### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Andrew Goudelock - CofC

Goudelock averaged 20.7 points, 6.0 assists and 3.7 rebounds in three games last week as the Cougars went 2-1 in league play.

He opened the week with 28 points, three rebounds and three assists in CofC's win over Furman (92-80) last Thursday. The Lilburn, Ga., native tallied 10 points, five rebounds and four assists in Friday's 70-68 win over Wofford. Goudelock then tallied a double-double with 24 points and 11 assists in Monday's 100-90 loss at Western Carolina. He tied his career high with six triples against the Catamounts. Goudelock connected on 23-of-40 field goal attempts and made 10-of-18 attempts from three-point range while averaging 37.3 minutes played per contest.

The junior guard is second in the league in scoring (19.3 ppg) and eighth in field goal percentage (.482). He is fourth in the league in made three-pointers per game (2.7). Goudelock has scored in double figures in 14 straight games and has reached the 20-point plateau in seven of his last eight games.

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



• Donald Sims scored 28 points on Saturday against WCU and leads the league with 19.4 points per game. He has a chance to become just the second Mountaineer to win the SoCon scoring title. Billy Ross averaged 24.4 points per game in 1992-93 for ASU.

• The Mountaineers saw their three-game winning streak snapped at Georgia Southern Thursday but recovered with a home win against Western Carolina. ASU has won 11 of the last 12 games against the Catamounts.

- Appalachian State visits Samford Thursday night.

## ELON PHOENIX



• Elon broke a nine-game losing streak with its victory against Chattanooga Saturday night. Both of Elon's league victories this year have come against the Mocs. In two games against Chattanooga this season, Chris Long has netted a total of 45 points and dished out 16 assists.

• Drew Spradlin scored 30 points against the Mocs, the first 30-point game by an Elon player since the 2006-07 season.

Spradlin is averaging 13.1 points per game this season, the ninth best mark in the league. Spradlin has made 1.9 three-pointers per game this season, the 11th-best average in the league.

- The Phoenix visit UNC Greensboro Thursday night.

## UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



• Ben Stywall pulled down a game-high 19 rebounds Saturday against Samford. It was the highest single-game rebound total in the conference this season. Stywall leads the league with 10.5 rebounds per game to go along with 14.3 points per contest. He is one of just three players in the league to rank in the top ten for both scoring and rebounding.

- The Spartans lead the league with 15.1 offensive rebounds per game, outpacing second-place Western Carolina (13.0) by more than two offensive boards per contest.
- The Spartans host Elon Thursday night.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



• Associate head coach Paul Kelly has assumed the lead coaching duties following coach Jimmy Tillette's hospitalization. Kelly is in his 13th year at Samford and his fifth full season as the team's associate head coach.

- Monday's game at Furman marked the first time since Feb. 28, 1997 that someone other than Tillette has started a game as Samford's acting coach. In that 1997 contest, John Brady made his final Bulldogs' coaching appearance in a 90-67 loss to Florida International in the second round of the Trans-Atlantic Athletic Conference (TAAC) Tournament.
- The Bulldogs visit UNC Greensboro Saturday afternoon.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



• Junior Troy Cage made his return to the Mocs Monday at Wofford. Cage was believed to be out for the season after a Dec. 3 surgery to insert a rod in his leg to alleviate a stress fracture that had plagued him from the moment he walked on campus.

• The Mocs committed 16 turnovers in Monday's loss at Wofford. Chattanooga is 6-0 when committing less than 15 turnovers, 5-10 when registering 15 or more. The Mocs have a -2.4 turnover margin on the season.

- Chattanooga hosts Western Carolina Thursday.



## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS

• Jake Robinson became WCU's all-time career 3-point leader, supplanting former standout – and current assistant coach – Anquell McCollum (1993-96). Robinson currently has 249 career 3-pointers – six shy of tying for 10th-place on the SoCon's career made 3-pointers ledger.

- Monday night's attendance of 4,765 was the most to see a Western Carolina basketball game since 1996 when 4,577 were on hand when the Catamounts clinched the SoCon South Division title.
- Western Carolina visits Chattanooga Thursday.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



• Austin Dahn enters the week two three-pointers shy of moving into a sixth place tie with Dante Terry and Donny McLendon (160) on the school's all-time three-point field goals list. Dahn has made 27 triples for the Bulldogs this season.

• The Citadel is looking to improve its record to .500 with two games on the road this week. In eight previous games on the road the Bulldogs are 3-5. The Citadel is 2-0 in games played on a neutral court and 5-5 at home this season.

- The Bulldogs visit Georgia Southern Thursday night.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



• College of Charleston suffered its first defeat in league play with a 100-90 loss at Western Carolina Monday night. At 8-1 in conference play, the Cougars are off to their best start since opening the 2000-01 season 8-1.

• The Cougars broke the school record for three-pointers with 19 at Western Carolina Monday. The old mark was 16 made triples, set Feb. 22, 2003 at Chattanooga. The Cougars average 9.3 made three-pointers per game, the second-best mark in the league, and are led by Andrew Goudelock's 2.7 triples per game. CofC has made 38 percent of its attempts from beyond the arc

- College of Charleston visits Davidson Thursday night.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



• Steve Rossiter became just the 30th Davidson player to tally 500 points and 500 rebounds. Rossiter topped the 500-rebound mark with 10 boards against Western Carolina. He has started in every game for the Wildcats this season. He is averaging 7.0 points and 6.1 rebounds per contest and is shooting 55 percent from the field.

