### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Brendan McKillop - Davidson

McKillop tied his season high with a game-high 21 points as the Wildcats defeated Charlotte 82-68 at Belk Arena December 11.

The senior tied his career high with seven made three-pointers in the win over the 49ers. McKillop added two assists, a rebound, and one steal. With Davidson holding a three-point lead midway through the second half, McKillop knocked down a triple and assisted on another three-pointer from JP Kuhlman as part of a 14-4 run that moved Davidson out in front 53-40.

McKillop ranks third in the SoCon and 34th nationally with 2.9 made triples per game. He is averaging 11.2 points per game and has played 35.2 minutes per contest.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock, Elon's Roger Dugas, Furman's Noah States, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, Samford's Andy King, Chattanooga's Omar Wattad, Western Carolina's Mike Williams and Wofford's Cameron Rundles.

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Despite scoring a season-low 14 points at Georgetown on Sunday, Donald Sims maintains the lead in the So-Con scoring race with 25.1 points per game. He is among the nation's top-10 in scoring and is just 85 points away from the program's all-time scoring lead.

- The Hoyas shot 60 percent from the floor and four players scored in double figures to lead the home team to an 89-60 win over the Mountaineers. It was the first time since 2005 that a team shot 60 percent or better from the floor against the Apps.
- The Mountaineers host Robert Morris December 18.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Elon has been one of the top teams at sharing the basketball during the first month of the season. The Phoenix rank second in the conference with 15.7 assists per game. Elon also ranks second in the league with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.2.

- Elon has seen an increase in its scoring through the first nine games this season. The Phoenix lead the league with an average of 78.6 points per contest, eleven points better than 2009-10 when Elon averaged 66.9 points per game.
- The Phoenix host Chattanooga at Alumni Gym on December 17.

## UNCG SPARTANS



- Junior transfer Aloysius Henry has made an immediate impact for the Spartans this season. He leads UNCG and ranks in the top 20 in the league in both scoring (11.8 ppg) and rebounding (5.9 rpg).
- UNCG has been one of the best teams on the offensive glass in the conference through the first month of the season.

The Spartans rank third in the SoCon with 13.1 offensive rebounds per game. The Spartans are third in offensive rebound percent (.348).

- UNCG visits Wake Forest December 15. The Spartans will visit Clemson December 19.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford is the sixth-ranked team in the nation in 3-point field goals made per game. The Bulldogs are averaging 9.8 three-pointers per contest and are shooting 38.7 percent from beyond the arc. So far this season, Samford owns a 4-0 record when shooting at least 40

percent from three-point range.

- Samford is 5-0 this season when at least three players have scored in double figures. So far this season, junior guard Jeffrey Merritt is the only Bulldog averaging double figures in scoring, but four players achieved the mark in Saturday's win against UT Arlington.
- Samford will host Asbury December 18.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- In his last seven games, Omar Wattad is averaging 15.4 points and 4.1 rebounds per contest while shooting 41.5 percent. He has made 3.1 triples per game and is shooting 82.4 percent (28-34) from the free throw line, including hitting 16 for his last 17 (.941). He has scored at least 20 points in two of the last three games with 21

against Appalachian State and 23 against Murray State.

- Chattanooga is 4-1 when the score is within five points (leading or trailing) with five minutes to play in the game.
- The Mocs visit Elon Friday night.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Senior guard Mike Williams scored 20-plus points for the fifth time in his WCU career against Ohio State, coming up two points shy of matching his career-high of 24 which he scored last year at Louisville and matched this season against Gardner-Webb. The Catamounts are just 1-4 (0-4 this season) when Williams surpasses the 20-point plateau.

- Western Carolina has lost four straight games, marking the longest winless drought for the Catamounts since the 2006-07 season. WCU had not dropped more than three consecutive games since 2006-07 when the Catamounts endured a pair of five-game skids.

- The Catamounts travel to take on the Dayton Flyers December 18.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars rank 30th nationally in field-goal percentage (.482) and 32nd in three-point field goals per game (8.3 avg). They have averaged 79.8 points per game which also ranks in the top 50 among NCAA statistical leaders as of Dec. 12. CoFC has scored 79 points or more in its last three games.

