#### Preseason Men's Soccer Release

For the third consecutive year, UNCG has been picked to claim the 2023 regular season championship in voting of the leagues' six head coaches. The defending regular season and tournament title winners along with their head coach, Chris Rich, will be vying for their eighth championship in program history and their third straight regular season crown. The Spartans scored in the 83rd minute of the 2022 SoCon Championship match to claim a 2-1 victory over the defending tournament title holder, Mercer.

ETSU picked up a conference-best four selections. UNCG followed with three, while Mercer and Furman placed two each on the preseason team. Wofford rounded out the team with one selection.

Coaches were not allowed to vote for their own teams or players in the balloting.

UNCG accumulated five first-place votes for a total of 25 points. Mercer and ETSU each collected 18 points to tie for second place with the Bears picking up the final first-place vote. Furman came in fourth with 14 points while Wofford was picked fifth with 10 points. VMI rounded out the poll with five points.



#### **Notes**

- Last Season's regular season and tournament champions UNCG have been selected as preseason favorite to win the Southern Conference regular season title for the third consecutive year.
- The Spartans were ranked no. 10 in the United Soccer Coaches Top 25 Preseason Poll
- UNCG beat Mercer in the conference championship 2-1 last year then went on to win against Ohio State and Stanford before losing in the Elite Eight to Indiana.
- The Spartans ended the season tied for ninth in the NCAA for total goals with 46 on the season
- Mercer and ETSU tied for second place in the preseason poll each garnering 18 points with Mercer receiving one first-place vote.
- ETSU had four SoCon preseason selections including Goalkeeper of the Year and 2023 preseason selection, Cole Hunter who averaged 0.79 goals against and .761 saves last season.
- The Bucs also return their leading scorers Kieran Richard and Tarik Pannholzer who both finished first-team all-conference a season ago.
- Mercer placed two on the preseason team including midfielder Dylan Gaither who is the active career leader in points scored, goals scored, shots and shots on goal.
- Furman was picked to finish fourth with the return of Jake Raine the career active goals and points per game leader who did not play for two months of the 2022 season due to injury.
- Wofford acquired 10 points to finish fifth in the preseason poll and return the 2022
   Freshman of the Year Nikolai Rojel, a forward for the Terriers.
- VMI ended the 2022 season ranked eight in the NCAA for saves per game with an average of 5.41 per game