- Senior Will Archambault is 45 points away from becoming the 38th Davidson player to score 1,000 for his career. He is averaging 11.2 points per game, the 18th best mark in the league.
- The Wildcats visit Georgia Southern Saturday afternoon.

## FURMAN PALADINS



• The Paladins are second in the league in blocked shots per game (4.9 bpg). Freshman Colin Reddick is third in the league with 1.5 blocks per game while teammate Bryson Barnes is eighth with 1.2 rejections per contest.

• Coming off of back-to-back seasons of 7-23 and 6-24, Furman has shown significant improvement through the first half of the 2009-10 season while posting a 10-10 record. After averaging just 61 points per game last season, the Paladins have scored 69.9 per contest this season and topped 80 points on six outings.

- Furman travels to take on Wofford Saturday afternoon in Spartanburg, S.C.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



• Willie Powers III is connecting on 84.7 percent of his free throws, the best percentage of his career, a figure that would stand third on the Eagles' single-season list. His current career percentage of 75.7 would stand fourth on the GSU career chart.

- Senior Antonio Hanson has been one of the top long-range threats in the league this season. Hanson is second in the conference with 3.1 made three-pointers per game and has shot 42 percent from beyond the arc, the seventh best mark in the SoCon. Hanson is 12th in the league in scoring with 12.9 points per game.
- Georgia Southern hosts The Citadel Thursday.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



• Tim Johnson has led the team in rebounding in eight straight games. Over the past four games, he is averaging 12.0 rebounds per game. Johnson averages 6.7 boards per game, the sixth-best mark in the conference. He is averaging 2.0 offensive rebounds per contest.

- Brad Loesing leads the league in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.5. He tied a season high with eight assists against Chattanooga with no turnovers. Loesing is ninth in the SoCon with 3.3 assists per game.
- Wofford hosts Furman Saturday. The game will be televised by SportSouth.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Wofford junior Noah Dahlman has led the league in field goal percentage each of the past two seasons. Dahlman shot .609 from the field as a freshman and .601 last year. If he is able to lead the conference shooting percentage again, he would be the first player to lead the league in field goal percentage three straight seasons since Joe Holup of George Washington (1954-56).

Western Carolina junior Brigham Waginger led the league in steals in 2008 (69) and 2009 (81). Should he lead the league in steals again this season it would be the first time the same player has led the conference for three consecutive seasons. East Tennessee State's Keith Jennings is the only other player in league history to lead the league in steals for three seasons (1988, 1989, 1991).

Davidson has led the league in scoring each of the past four seasons. The only team to lead the conference in scoring for more than four straight years was West Virginia. The Mountaineers were the top scoring team in the league for seven consecutive seasons from 1957-1963.

### ALL-DECADE RECOGNITION

CollegeInsider.com recently released it's All-Decade team which featured the top 25 players from the past decade (2000-2009). Davidson's Stephen Curry (2006-09) was named to the All-Decade Team. He finished his career as the league's leading scorer with 2,635 points in three years.

- Western Carolina's Kevin Martin (2001-04) and East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2002-06) were named to the Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Martin led the league in scoring in 2003 and 2004 before being taken in the first round of the 2004 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. A two-time SoCon Tourney MVP, Smith was the league's leading scorer in 2005.

### SCHEDULE CHANGE

Following a 20-game league schedule each of the past two seasons, the SoCon Council of Presidents voted to move to an 18-game league slate beginning 2009-10. The last time the conference played 18 league games was during the 2006-07 season. The SoCon also played 18 games during the 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 5-8 in Charlotte. The first two round (March 5-6) will take place at Bojangles Coliseum while the semifinals and finals (March 7-8) will take place at Time Warner Cable Arena. It will mark the league's first conference tournament in Charlotte since 1971.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2010 will mark the 89th year of the post-season classic.

Appalachian State's Donald Sims scored 44 points January 9 at Davidson. It was the highest scoring output for a SoCon performer since Davidson's Stephen Curry tallied 44 points at Oklahoma on November 18, 2008. It was the 10th 40-point performance in a league game dating back to 1999.

### FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2009-10. No team had fewer than seven returning lettermen and seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 41 starters from last year, an average of 3.4 per team. Three teams (Furman, Western Carolina and Wofford) return all five starters.

### HEAD COACHES

Nine of the league's 12 head coaches return to the bench in 2009-10. The current head coaches have a combined 58 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Buzz Peterson returned to Appalachian State after guiding the Mountaineers from 1997-2000. Matt Matheny took over the Elon Phoenix after spending 16 years on Bob McKillop's staff at Davidson and Charlton Young returned to his alma mater to take over the Georgia Southern Eagles.
- Four SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments last season. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

- The Mocs made their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005 before falling to UConn last year.
- Davidson made its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 3-5 all-time in the NIT after losing at Saint Mary's in the second round.
- College of Charleston lost at Richmond in the second round of the College Basketball Invitational. It was the eighth postseason appearance for CofC.
- The Citadel fell to Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.
