PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Noah Dahlman Wofford

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - Wofford's Noah Dahlman has been named the Southern Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week for all games February 17-23 the league office announced Tuesday (Feb. 24). Dahlman helped the Terriers pick up victories over Furman (85-82, OT) and Western Carolina (81-66). He averaged 22.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and connected on 62 percent of his field goal attempts (18-29) last week.

Dahlman led the Terriers in scoring both games, posting a career-high 25 points in Wofford's overtime win at Furman Saturday afternoon. He followed that performance with 20 points and seven rebounds against Western Carolina Monday night. Dahlman has led the Terriers in scoring in each of his last six games. He is the third-leading scorer in the conference (17.2 ppg) and leads the league in field goal percentage (.594). Dahlman is 14th in the league in rebounding (6.2 rpg), and leads the conference in offensive boards per game (3.2).

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Sophomore Donald Sims scored a career-high 35 points to lift Appalachian State to an 88-82 victory over Chattanooga Thursday night. He connected on nine three pointers in the win. Sims' 35 points was the highest point total for any Mountaineer this season.

- Five of ASU's last six games have been decided by five points or less, as have 12 of the team's games on the season. ASU continues to dominate the boards as the team holds a +7.7 rebound margin for the season, good for seventh-best in the nation.
- Appalachian State will entertain Samford Saturday afternoon to close out the regular season.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Senior Nicchaeus Doaks passed Lance Fulse (1985-88) for fourth place in career scoring in the Division I era in Saturday's win over Samford. Doaks now has 1,350 points, 99 behind Gerald Wilkins (1983-85) and Brandon Born (1992-95) who are tied for second with 1,449.

- Senior Stephen McDowell passed Keddrick Mays' (2006-07) for the school record of with 121 three pointers made in a single season (2007). McDowell is the school's all-time leader in three-pointers made with 227. His 119 this year and 108 last season makes him the only player in school history to make 100 in more than one season.

- The Mocs visit Western Carolina Saturday.

ELON PHOENIX



- Senior guard Brett James continues to climb Elon's career scoring chart. James now ranks 16th in program history with 1,260 points. He ranks third in the conference in blocked shots (1.4 bpg) and sixth in steals (1.6 spg).
- The Phoenix are fourth in the conference in assists (13.9 apg) and assist to turnover ratio (1.0). Sophomore

Chris Long is second in the league in assists per game (4.2 apg) and leads the conference in assist to turnover ratio (2.3).

- Elon visits UNC Greensboro Saturday. The Phoenix will host Davidson Monday night to close out the regular season.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Mikko Koivisto moved into the Top 20 on the UNCG career scoring list last week. He now has 913 points in his career, which is good for 19th place all-time at UNCG. He is also 17th in assists with 147 and third in three-point field goals with 206.

- Ben Stywall has moved up to sixth on the UNCG career rebounds list, now with 617. Stywall's 230 rebounds thus far this season ranks 11th in school history for a single season.

- UNC Greensboro hosts Elon Saturday afternoon on SportSouth.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford is 13-4 when shooting better than its opponent from the field. The Bulldogs also hold a 12-5 mark when outshooting their opponent from three-point range. In Samford's 13 victories this season, the Bulldogs are shooting at an average of 52.2 percent

from the floor and 41.3 percent from beyond the arc.

- The Bulldogs have made at least one three-point field goal in 529 consecutive games. The last time that Samford did not make a three-point basket was Jan. 19, 1991, against Texas-San Antonio.
- Samford visits Appalachian State Saturday afternoon.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- With 15 wins on the season, Western Carolina has matched the most victories in Larry Hunter's tenure in Cullowhee. Hunter won 13 games in his first season at the helm of the Catamount program (13-17) in 2005-06.

- Western Carolina's 10 conference victories this year equals its highest total since winning 10 games during the 1995-96 season, which was WCU's only divisional title and tournament championship.

- The Catamounts host Chattanooga Saturday night.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- Thursday's win over Wofford gave the Cougars their 22nd win of the season. CofC has won at least 20 games for the 22nd time in the past 30 seasons. The Cougars have averaged 23.3 wins and just 7.2 losses per season during that span.