- Senior Andrew Goudelock is 201 points away from becoming the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,935 career points to date. He currently ranks No. 7 nationally in points per game (24.1) and No. 2 in three-point field goals per game (3.7 avg).
- The Cougars visit Charleston Southern December 15. CoFC will host Clemson December 22.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Senior guard Cameron Wells is now 38 points shy of Regan Truesdale's all-time school scoring record of 1,661 points. It has taken Wells six less games to move within the scoring record, as Truesdale played in 109 games over the duration of his career.
- Senior Austin Dahn, who leads the team with 17 3-pointers on the season, has climbed to fourth on the all-time 3-pointers made in Citadel history (199). He is now one shy of joining Zach Urbanus (247), Noy Castillo (230) and Travis Cantrell (228) among sharpshooters with 200 or more 3-pointers in their career.

- The Citadel visit Colorado December 17.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Davidson improved to 24-2 in its last 26 games against non-conference competition in Belk Arena with an 82-68 win over Charlotte Saturday. The 'Cats are 32-5 at home since 2003.

- Head coach Bob McKillop is 12 wins away from his 400th career victory. A total of 351 of his 388 wins have come while Davidson has been a member of the Southern Conference, making him the all-time wins leader in league history.

- The Wildcats travel to take part in the MSG Holiday Festival in New York City December 20-21.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman shot a season-high 53 percent from the field in its 76-61 victory at Middle Tennessee State on Sunday afternoon. The Paladins have shot 44.4 percent from the floor this season.

- Sunday's victory at Middle Tennessee State marked Furman's third straight win and third road victory of the 2010-11 season. Furman, 3-2 on the road this season, posted just a 5-11 record away from Timmons Arena last season.

- The Paladins visit North Florida December 18.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Eric Ferguson, who led the Eagles with 22 points and 10 rebounds against Brewton-Parker, recorded his first collegiate double-double. Ferguson averages a team-high 14.0 points per game for the Eagles. He is 12th in the league with 5.7 rebounds per game.

- The Georgia Southern freshman class accounts for 61 percent of the Eagles' scoring. Ferguson and Jelani Hewitt average 14.0 and 11.4 ppg, respectively, while the seven freshmen on the roster are responsible for 45.1 of GSU's 74.0 points per game.

- The Eagles visit Cincinnati Tuesday night. Georgia Southern will host South Alabama December 18.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Senior Noah Dahlman has extended his double-digit scoring streak to 57 games after pouring in 14 points at South Carolina. The forward is third in the league in scoring (19.2 ppg) and ranks sixth in the SoCon in field goal percentage (.537).

- The Terriers average a league-high 16.0 assists per game but do not have a single player in the conference's top-10 ranking. Jamar Diggs leads Wofford with 3.1 helpers a game which ranks 15th in the Southern Conference.

- Wofford hosts High Point December 18.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2010-11. Seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 35 starters from last year, an average of 2.9 per team. Furman is the only team in the league to return all five starters from last season. Wofford and The Citadel each return four starters.
- Eight of the ten members from the 2010 Coaches All-Conference team return for 2010-11.

### HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

### NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Ten of the 12 SoCon teams are scheduled to participate in an exempt tournament this winter, from Puerto Rico (Davidson) to Cancun, Mexico (Appalachian State).

- SoCon teams will take part in the 2K Sports Classic, Charleston Classic, Puerto Rico Tip-Off, Global Sports Showcase, Legends Classic, South Padre Island Invitational, Cancun Govern's Cup, MSG Holiday Festival and Las Vegas Classic.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in Southern Conference history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the league in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

### MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2011 marks the 90th year of the post-season classic.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the postseason for 2010. The league also placed four teams in postseason tournaments in 2009.

- The Wofford Terriers made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2010. Wofford fell to Wisconsin 53-49 in the first round in Jacksonville, Fla.
- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
- Appalachian State defeated Harvard (93-71) and Marshall (80-72) in the CIT but dropped a 64-56 decision to Pacific in the semifinal.
- After defeating Eastern Kentucky (82-79) in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, College of Charleston fell at VCU (93-86) in the second round.
