- Katie Burrows, a Chattanooga alum, enters her second season after leading her squad to a 14-17 record and 8-6 mark in SoCon play. The Mocs advanced to the SoCon semifinals.
- The Mocs return two starters, including senior guard Lakelyn Bouldin who led the team with 13 points last seaosn. She was named to the preseason all-conference team alongside teammate Eboni Williams.



#### Wofford

- Wofford was picked second by the coaches in the preseason poll after posting a 7-7 SoCon mark last season

### NOTES AND PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ETSU (5-9) has bested its non-conference win total from the 2018-19 season. Last season ETSU went 2-14 against out-of-conference opponents.
- ETSU's 67-60 win over ACC opponent Wake Forest was ETSU's first win over a Power 5 opponent since 2008-09 when the Bucs upset Kentucky 59-50 on the road.
- Head coach Brittney Ezell coached her 200th game as the leader of the Bucs in the 65-60 win over South Alabama on Dec. 20.

- Redshirt junior guard/forward Tierra Hodges was named the December Player of the Month. In recent action, Hodges recorded her third consecutive double-double and team-leading seventh of the season after leading Furman with 12 points and 10 rebounds in a 62-43 home win over Newberry on Jan. 2.
- Taylor Petty currently sits 14 points away from reaching 1,000 in her career. She would become the 24th player in Furman history to score 1,000 career points.
   Le'Jzae Davidson is five points away from passing Holli Wilkins (2013-16) for sixth-place all-time at Furman in career scoring.

- Mercer has 11 freshmen and sophomores on the roster, tied with Winthrop for the most in the country.
- · Head coach Susie Gardner coached her 300th game as the leader of the Bears in the overtime loss to Jacksonville on Dec. 29.
- Sophomore Jaron Dougherty was tabbed the SoCon Player of the Week after averaging 20.3 points and 7.3 rebounds. She has recoeded double-digit points in six of the last seven games, including five games with 20+ points.
- Mercer enters conference play having won its last 34 games against SoCon opponents, the longest streak in program history. The Bears be tested early, however, as they open with a rematch of last season's conference championship game against Furman on Thursday. Mercer is coming off back-to-back undefeated seasons in conference play, becoming the second team to accomplish that feat in SoCon history joining Chattanooga who did so from 2013-15.

  • Freshman Jill Harris has been one of the premier young ball handlers in the nation as she ranks 15th nationally and first in the SoCon among freshmen in total
- assists with 51. Her 2.0 assist/turnover ratio is also tops in the SoCon and is the eighth best among freshmen in the country.

#### **UNCG**

- UNCG's win over Wake Forest was the Spartans' first victory over the Demon-Deacons since 2005.
- Te'ja Twitty became the 26th person in program history to surpass 1,000 career points after scoring 14 points against Coastal Carolina.
- · Head coach Trina Patterson coached her 100th game as the leader of the Spartans on Sunday, Nov. 17 against Maryland Eastern Shore. The Spartans won 86-48.
- Nadine Soliman is 81 points away from UNCG's all-time scoring mark (1,907). Her 1,826 points leads all active players in the league.
- UNCG is off to its best start since the turn of the century at 11-4. The Spartans are on a 5-game winning streak and a 7-game win streak at home. Should the Spartans win the next three home games, the squad would tie a program record for longest home winning streak in the past two decades.

- Carley Kuhns got her first win as the Samford leader with an 81-60 win over Montevallo to open the season. On Nov. 17, she coached her 100th career game at No. 12 Florida State.
- Samford set a school record for first-half points (51) on its way to an 84-56 win at Murray State on Dec. 20.
- · Maryland transfer Sarah Myers has had an immediate impact on the team so far. She leads the team in both scoring (13.5 ppg) and rebounding (6.4 rpg).
- Charity Brown, the league's active leader in career assists, surpassed 400 in the win over Murray State.

- Chattanooga is looking to break an 11-game losing streak.
- · Lakelyn Bouldin leads the Mocs in scoring (12.1 ppg) while Eboni Williams leads the squad in rebounding (7.8).

#### **Western Carolina**

- Farasia Hodge came off the bench scoring her new career-high of 17 points and connecting on a career-best seven field goals against Southern Wesleyan. She also ripped down a season-best eight rebounds.
- The Catamounts' 70 points in the game is a season-high for the team. Western Carolina has scored 60 or more points in six of the last seven games. In that seven-game stretch, WCU is averaging 63.1 points per game.

  • Lauren LaPlant has scored in double figures in seven of the last nine games. She has also hit four or more three-pointers in a game in five of the last seven contests.

#### **Wofford**

- Chloe Wanink leads the Terriers, averaging 17.5 points per game, second in the league behind UNCG's Nadine Soliman. Terriers' head coach Jimmy Garrity coached his 100th game at Wofford in a 70-57 loss to Georgia Southern on Dec. 1.

- Wofford is looking to start off conference play 2-0 for the first time in program history.
   For the 4th time this season, Wofford held their opponent to under 40 points after taking down Brevard 82-34.
- Lilly Hatton has made her presence known as she ranks 7th among all freshman in the country in blocks per game (2.0).

### Mercer's Jaron Dougherty **Sophomore forward**

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - Mercer's Jaron Dougherty has been named the Southern Conference women's basketball player of the week presented by GEICO for games played Dec. 24 to Jan. 6 after averaging 20.3 points, 7.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists per contest. The award is selected by the league office.

The forward scored 22 points and pulled down six rebounds in an overtime loss to Jacksonville on Dec. 29. She added five assists, two blocks and two steals against the Dolphins. Dougherty kicked off 2020 with a game-high and career-high 26 points at Yale on Jan. 2 and added 10 rebounds to notch her team-leading fifth double-double of the season. The Buford, Georgia, native concluded the week with a team-high 13 points, six rebounds and three steals at Columbia on Jan. 4.

Dougherty is fourth in the league in scoring, averaging 15.3 points per game, and is also in the top 10 in rebounding, field goal percentage, steals and blocks.

Mercer (3-12) begins Southern Conference play with three straight road games, beginning at Furman on Thursday, Jan. 9, before traveling to Wofford on Saturday, Jan. 11.

Also nominated: Tierra Hodges (Furman), Te'ja Twitty (UNC Greensboro), Sarah Myers (Samford) and Tembre Moates (Western Carolina).
