##### UNC Greensboro's Randi Patterson

SPARTANBURG, SC -- Randi Patterson of UNC Greensboro has been named the Southern Conference men's soccer Player of the Week for the week of October 19 the league announced today.

A sophomore forward from Teaneck, NJ, Patterson led the Spartans to a 3-0 record on the week with wins over Davidson, Coastal Carolina and Mercer. In the match against Davidson, Patterson recorded a goal and an assist as the Spartans defeated Davidson 2-1 on Tuesday, October 12. He also assisted on the game winning goal in the Spartans' 2-0 win over the Chanticleers on Sunday, October 17. Named to the UNCG/adidas Classic All-Tournament team, Patterson recorded one goal, three assists and five points on the week.

The first-ranked Spartan's next match is scheduled for Tuesday, October 19 as it hosts Wofford at 5:00.

Other top performers for the week included Troy Lesesne of the College of Charleston, Davidson's Mac Wilkie, Stephen Jensen from Georgia Southern and Wofford's Tim Mittmann.

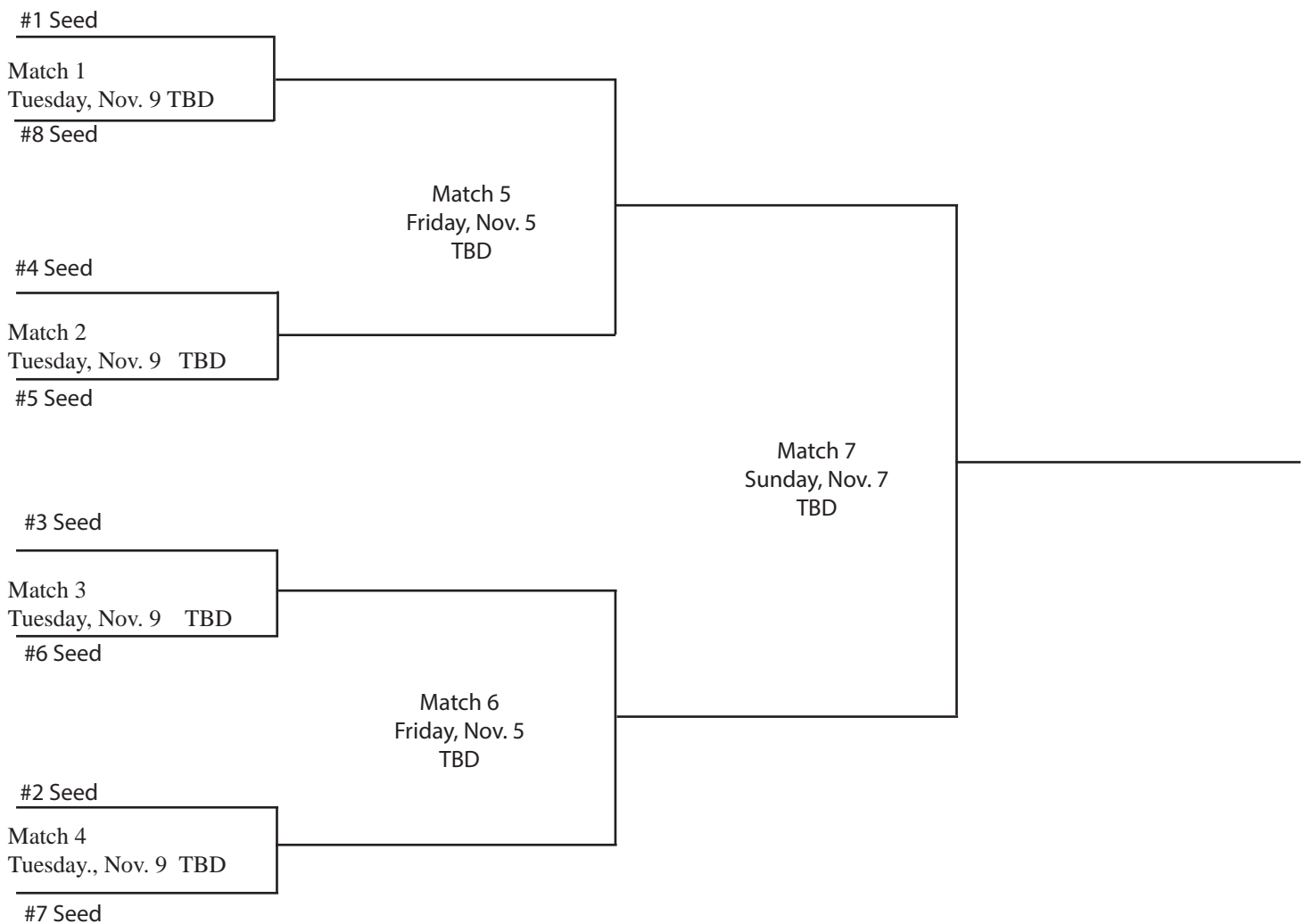

## **The Southern Conference Has the Consensus Number One Rated Men's Soccer Team in the Nation**

*UNC Greensboro receives number one ranking on all four major polls*

Spartanburg, SC – The Southern Conference boasts the consensus number one men's soccer team in the nation in UNC Greensboro according to this week's *College Soccer News* Top 30, *Soccer America*, *Soccer Times* and National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) polls.

Coming off back-to-back wins this weekend, and UC Santa Barbara falling to Cal-State Northridge, the Spartans have taken over the top spot in the nation. UNC Greensboro registered a 2-0 win over Coastal Carolina on Friday, October 15 and two days later, the Spartans defeated Mercer 1-0 to take over the number one ranking. UNCG is one of only two teams in the country without a loss this season. James Madison is 12-0-1