- Head coach Bobby Cremens and CofC women's coach Nancy Wilson are one of only four active Division I men's and women's coaches at the same school to have reached at least 500 wins.

- College of Charleston closes out the regular season Saturday at home against Furman.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- With 2,454 career points, junior Stephen Curry is fourth all-time on the Southern Conference's career scoring list. He needs 30 points to become Davidson's all-time leading scorer.

- Davidson leads the conference and ranks seventh in the nation in turnover margin (+5.4). The Wildcats average just 12.2 turnovers a game and force their opponents into 17.6 miscues per contest.

- Davidson will host Georgia Southern Saturday. The Wildcats close out the regular season Monday night at Elon

FURMAN PALADINS



- Freshman Bryson Barnes recorded his third double-double of the season with a 10 points and 12 rebounds against The Citadel on Thursday. Barnes has averaged 14.6 points and 7.2 rebounds over his last five games.

- Sophomore guard Jordan Miller is 12th in the conference in scoring. Miller is averaging 13.9 points per game

and also ranks fifth in the conference in free throw percentage (.800). He has been Furman's leading scorer in 16 of 26 games this year.

- The Paladins visit College of Charleston Saturday afternoon. The game will be televised by SportSouth.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Freshman Ben Drayton III scored a season-high 26 points for the Eagles Thursday at Elon. Drayton has scored in double figures in each of his last nine contests and has tallied at least 20 points in three of those games.

- Head coach Jeff Price is just one win shy of 300 for his career. Price, in his 16th season as a head coach, has

captured 165 wins at Georgia Southern, the 13th-highest win total among all coaches to coach at a Southern Conference school.

- The Eagles will travel to face Davidson Saturday afternoon. GSU hosts The Citadel Monday to finish the regular season.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Bulldogs have won 11 straight games, the longest winning streak for The Citadel since the 1926-27 season when the Bulldogs won 13 games in a row. The Citadel's 13-game improvement in conference play is the biggest turnaround in league history.

- The Bulldogs defeated Davidson last Wednesday for the first time since 2002 and won in Davidson for the first time since 1990. Head coach Ed Conroy had never defeated the Wildcats in Davidson as a player or coach of The Citadel until last week's win.

- The Bulldogs will host Wofford Saturday before closing out the season at Georgia Southern Monday night.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Sophomore forward Noah Dahlman scored a career-high 36 points in Thursday's game at College of Charleston. Dahlman added 10 rebounds in the loss to CofC for his fourth double-double of the year. The Terriers have now scored at least 80 points in each of their last four games.

- Wofford's ten conference wins are the most since joining the league in the 1997-98 season. The ten wins also secures a .500 record in the conference play for only the fourth time.
- Wofford visits The Citadel Saturday afternoon in the regular season finale for the Terriers.

MOVING FORWARD

The Citadel has won 14 conference games this season after going 1-19 in league play during 2007-08. The Bulldogs' 13-game improvement is the best mark in league history for biggest turnaround in consecutive seasons.

TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Southern Conference teams took on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams participated in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams participated in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season marks the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November 2008 to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

The Southern Conference announced the inaugural Hall of Fame class for 2009. The 2009 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 6-9 at The McKenzie Arena (11,218) in Chattanooga. All 12 members of the Southern Conference will take part in the conference tournament. The championship game, scheduled for March 9, will be televised by ESPN. It marks the second time that the league tournament has been held at the facility. The SoCon Tournament was held at The McKenzie Arena in 2005.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2009 marks the 88th year of the post-season classic.

NEW MEMBERSHIP

Samford University, located in Birmingham, Ala., is in its first season as a member of the Southern Conference after officially joining the league on July 1, 2008. Only two teams in the history of the league have won the regular season conference title or a division crown in their first season (College of Charleston - 1999; West Virginia - 1951). EXPERIENCE ON THE COURT

The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches returned to the bench for 2008-09. The current league head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.
