Chattanooga's McDowell Named SoCon Player of the Week

Chattanooga's **Stephen McDowell** was named the Southern Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for the week ending January 13.

In two games last week, the Indianapolis, Ind. native averaged 20.0 points and 3.5 rebounds while helping lead the Mocs to victories over UNC Greensboro (78-73 on Jan. 10) and Western Carolina (85-55 on Jan. 12).

The junior scored 18 points against UNC Greensboro and tallied 22 versus Western Carolina. He made 14-of-31 (45.3 percent) shots from the field and was 11-of-24 (45.8 percent) from three-point range. The guard converted 1-of-2 free throws.

Other standout performances were turned in by Willie Powers (Georgia Southern), Stephen Curry (Davidson), Donald Sims (Appalachian State), Tony White Jr. (College of Charleston) and Brett James (Elon).

Tournament Seeding Procedures

The team with the best overall conference won-loss percentage in the North and South Divisions shall receive the top two seeds in the conference tournament. Other seeds for the tournament shall be determined based on each team's overall Conference won-loss percentage regardless of division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed, the seed shall be determined as follows:

- A. If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- B. If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie;
- C. If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- D. If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's Rating Percentage Index (RPI) as published by RPIratings.com after the completion of the last regular season game;
- E. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- F. If the teams are still tied, the team's records against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so forth until the tie is broken;
- G. If there is still a tie, the seeded position of the teams will be determined by comparing each team's RPI ratings as published by RPIratings.com,
- H. For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie; and
- I. For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian State



■ The Mountaineers have reeled off five consecutive wins, all in SoCon play, and have won seven of their last eight contests.

■ Appalachian State's hot shooting led to a 91-68 victory against UNC Greensboro on Jan. 12. The Mountaineers shot 59 percent from the field, 52 percent from three-point range and 81 percent from the line --- all highs for the Mountaineers in SoCon play this season.

■ Freshman Donald Sims averaged 11.5 points as games at Wofford and against UNC Greensboro last week. The Gaffney, S.C. native also dished out seven assists with four steals and four rebounds in the two games.



Elon

■ With a 60-58 victory at Furman on Jan. 12, Elon equaled both its overall and Southern Conference win totals from a year ago. The Phoenix finished the 2006-07 campaign with a 7-23 record, 5-13 in SoCon play.

■ Elon's 7-10 worksheet includes a 5-3 mark at home in 2007-08. After hosting UNC Greensboro on Jan. 19, the Phoenix play five consecutive road contests.

■ Limited to eight points in a 59-57 setback against Davidson on Jan. 9, Ola Atoyebi's streak of 11 consecutive double-figure scoring games came to an end.



UNC Greensboro

■ UNC Greensboro opponents made 10 or more three-pointers in all three games against the Spartans last week. It marks the first time since November 2004 that the Spartans had allowed 10 or more three-pointers in three consecutive games.

■ During UNC Greensboro's six-game winning streak, the Spartans held the opposition to 38 percent shooting from the floor. In back-to-back losses last week, Chattanooga and Appalachian State each shot 50 percent or better from the field.

■ Kyle Hines connected on 10-of-10 from the floor against The Citadel, It marked the seventh time in Southern Conference history that a player has shot 10-for-10 or better from the field and only the third time it has happened in a conference game.



Chattanooga

■ Chattanooga opened Southern Conference play by reeling off seven consecutive wins, the best start since 1996-97. The Mocs fell, 92-83, at Appalachian State on Jan. 17 to bring the winning streak to an end.

■ The Mocs are in the midst of their second four-game winning streak. The last time Chattanooga won five in a row was Jan. 3-15, 2005, coach John Shulman's first season at the helm.

■ Several Mocs players set a number of personal career highs in an 85-55 win over Western Carolina on Jan. 12. Marcus Watts (18 points), Kevin Goffney (14 rebounds) and Nicchaeus Doaks (13 rebounds) all set new highs.



Western Carolina

■ Coach Larry Hunter ranks 13th among the nation's winningest active Division I coaches. With 538 wins, he is currently tied with North Carolina mentor Roy Williams.

■ Western Carolina is the only SoCon school to have representation in the Major Leagues, NBA and NFL. Jared Burton is a pitcher for the Cincinnati Reds; Kevin Martin plays for the Sacramento Kings and Brad Hoover is a member of the Carolina Panthers and David Patten is with the New Orleans Saints.



SOUTH DIVISION

College of Charleston



- Tony White Jr. scored a career-high 26 points at Georgia Southern on Jan. 10. He is fifth in the SoCon in scoring (14.2 ppg) and has converted 17 of his last 18 free throw attempts.

- The Cougars shot 54.8 percent from the floor in a 96-90 overtime loss at Georgia Southern on Jan. 10, dropping College of Charleston to 38-1 all-time in SoCon games when shooting at least 50 percent from the field.

- The Cougars topped crosstown rival The Citadel, 69-46, behind the play of Jermaine Johnson. Johnson had a double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds.



The Citadel

- The Citadel has posted a 5-5 record at McAlister Fieldhouse this season but the Bulldogs are 0-6 away from home in 2007-08.

- The Bulldogs began a five-game homestand on Jan. 12 in a game against Georgia Southern. Following a loss to College of Charleston (Jan. 14), the Bulldogs host Wofford (Jan. 19), Davidson (Jan. 24) and UNC Greensboro (Jan. 26) during the stretch.



Davidson

- With a win at Furman on Jan. 16, the Wildcats extended their SoCon winning streak to 17, dating back to last season. Davidson has won 30 of its last 31 contests against league competition.

- The Wildcats are 7-0 in league play for the second consecutive season and have won five consecutive games.

- Stephen Curry averaged 20.5 points in two contests last week, shooting 50 percent from the field with five three-pointers. The sophomore was 8-of-9 from the line as Davidson slipped past Elon (59-57) and beat Wofford (85-50) last week.



Furman

- Furman will host College of Charleston (Jan. 19) and Appalachian State (Jan. 24) in its next two outings. The Paladins are 0-8 on enemy courts this season.

- The snake-bitten Paladins have lost five games by five points or less this season including a 60-58 defeat against Elon on Jan. 12 in their last outing.

- Alex Opacic notched his first career double-double with 20 points and 12 boards Jan. 12 vs. Elon.



Georgia Southern

- Georgia Southern connected on a season-high 11 three-pointers in a 73-52 triumph at The Citadel on Jan. 12. Freshman Willie Powers was 4-of-5 from three-point range against the Bulldogs.

- The Eagles play at Appalachian State on Jan. 19. Georgia Southern is 7-5 away from home this season.

- Willie Powers averaged 17.5 points and 2.5 assists in two games last week. The guard scored 23 points in a 96-90 overtime win at College of Charleston and had 17 against The Citadel.



Wofford

- The Terriers finished a four-game homestand with a 1-3 mark and fell, 70-60, at College of Charleston on Jan. 17 to begin a three-game road swing. The Terriers are 1-5 on the road this season.

- Shane Nichols scored his 1,000th career point at Wofford on Jan. 12 against Davidson. Nichols has scored 1,010 points in a Wofford uniform and has 1,316 career points. Nichols played at St. Peter's as a freshman and was the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference's Rookie of the Year in 2003-04.

- The Terriers are 4-0 when they shoot 50 percent or better from the floor and 5-0 when they outshoot the opponent.

Coach Jimmy Tillette's team was 15-16 in 2006-07 with an RPI of 76. Samford currently competes in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Bulldogs are 7-10 (4-5 in the OVC) as of Jan. 18, 2008. The Bulldogs play at Eastern Kentucky (Jan. 19) in an OVC contest.
