limited its opponents to just 64.4 points per game last season. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

Western Carolina's Mike Williams led the league in steals last year (2.0 spg) making it four consecutive seasons that a Catamount has led the Southern Conference in steals.

- Brigham Waginger, now an assistant coach at WCU, led the league in steals three consecutive seasons (2008-10).

College of Charleston led the league with 306 made three-pointers last year, the fifth highest single-season total in league history.

- Elon connected on 285 made triples last season, which tied for the ninth-best single season total.

### SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.

## SoCon Championship

The 2012 Southern Conference Men's Basketball Championship will be held March 2-5 in Asheville, N.C., at the newly renovated U.S. Cellular Arena. The 2012 tournament will mark a return to Asheville, site of the men's basketball tournament from 1984-95.

The oldest conference tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2012 will mark the 92nd year of the postseason classic.

### Postseason Play

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the postseason for 2011. It was the third consecutive year the conference placed four teams in the postseason.
